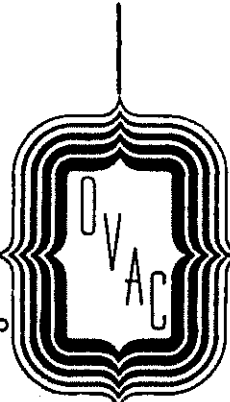

St. Clairsville High captured the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference golf championship Wednesday afternoon with a 13-stroke victory over Triadelphia in an 18-hole playoff at the Oglebay Park Crispin Center course.

George Strager's Red Devils, who won the Ohio-side tournament earlier to qualify for the playoff, finished with a team score of 316 while W.Va. representative Triadelphia wound up with a 329.

Medalist in the match was St. C.'s Brad Kocher with a five-over par score of 76. Gus Mohallis was next with a 77 while Bobby Van Echo had a 79 and Doug Hocking and Monte Beck wound up tied at 84.

Larry Loew paced the Little Reds with an eight-over par 79. He was followed by Fred Cook with an 82; Dave Kaiser, 83; Sam Stavich, 85; and Dave Hicks, 89.
