Wintersville Golf Champ

Class 4-A champion Wintersville defeated Class AA tilist St. John's Central by one stroke in a one-hole playoff Friday to win the overall title in the OVAC Ohio-side fall golf championship at the Springs Hills Golf Club in East Springfield.

Both Wintersville and St. John's finished the 18-hole tourney with 331 totals, forcing a playoff to determine the overall champ and the winner of the OVAC's championship pennant. After the one-hole playoff, the scores of all five players on each team was totaled and Wintersville declared the champion by one stroke.

St. Clairville, with a 337 score, was the Class AAA champion by six strokes over Steubenville Central, while River was third at 365. Woodsfield won the three-team Class A tourney with a 366, followed by Beallsville, with 374, and Buckeye Trail.

The runnerup to Wintersville in the Class 4-A race was Cambridge, 10 strokes back at 341. Steubenville had 352 and East Liverpool 361 to round out the field. Cadiz, with a 342, was second and Bridgeport third in double-A.

St. Clairville's Mark Hooper was the overall medalist champion, touring the Par-72 Spring Hills course in 76. Wintersville's John Haberfield took the 4-A honors with an 81, while Dennis Irwin of St. John's fired a 78 and Woodsfield Kirk Schwall shot 79.
