

# Park Girls Capture OVAC Softball Title

Wheeling Park scored two unearned runs in the bottom of the 13th to best Bishop Donahue, 6-5, and win the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference girls' softball championship Saturday afternoon at St. Jude Park in Glen Dale.

The Bishops took the lead in the top of the inning when losing pitcher Jo Ann Lally stole home. But the Patriots got a pair of singles and an intentional walk to load the bases before Bishop Donahue committed two consecutive infield errors that plated the tying and winning runs.

Beth Walter was the winning pitcher for The Park, which ended the season with a 10-3 record, while

Sue Morris, Becky Riggle and Watson had two singles each. Lally, who fanned eight batters, had a triple and was walked intentionally four times for the 13-2 record Bishops.

In the semi-finals earlier in the day, Wheeling Park bested Weirton (9-2), 18-13, as Shari Doerr had four singles and Riggle a triple and two singles. The Patriots were aided by 18 walks, while Donahue downed Fort Frye (14-2) as winning pitcher Karen Kanick had double and a single and Lori Palmer had three bingles.

The Warwood Green Fillies downed the Elm Grove Bees Saturday afternoon by an 11-8 count in Chamber's 'Y' ponytail softball league play at the Lock 12 field.

Tammy Ross belted two doubles and Kathy Majewski doubled and had two singles. Michelle Tomczyk, Misty Boring and Michelle Lemons each contributed two singles.
