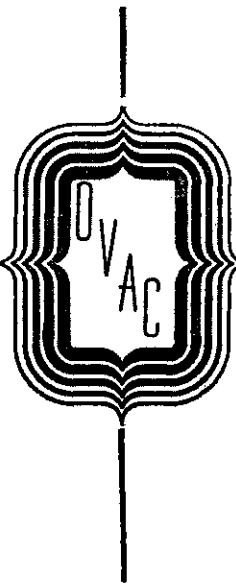

# Snare OVAC Title

Bellaire High won the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference cross country championship on Saturday morning at the Oglebay Park course.

The Big Reds finished with a team score of 56 while Brooke placed second with 59 and Triadelphia wound up with 67 points. They were followed in the team scoring by John Marshall, 63; Martins Ferry, 141; Shadyside, 177; Wheeling and Magnolia, 189; Wheeling Central, 237; and St. Clairsville, 240.

Brooke apparently had the meet won as John Vargo was running 16th place about 20 yards from the finish line when a bone snapped in his leg and he was unable to finish.

Taking first place in the 2:1

mile race was Larry Teeters, of Brooke, who set an OVAC record when he finished in 30 min. 7 secs. Second was Rich Grum, John Marshall, 10:15; followed by Emmett Garlitz, Triadelphia, 10:37; Rich Soly, Brooke, 10:43; Dan Rybeck, Triadelphia, 10:45; Gary Benoush, Bellaire, 10:47; Roger Lewis, Shadyside, 10:55; Gage Lightner, John Marshall, 10:56; Tom Skrabak, Bellaire, 10:58; and Manuel Helmbright, Wheeling, 11:06.

Teeters placed seventh in the West Virginia High School cross country meet last fall at Morgantown. Vargo was taken to Wheeling Hospital where X-rays were taken to determine the extent of his injury.
