EXCEPTIONS AND ADDITIONS TO RULES

For OHIO High School Games Only

- 1. A forward pass can be made anywhere back of line of scrimmage. (General rules require 5 yds. back.)
- Penalty 5 to 15 yards if forward passer is run into or roughed when it is clearly indicated by his actions that he is going to pass.
- On all outbound plays, ball is brought in 15 yards instead of the usual 10 yards Head gears must be worn by all players of both teams—player has two minutes
- to obtain head gear and his team is charged with time out or player disqualified.
- A kicked ball not having crossed line of scrimmage can be downed or advanced by either team. A lateral pass is permissable by the team recovering ball.

INTERPRETING THE DECISIONS

Almost everything that happens is communicated to the spectators by signs from the officials:

SAFETY: One hand raised above the head, with two fingers extended. TOUCHDOWN, POINT AFTER TOUCHDOWN, FIELD GOAL: Both hands raised high over head.

TOUCHBACK: Arms crossed over head.

DEAD BALL: One hand raised above head.

OFF-SIDE: One hand extended in direction of penalty.

CLIPPING, ROUGHING KICKER PILING UP: Shaking of fist.
INCOMPLETE FORWARD PASS, MISSED GOAL: Arms crossed in front of

HOLDING: Grasping of wrist.

INTERFERENCE: Pushing motion with hands

FOUL BY BOTH TEAMS: Arms form a zero, finger tips touching above head.

PENALTY DECLINED: Military salute.

SPORTSMANSHIP and FOOTBALL

Football is a pastime that demands sportsmanship. It is a grueling, personal-contact battle, in which a man knows in advance he must accept punishment.

The slightest show of weakness on his part is a signal to the other side to 'let him have it.' No rival can be censured for taking advantage of a technical defect in the other team's play.

But drawing the line at inflicting personal injury is part of the sportsman's code, which every true American youth who plays football should learn and practice.

It is hardly necessary to say there have been instances a-plenty on the gridiron where fine sportsmanship has not been displayed. It was not so many years ago that we had what were called "muckers" in football.

More than one team had a repu-

tation for roughing opponents beyond reason. A few such outfits eventually found it difficult to complete their schedules. There have been coaches who had the reputation of teaching "dirty" football.

With them it was a case of "get him before he gets you." An injured opponent was the special "meat" for such teams, and was hammered out of the lineup as early in the game as possible.

But throughout the length and breadth of the land, there are scores of teams about which could be written epics of fine sportsmanship.

As long as sportsmanship is the usual thing, football will flourish. It will always be a rough battle, fit only for he-men carefully trained and conditioned, but it will never_deteriorate into brutishness.

SUMMARY OF THE MOST COMMON PENALTIES

LOSS OF DOWN

Second forward pass during same play. Intentionally grounding pass (also 15 yds.) Incomplete forward pass.

LOSS OF FIVE YARDS

More than three time outs during a half.
Illegal delay of game by either team.
Failure of substitute to report. Offside play.
Player in motion less than five yards back.
Player out of bounds when scrimmage begins.
Attempts to draw opponents off-side.
Illegal use of hands and arms by players on the defensive team.

Using flying block or flying tackle.

Running into the kicker. ("If contact is slight, or is caused by the kicker's own motion, this shall not be interpreted as 'running into the kicker.' ")

Crawling by the runner.

Unfair play not provided for in rules.

LOSS OF FIFTEEN YARDS

Substitute communicating before ball is put in play. Failure to come to a stop on a shift play. Interference with opportunity to make a fair catch. Throwing to the ground the player who has made the fair catch. Helping the runner or interlocking interference. Illegal use of the hands and arms by offensive team. Roughing the kicker. Piling up, hurdling, clipping. Unsportsmanlike conduct by players.

Team not ready to play at scheduled time. Illegal return to game (also suspensions).

LOSS OF HALF DISTANCE TO GOAL LINE

Striking, kneeing, kicking, etc. Foul within 1 yard line.

LOSS OF BALL

Second kick out of bounds at kick-off.
Forward pass touched by ineligible player.
Interference by team which did not make pass.
Kicking team illegally touching ball.
