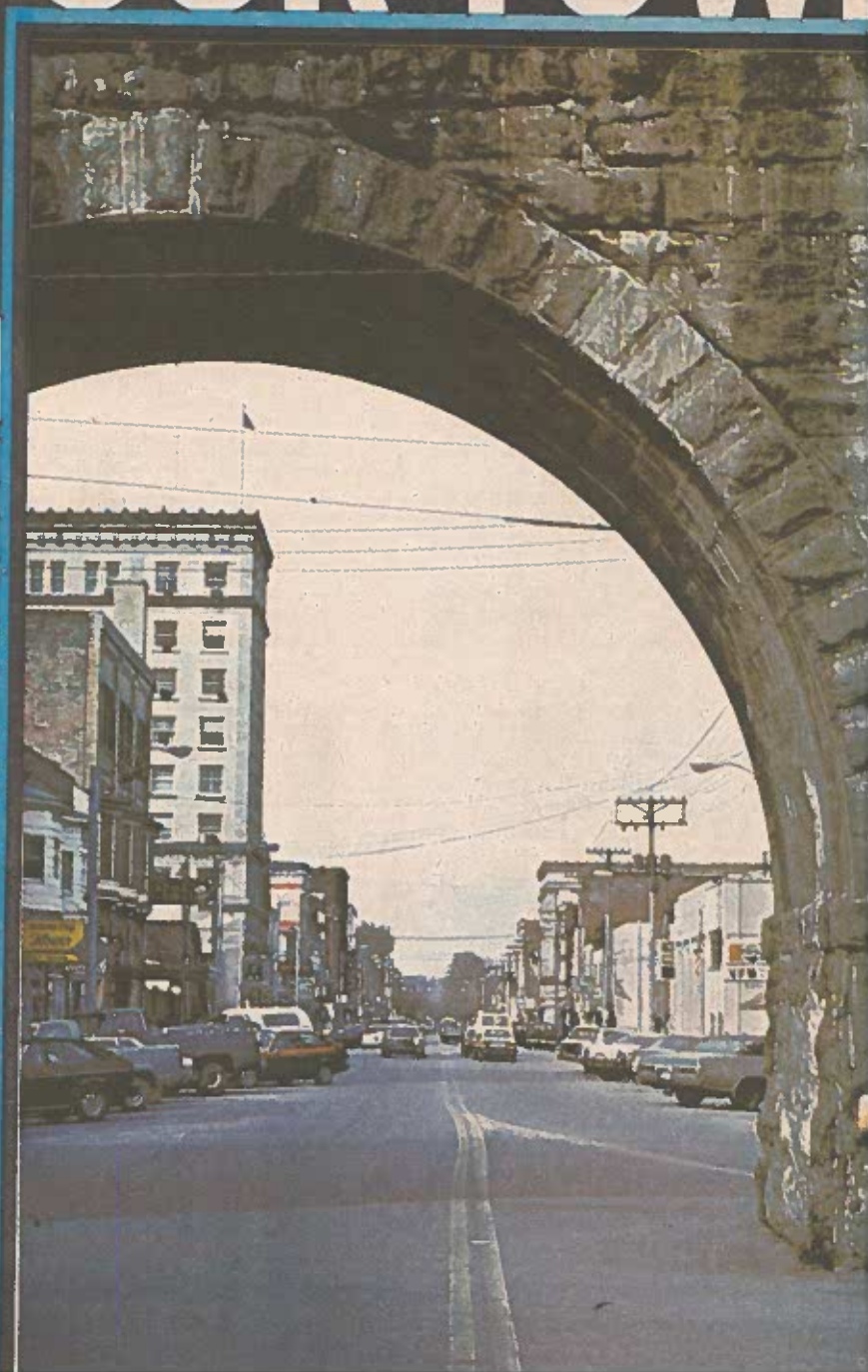

BELLAIRE



THE JOB of the Bellaire Area Chamber of Commerce is to improve business and build a better community. Therefore, the Chamber's program should include all types of activities which seek to serve the best interests of all people of the community.

In 1975, Christmas lights were purchased by the business community at a cost of \$10,000 through three-year pledges from member businesses.

