

# Linsly Again Cops OVAC Swim Crown

Linsly Institute outclassed the field once again in the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference swimming championships, scoring a total of 115 points at the Cadet pool to win the team title for the 26th year in a row Saturday.

Tied for second place behind the Cadets with 51 points each were Brooke and Wheeling Central. Weirton was fourth with 33 points. Shadyside and Weirton did not enter full squads but competed with a few individuals each. Headed by Jerry Carte's two record-breaking triumphs, the Tigers were fifth with 14 points while the Blue Dons wound up with seven points.

Coach Warren Pugh's team won eight events, including both the 200-yd. medley relay and 400-yd. free style relay races.

Shadyside'ssa Carte set pool marks with a 2:20.5 clocking in the 200-yd. individual medley and a 1:05.3 effort in the 100-yd. back stroke. Three other records were turned in by Soldier swimmers.

Linsly's 200-yd. medley relay team set a pool and school mark with a 1:55.8 performance. Sam White set two school and pool marks as he was timed in 23.9 in

the 50-yd. free style and 53.7 in the 100-yd. free style.

The only other double winner in the meet was Linsly's Kerwood Kline, who won the 200 and 400-yd. free style races. Results follow:

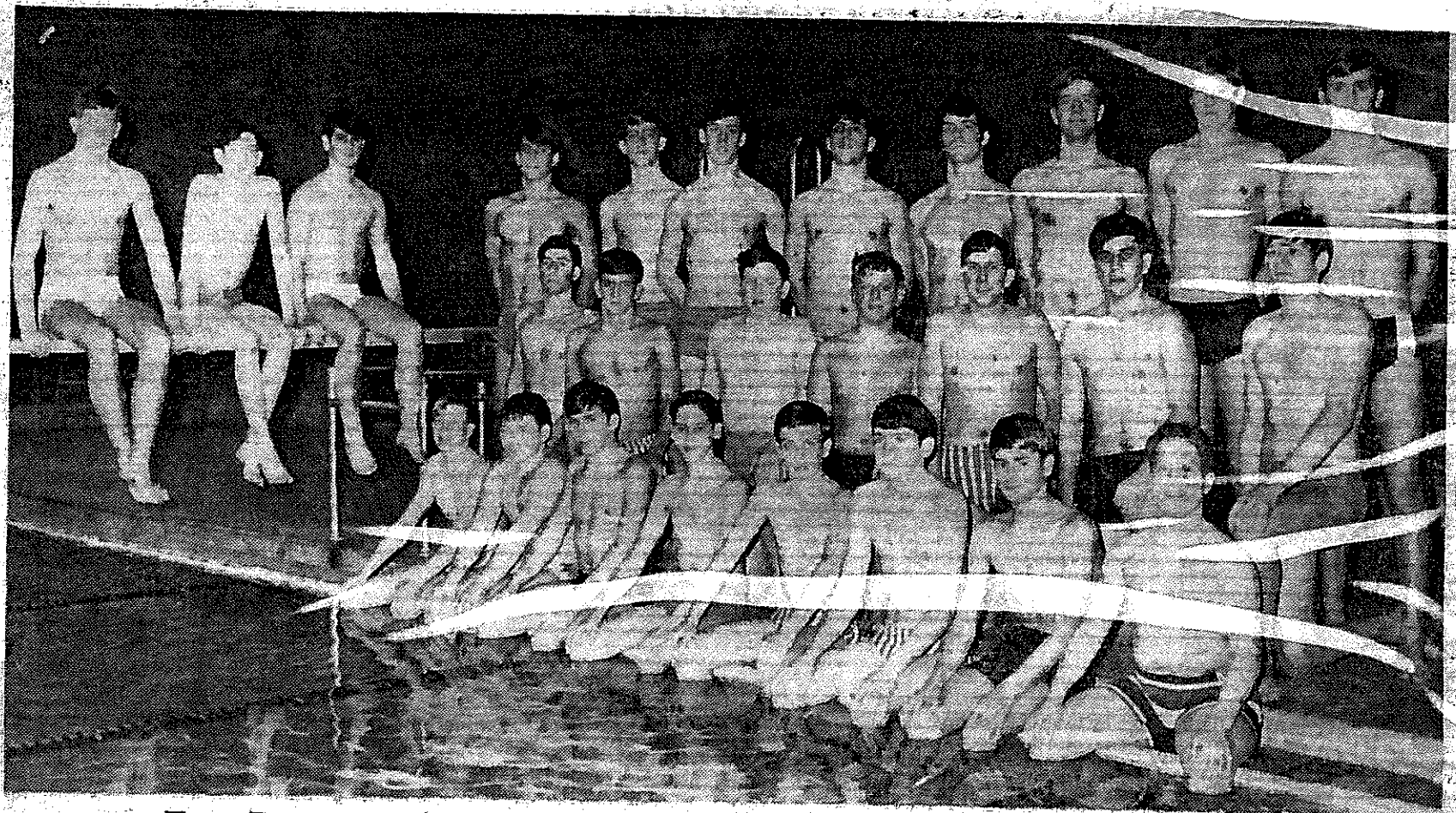

Linsly Military Institute's swimming team, coached by the veteran Warren Pugh, has won the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference championship for the twenty-sixth straight year. In the conference meet, the Cadets piled up 115 points while Brooke and Wheeling Central tied for second place with 51 each. In dual meet competition, the Linsly team was 8-2 as it defeated Brooke, Weirton, and Central twice each and also topped Pittsburgh Peabody and the Fairmont Aquatic Club and lost only to Pittsburgh Central Catholic and Shadyside Academy, of Pittsburgh.
