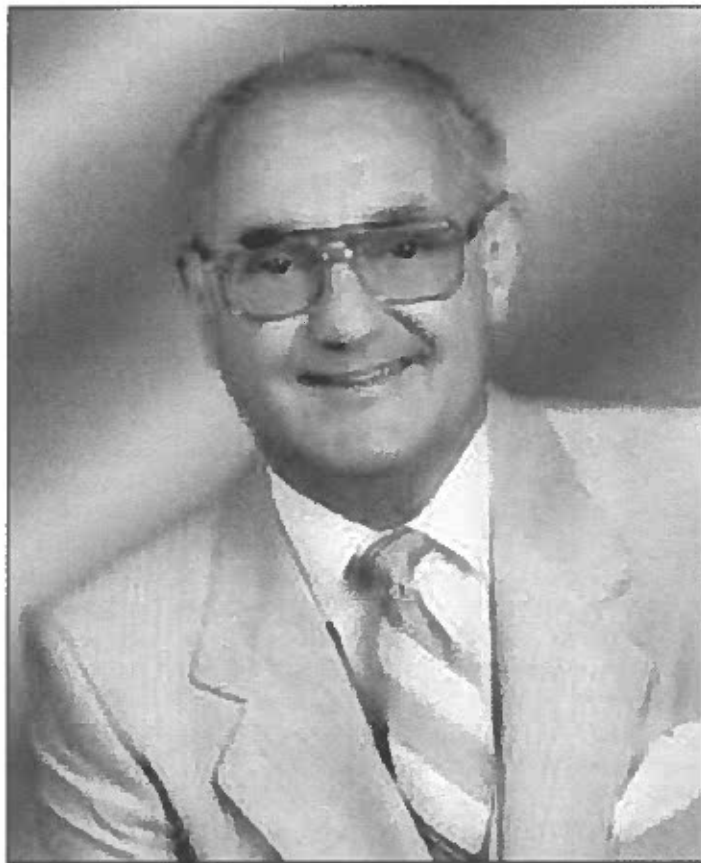

Clyde DiAngelo spent a decade as the boys basketball coach at Steubenville Catholic Central.

During that time, DiAngelo firmly etched himself among the best in Crusaders' history. Because of his longevity and success, DiAngelo has earned numerous accolades, including the Earl Haberfield Boys Basketball Coaching honor today as part of the OVAC Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Game.

DiAngelo, who is the all-time winningest coach in SCC history, guided the Crusaders to two OVAC championships, five sectional crowns and a district championship. Steubenville Central also won an Eastern Buckeye League title.

He was recognized for his success when he was named District 5 Coach of the Year in 1979, 1984 and 1989. He coached the District 5 All-Star Game in 1982 and 1984. He coached the OVAC All-Star Game in 1984 and 1989 and served as the game's director in 1987 and 88. He also received the OV Board of Approved Officials Sportsmanship Award in 1989.

Along with his basketball coaching prowess, DiAngelo was also a highly successful baseball coach. He led the Crusaders to three OVAC titles and a trip to the OHSAA State Baseball Tournament.

In 2015, DiAngelo received the Steubenville Baron Club Award from Franciscan University.

Clyde and his wife, Sonja have two children -- Danielle Kalinowski and Michael. They also have three grandchildren -- Ty, Vinny and Giovanni.

Tina (Yates) Exner was enjoying life in Tampa, Fla. as a teacher.

However, the opportunity to come home to Shadyside and take over the reins of the Lady Tiger basketball program was simply too much to pass up.

Exner returned and guided the Lady Tigers from 2015-2013 and experienced much success during her tenure. She guided Shadyside to a 135-51 record during her time. She won two OVAC titles, five sectional titles, a district and regional championship. During that regional championship campaign of 2011, Shadyside put forth the school's lone perfect regular season, too.

Her decision to come home and the career she put forth led her receiving the Rich Saffield Girls Coach Award at today's OVAC Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Game.