In 1976, the Chamber shared jointly with the New Industries the expense of mover lines for the Bellaire-Neffs highway extension an industrial site west of the city. The group contributed \$4,600.

A major project for 1978 was the creation of Bel-Park and Development Inc., which provides 69 off-street parking spaces at the intersection of Union and Belmont streets and allows more parking for business customers.

In 1983, one of the most successful projects the Chamber worked on was the sponsorship of a reprint of Caldwell's 1880 "History of Belmont and Jefferson Counties."

In 1985, we spearheaded a drive to raise \$10,000 to do a study on revitalizing the downtown area and we were able to meet our goal.

In 1986, we published a brochure of unoccupied buildings, renovated Chamber "Welcome Signs" at the north and south ends of the city, assisted in selecting and putting in new litter receptacles in the downtown area, continued to work closely with the city administration and the Bellaire Development Committee on various projects, and sponsored a citywide Cleanup Campaign that has

According to latest census figures, Bellaire has a population of 8,241. The town extends along the banks of the Ohio River for approximately 3.5 miles and encompasses an area of approximately 2.5 square miles. The city supports several small industries, including Belmont Garment Co., Delta Concrete, and loading docks for R and F Oil, Cravat Coal and Marietta Coal companies.

Bellaire was once a center for the glassmaking industry with 17 glass plants. Imperial Glass Corp. has produced reproductions for the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Smithsonian Institution.

become an annual event. Also, the Chamber now sponsors the Bellaire Glass Festival with proceeds going toward the maintenance of the Bellaire Glass Museum. Other activities include sponsorship of a series of commemorative Christmas tree ornaments, a Christmas parade, and the upkeep and repair of the Christmas lights.

In addition to these activities, the Chamber:

- Maintains current organization, industrial and retail listings, complete with addresses and contact person, available on request.

- Converses with out-of-town visitors, providing them with information and a map of the city or county.

- Maintains small business association information.

- Provides Better Business Bureau kind information and referrals for consumer problems.

- Maintains a collection of tourist information, including brochures and other information about Ohio attractions.

- Works with surrounding area chambers of commerce and government bodies toward preventing harmful legislation that would affect the area's unemployment and economy — a telephone tree message is received from the Steubenville Chamber of Commerce which the Bellaire Chamber then relays to the Martins Ferry Chamber, etc.

- Provides secretarial work for Bel-Park and Development Inc.

- Provides secretarial work for the Real Estate Merchants Association, planning promotional parades, etc.

- Publishes a monthly newsletter.

Looking ahead

THE CITY'S development department was organized in 1977 and for the past few years has pursued a number of projects geared around the relocation of Ohio 7 through Bellaire. City officials, along with representatives from the board of education, the Belmont County Community Improvement Corp., local health care facilities, the Eastern Ohio Development Council, the Ohio Midwestern Governments Association, and local financial institutions participating are members of the Bellaire Development Committee, which was formed in 1984. The DC continues to investigate ways to use the highway as a focal point for future development in Bellaire.

Although the city has lost business and population in the past few years, 1986 saw the beginning of what many hope will be a brighter future for Bellaire. The former Bellaire Garment Co., which manufactured

as of April 1987 and the plant owners advertising for more help.

Much of the city was declared an enterprise zone, thus allowing Bellaire to offer incentives to new businesses. One of the ways to take advantage of the designation was C.A. Robrecht Co., formerly of Wheeling, which relocated its wholesale printing warehouse to a new building on 26th Street. Groundbreaking ceremonies for the 15,000 square-foot edifice were held in April 1986 and the company was operating from its new headquarters in December.

