FOOTBALL EVOLUTION

In the early days, play was started by putting the ball on the ground, all players closing around it and then kicking it until it rolled out in the open. This method of putting the ball in play had its disadvantages, for it also gave the opponent a chance to secure the ball. Someone suggested that a player be stationed a short distance behind the scrimmage and that the ball be kicked back to him whenever possible. This was tried and proved so successful that the man behind the scrimmage many times was able to secure the ball and run around the mass of men before they realized that the ball had come into the open. From this time on the player behind the scrimmage was called the "Quarterback."

Soon some inventive genius discovered that he could so place his foot upon the ball that by pressing suddenly downward and backward with the toe of his shoe he could roll the ball back to the quarterback along the ground. This was the second step in the evolution of putting the ball in play. Until the style of play began to call for lower charging linemen, the ball was put in play by this means of rolling back with the foot. However, when lower

line play called for the center to be down over the ball he found it impossible to use his foot for snapping the ball back to the quarterback.

This resulted in the third step in the evolution of putting the ball into play, namely, the center using his hand to roll the ball back to the quarterback, end over end along the ground. By this time the backfield had developed and it took great skill on the part of the quarterback to pick the bounding ball up from the ground and hand it to one of the backs.

The fourth step in the evolution of putting the ball into play came when the center discovered that greater speed and accuracy could be secured by passing the ball between his legs with both hands to the quarterback, not allowing the ball to touch the ground. This method of putting the ball into play speeded up the game and fumbles were eliminated to a great extent.

The last stage of putting the ball into play came with the "direct snap," the passing of the ball by the center directly to the man who was to run with the ball.

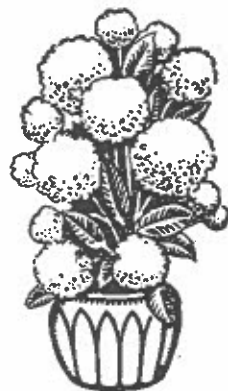

Penalties

- 1 Taking more than three times out during either half
- 2 Illegal delay of game
- 3 Failure of substitute to report to umpire

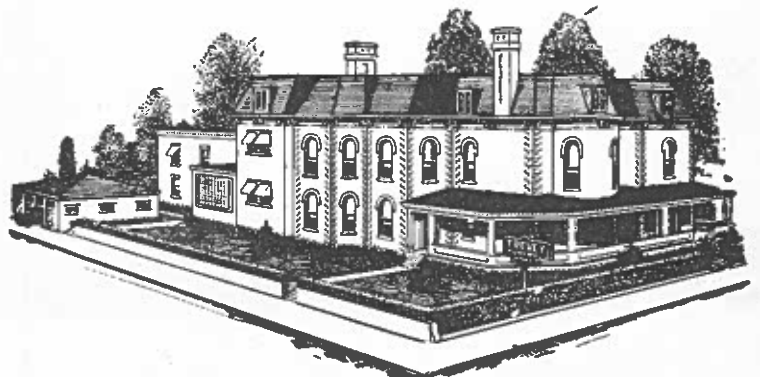

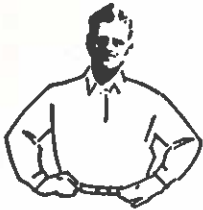

Offside and violation of kickoff formation. (Penalty, 5 yards.)



Unsportsmanlike conduct. (Penalty — 15 yards.) For flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct — 15 yard penalty and disqualification.



Illegal formation or position of one or more players. (Penalty — 5 yards from where ball was put in play.)



Player illegally in motion. (Penalty, 5 yards. If from shift or huddle, 15 yards.)



Intentional grounding of forward pass. (Penalty — loss of down and 15 yard penalty from spot of preceding down.)



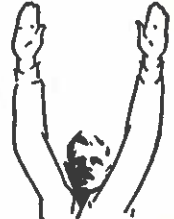
Unnecessary roughness, illegal defensive use of the hands. (Penalty, 15 yards.)



Crawling, pushing, or helping ball-carrier. (Penalty for helping ball-carrier, 15 yards; otherwise, 5 yards.)



Holding. (Penalty — by offense, 15 yards, by defense, 5 yards.)



Score—touchdown, field goal, or conversion.

Military salute also used for clipping, followed by striking the back of the knee with hand. (Penalty, 15 yards.) Signal also used for disqualification fouls and for running into or roughing the kicker. In the latter case, the military salute is followed by swinging the leg as though punting.



Safety.



Delay of game or extra time-out. (Penalty, 5 yards.)



Illegal forward pass.



Interference with forward pass, pass coaching ineligible player, or "screening" pass receiver. (If penalty on offense, 15 yards and loss of down; interference by defense, ball to offense on spot of foul as first down.)



Penalty refused, incomplete pass, missed field goal or conversion, both sides offside, etc.



Time out.



Illegal touching of kicked ball inside opponent's 10-yard line — touchback.

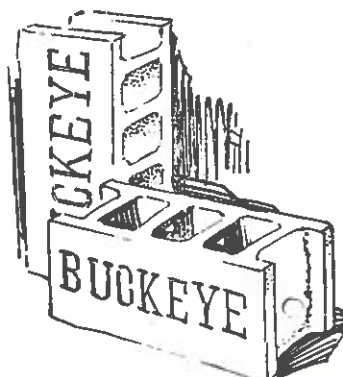

WELCOME TO OUR OLD FRIEND

Bellaire fans need no introduction to Albert N. "Sleepy" Glenn, coach of the enemy forces today. "Sleepy," or more properly, "Big Sleepy," was around these parts for three successful years before he was enticed away from the Big Red gridiron.

The "Big Sleepy" monicker was applied during his college days at W. V. U., when he and his brother, "Little Sleepy," helped spark one of the most successful Mountaineer squads to come out of "them thar hills." They even roared into Pittsburgh one fog-bound Saturday way back in 1927 to hang one on Jock Sutherland's Panthers at Pitt. That was in the days when Pitt University was Pitt and not Pee-Yoo as in recent lean years.

In that year the Mounties became known as the "unofficial" small college champions. "Sleepy's" friends, however, lived to regret that fact bitterly. When Glenn coached here, he was a perfect gentleman to talk to until the conversation—as it always did—got around to that 1927 outfit.

Then it was mayhem, uncontrolled. Albert—we hope he never reads this—would enthusiastically begin to demonstrate how the ridge-runners blocked out the opposition that memorable year. "Here's how we gave 'em