Exner was the Eastern District Coach of the Year that season as well as the Times Leader Girls Basketball Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the OVAC Coach of the Year. She coached in this very all-star game that season as well.

Prior to becoming the head coach at her alma mater, Exner was a member of Kim Appolloni's staff at Martins Ferry from 1996-2004. She was also a player during part of that time when she was on the team at Ohio University Eastern where she was a 1,000-point scorer.

Exner, who owns a master's degree from West Liberty, is employed by the Martins Ferry school district.

Jimmy Hood certainly saw a lot during his time involved with Ohio Valley basketball.

How couldn't he? After all, he spent 40 seasons officiating the sport.

That length of time and the fact that he was one of the most decorated officials in the area has led to him receiving the Robert Dawson Officials Award at today's OVAC Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Game.

Hood worked as a member of the Ohio Valley Board of Officials and spent time not only working in the OVAC, but his expertise earned him assignments within the MVL, IVC and ECOL.

Add all of that up and it also led the 1983 Martins Ferry graduate to earn 18 state-tournament assignments in Ohio. He worked 11 boys and seven girls state tournaments. He worked numerous regionals in both Ohio and West Virginia.

Hood was named the Ohio Valley Board Official of the Year and was also recognized as the NFHS Ohio Official of the Year.

If you've been to a Cambridge basketball game -- at any level -- you've probably seen Bob Shepard without even realizing it.

For more than 20 consecutive seasons, Shepard has been the scorekeeper for the Bobcats boys basketball team and he's approaching his 20th consecutive season as the girls' scorekeeper.

Add all of that up, and it results in receiving today's Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer and Scorekeeper Award at the annual Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Basketball Games.

Shepard began his scorekeeping duties as the junior varsity scorer in 1999. A few seasons later, he started doing both the JV and varsity books and has remained in that position. Clearly in need of more to do during the winter, Shepard started keeping the girls' JV and varsity scorebook in 2005. He's also kept score at several junior high boys and freshmen games over the course of that time span.

If his work during the regular season wasn't enough, Shepard has served as the "official scorer" for the tournament games that Cambridge High School has hosted for the OHSAA.

Shepard is involved in sports at Cambridge basically all school year. He has worked the table for Bobcat volleyball games since 2003 and he's also the school's long-time head softball coach. He's excelled there with an OVAC championship and upwards of 250 victories. He also oversees the annual Cambridge Summer Softball League.

As it pertains to his work and involvement in Ohio Valley basketball, Phil Rujak checks multiple boxes.

He's coached, served the OVAC, worked in the media, worked in athletic administration and is currently the principal at Madonna High School in Weirton.

His consistent and dedicated involvement made him the selection for the Bob Burton Service Award, which is being presented today during the OVAC Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Games.

A 44-year resident of Weirton, Rujak didn't grow up in the OVAC, per se. He's originally from western Pennsylvania and is a graduate of Burgettstown High School in 1980. He attended the University of Steubenville and earned a degree in business administration and a certification in secondary and adult education. He later completed a Master's degree at Salem International in Educational Leadership.

Rujak began his career in basketball in 1981. He served as an assistant with the boys team for more than 30 years. He then accepted the head girls' basketball position at Oak Glen, holding that role for three seasons. He made two appearances in the West Virginia State Tournament.

He worked at Oak Glen as a teacher and then spent several years as the school's athletic director. He also taught at Weir before accepting the Blue Dons' principal role prior to the 2022-23 school year.

On top of basketball, Rujak was Oak Glen's boys track coach for three seasons and won two regional titles and an OVAC crown before garnering a third-place finish in the Class AA state meet.

Rujak hosted talk radio shows on WEIR and WSTV Radio for 17 years. He spent 10 years as a member of the OVAC Basketball Tournament Committee and also served on the West Virginia Athletic Director's Association Board of Directors for five years.