Bellaire is moving ahead with efforts to develop the 26th Street area into Community Park, where several existing businesses indicated they want to relocate when construction takes land they currently occupy. Those businesses include P&H Distributing, Swift Stone and Brick, A. G. Distributing Co., Weather-Rite, A. Gattuso and Cervelli Oldsmobile. The state of Ohio has already agreed to provide \$86,000

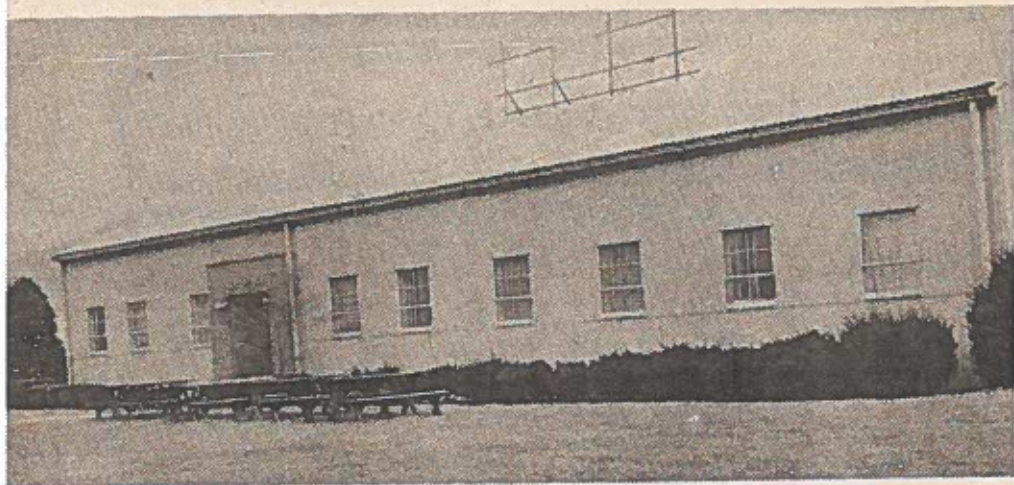

BELLAIRE'S FIRST permanent settlement is dated from 1803, when Jacob Davis, a slave of Bel Air, Md., built a cabin on what is now West 23rd Street, near McMahon's Creek. Davis purchased his land from John Er, who had obtained a land grant in Bel Air but never developed the land.

The town site was laid out by Davis and his sons in 1834, centering in the area north and south of McMahon's Creek, and in 1860 the village was incorporated according to the laws of Ohio, with the formal organization of municipal government and allied services.

Coal mines, glass plants, and foundries brought settlers in growing numbers to Bellaire, and the arrival of the Central Ohio Railroad from Columbus in 1856 added another dimension to travel by river and rail. The completion of the Stone Bridge in 1852 linked the Central Ohio Railroad in the west with the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad in the east and spurred the growth of both industry and population. In 1973, Bellaire came a city. Prior to the opening of the bridge, it was necessary to transport rail freight and passengers across the river by steamboat.

BELLAIRE AT one time supported 17 glass plants, which gave the town the nickname "Glass City." The last remaining glass manufacturer, Imperial Glass Corp., is unable to reorganize under chapter 11

The area surrounding Bellaire is one of industrial activity in coal mining, basic iron and steel fabrication. Located midway between New York and Chicago and midway between Cleveland and Washington, D.C. the Bellaire area is comparatively near the major markets in the eastern half of the nation.

The greatest of the city's resources are its people, warm, friendly, cooperative, and skilled enough to offer a vast reserve potential to incoming industry and business. The Stone Bridge remains the city's most known landmark and has served as a major east-west connection for the Baltimore and Ohio Railway and its successor, the Chesapeake and Ohio System.

The city is noted as the site of the mansion That Jack Built, a mansion constructed by Jacob Heatherington on South Belmont Street in 1837. Heatherington was one of the early coal barons who came to Bellaire from Wales and founded a successful coal business. He used his wealth not only to build the mansion but to help start several other enterprises, including iron foundries, and to establish Bellaire's first horse-drawn trolley line. The "Jack" was Heatherington's mule cart carried the necessary building materials from the house from the Ohio River to the mansion site. Local legend maintains the house was built with extra wide doors and staircases.

