St. C., Cadiz Woodsfield Golf Champs

St. Clairsville, Cadiz and Woodsfield captured division crowns in the OVAC Ohio-side golf tournament Wednesday afternoon at the Spring Hills course.

The Red Devils took the Class AAA crown with a 327 total followed by Steubenville at 332 and Marietta 335. third at Cadiz copped the Class AA title finishing with a 334 count while Steubenville Central Catholic was runner-up at 342 and Toronto had 346.

Woodsfield finished 40 strokes ahead of its nearest competitor, taking the single A title with a 341 while Beallsville had 381 and Buckeye West was at 384.

Medalist in the event was Steubenville junior Bob Lockett, who sank a 20-foot putt on the final hole to edge John Petrisko, a junior from Steubenville Catholic, by one stroke.

Lockett fired a three-over-par 75, after touring the front nine in two-under.
