WESTERN CLASS AA FOOTBALL CONFERENCE

The Western Class AA Football Conference resulted from a movement which was spearheaded by Emil Dupke of Washington, prior to the 1956 season. Others who were active in the original planning, and who made up the conference in its first season were Baldwin High School, coached by Al Crevar; Uniontown High School, coached by Bill Power; and Mt. Lebanon High School, coached by Ralph Fife. In subsequent years, Trinity, Munhall, Canon-McMillan and Chartiers Valley High Schools entered the league.

It was agreed by these schools' athletic leaders that they would place emphasis upon good competition carried on in a proper manner, with the best available facilities and conditions for the boys. The conference from the start has emphasized good sportsmanship.

Emil Dupke of Washington served as first President of the Conference. He was succeeded in 1957 by Al Crevar of Baldwin High School. Uniontown's Bill Power was the 1958 President and Ralph Fife of Mt. Lebanon was the 1959 President. The 1960 President was Nick Klisky of Munhall and the 1961 President was Tony Paesano of Canon-McMillan High School. The 1963 President was Cy Layne of Trinity High School. In 1964 the president was Dave Johnston of Washington High School. Harry Buzzato of Chartiers Valley is the 1965 President.

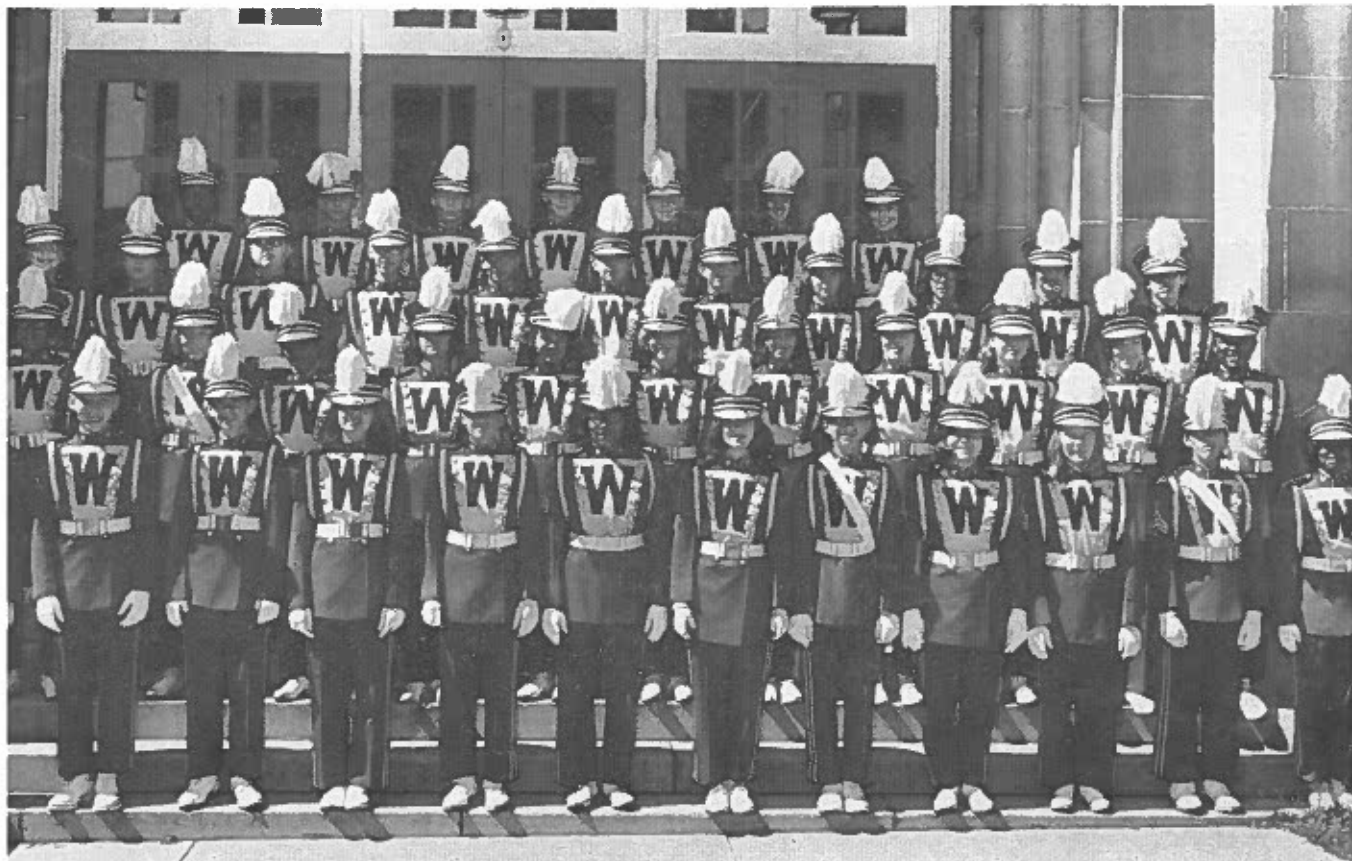