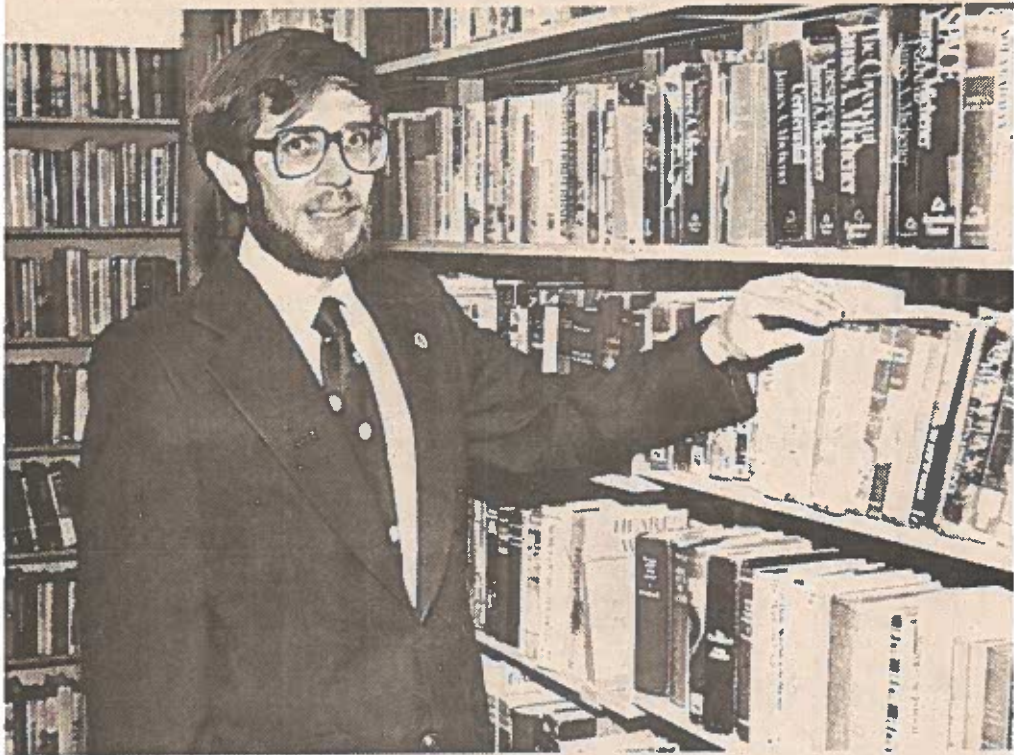

BELLAIRE STUDENTS may attend either public or parochial school system. The Bellaire City School District operates the Neffs, Key Ridge, West Bellaire, Rose Hill, and Indian Run elementary schools for children in kindergarten through fifth grade; the First Ward and Gravel Hill middle schools for students in grades six through eight; and the Bellaire High School for students in grades nine through 12. School officials have instituted several new programs in recent years to put ad-

