# SALUTING The FABULOUS TEAM Of '14 50th YEAR REUNION

The Bellaire High School Fans have the unique pleasure today of playing host to fifteen members of the Fabulous 1914 Football Team and their Coach. They are gathered here in Bellaire for their 50th reunion. They held an informal get-together last night at the American Legion Home where many of their old friends had the pleasure of seeing the Famed 1914 Greats. It was at the end of this great season in 1914 that the well-known phrase of "The All-American Town" was first used.

Although other teams in B. H. S. history have had the same win and loss record, it was this team that attracted the attention of the fans to such an extent as to increase the attendance at the games many fold. Their Coach, J. R. Estabrook, summed it up at one of their past reunions when he said, "unity of purpose," was the key to their spectacular success on the gridiron. One team member expressed his belief that their "willingness to sacrifice to win" was their secret to success.

These men will attend an informal banquet this evening at the Elks Club in Bellaire. There will be no formal speeches; just reflections by the Big Red Greats over their past fifty years. The same unusual team spirit that sent these men to fame on the 16th Street gridiron in 1914 has been instrumental in their still being able to have such a fine turnout after 50 years. 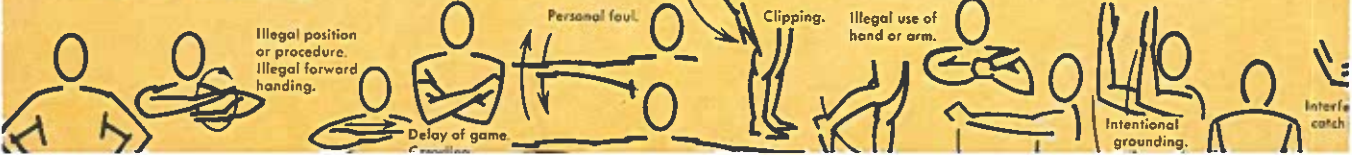

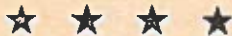
