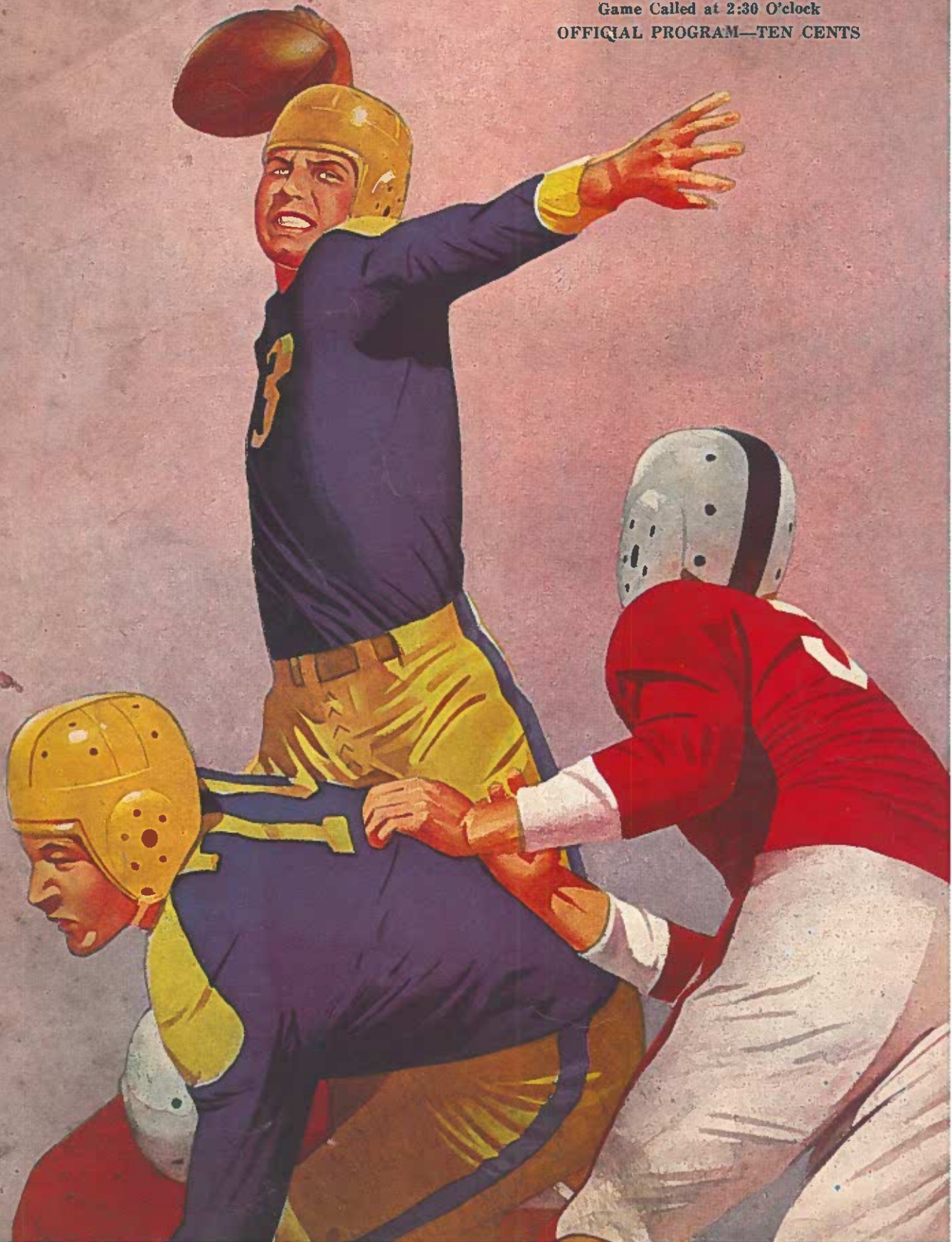

# THE PIGSKIN INVENTORY

In the last part of the third quarter of a football game you often hear the remark by some well-meaning fan, "what's the matter with that backfield; have they lead in their shoes? Run! Run! Don't just stand there!" How embarrassing it might be if that individual were quarterback instead of a fan.

Sitting in the shade, dressed appropriately for the prevailing weather, we are quite comfortable. Have you ever considered how much that player wears for his own and his opponents' protection? Its quite a pile of cotton, wool, leather, rubber and wood-fiber. Run a hundred yards with that pile on your back and it's bound to slow you down a bit.

Recently a person viewing our new game uniforms for the first time was really amazed at the dazzling color and apparent fit. They readily mentioned that perhaps it did cost a good bit. They even ventured a figure as to the cost of the entire uniform which would actually have purchased just one pair of shoes and a headgear.

A school like Bellaire having more than one hundred boys participating in football must carry a huge inventory of equipment. This includes a complete practice outfit and almost

an entirely different change for game use only.

To put a player on the field, for practice only, there must be an expenditure of at least sixty dollars (\$60.00). This includes only shoes, socks, supporter, jersey, hip pads, shoulder pads, thigh pads, pants, belt, headgear and possibly a T-jersey. The shoes, shoulder pads and hip pads are generally used for game too.

For game wear only the player must have at least two jerseys of different colors, pants, thigh pads, head gear, long stockings for cold weather, T-jersey and many "special" pieces of equipment to meet his own individual needs. The cost of putting a player in the game is at least an additional forty dollars (\$40.00). This figure includes no special equipment.

In addition we must always have on hand such things as shoe strings, belts, tape (miles of it), band aids and other medical supplies, rib pads, knee braces, ankle wraps, crepe rubber pads, heavy coats, with hoods attached, rain jackets, rubber rain pants, foot balls, rubbing ointment and a host of other necessities, too numerous to mention. One thing we must remember, it's not the cost with which we are concerned, but the fact that we must provide every boy with the best equipment we can buy to protect him against any possible injury.

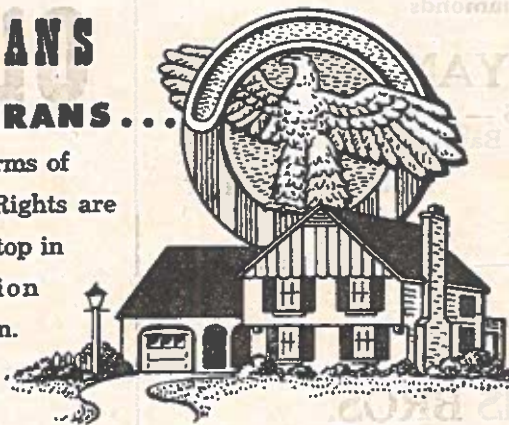

- 1 Taking more than three times out during either half

- 5 Failure to maintain proper alignment of offensive team before ball is snapped. Also, backfield man illegally in motion
- 6 Offside by either team, or encroachment on neutral zone
- 7 Attempt to draw opponents offside
- 8 Taking more than two steps with ball after signalling for fair catch
- 9 Illegal use of hands and arms by defensive players
- 10 Flying block or flying tackle
- 11 Running into kicker
- 12 Crawling by the runner
- 13 Team not ready to play at scheduled time
- 14 Substitute communicating with teammates before ball is put in play
- 15 Illegal substitution (Player also suspended from game)
- 16 Failure to stop at least one second on shift play
- 17 Forward pass by member of team which did not put ball in play
- 18 Forward pass touched by ineligible player
- 19 Intentional grounding of forward pass
- 20 Interference by member of passing team with defensive player eligible for pass
- 21 Interference with fair-catch or tackling player before ball is caught