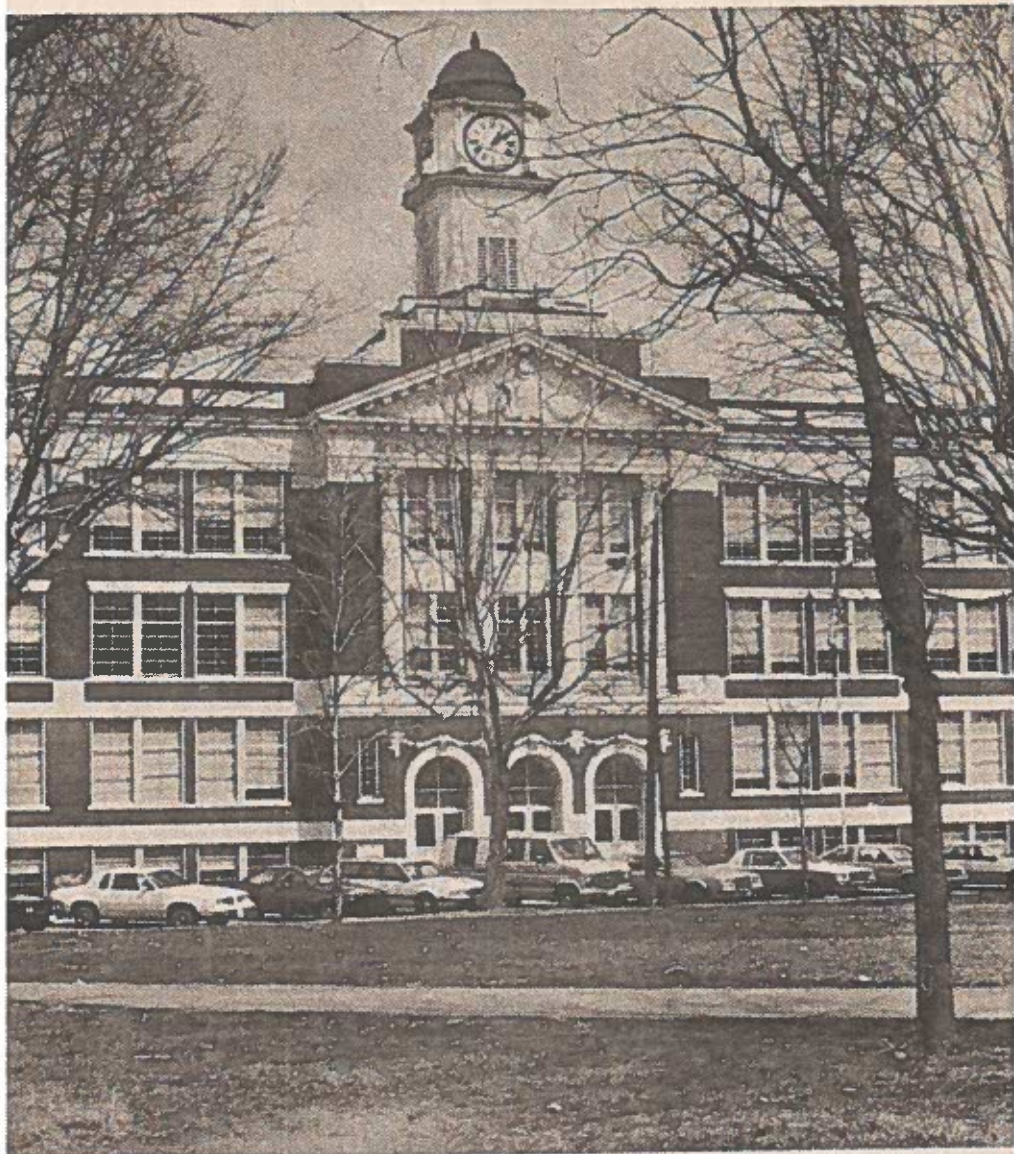

CITY HOSPITAL

BELLAIRE City Hospital, located at Harrison St., is a general, non-profit institution, organized for the treatment and care of medical, obstetrical, pediatric, surgical, and mental health patients.

The hospital was opened to the public in 1912 after eight years of planning and dedication by community-minded citizens. The original structure cost \$43,000 and contained 50 beds. A 1924 addition brought the number of beds to 50, and funds for another 50 beds were donated in the early 1930s. A new five-floor structure included operating rooms, men's and women's wards, a maternity ward, and a modern kitchen.

The present surgery-recovery and outpatient services wing went into operation in 1970, the hospital grew with the addition of an intensive coronary care unit. A \$2 million addition several years ago provided for an acute care wing, an emergency department, administrative offices, and a doctors' lounge. This newest addition has ex-

HEALTH DEPARTMENT

THE CITY Health Department is operated by Health Commissioner Bill Dunaway and Health Nurse Joyce Ferguson.

Because of budget cutbacks, both work or parttime and the office is open Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Despite the lowered hours, however, the department still provides a number of services.

The department maintains vital statistics for the city and has birth and death records dating from 1909; does affidavits; records city deaths for Belmont County and the Belmont County Board of Elections. Other services include environmental sanitation, food

MEDICAL FOUNDATION

THE MEDICAL Foundation of Bellaire provides Health Management System services to approximately 25,000 area residents; approximately 12,000 of those are subscribers to the HMS and the rest are fee-for-service patients.

The Medical Foundation was organized in the 1950s and operates the Bellaire Clinic at 3000 Guernsey St., the Powhatan Health Center on Ohio 7 in Powhatan Point, and the Harrisville Clinic on Ohio 250 near Harrisville.

President of the board of trustees is Richard Vannelle. The 24-person staff offers pediatric, internal medicine, family practice, surgical, obstetrical and gynecological, allergy, radiology, pathology, urology, optometry, and mental health care services.
