HAUGHTON ON PSYCHOLOGY

Before a game with Yale, Percy Haughton had trouble calming down his squad. They were so nervous and wrought up that they were unable to do their best out on the foothall field.

Haughton strode up and down the dressing room several times and then in a soothing conversational tone addressed his players. "Now you men know what I hope you'll do. I plish and you know what I hope you'll do. I know that you'll do your best. I'm not worry-ing about that. And now. go out there and God ing about that. And now. go out there and God pless every one of you." Harvard won.

Yes, saying "the right thing at the right time," has changed the aspect of many an important football game.

Football games aren't always won on the football field.

Because human emotions play such a large part in the gridiron sport, games seemingly hopelessly lost have been turned into victories by coaches who "said the right thing at the right time."

The famous Knute Rockne of Notre Dame, Percy Haughton while at Harvard, and Amos cago, all experienced the thrill of seeing their teams roar out on the field with half the battle won because of their mental attitude. All three coaches had the ability to "say the right thing at the right time."

One of the shortest, between-halves "fight talks" on record is credited to Rockne. His Notre Dame team was playing miserable football and just couldn't seem to make anything work in the first half of their game with an important foe.

ROCKNE'S THREE WORDS

At the end of the half, Rockne walked into the dressing room, surveyed his players with a look of withering scorn and with a roar that shook the room, said "Fighting Irish!— Bah!" With that he stalked out of the room. Yes, Notre Dame came back to win in the second half.


