# **Everett "Red" Rigel**

**District 12's Honorary**

**Coach - of - the - Year**



Retired teacher, coach, principal-superintendent -- Everett "Red" Rigel graced the eastern Ohio basketball scene as a head mentor for 23 years. He spent 15 of those years, 1949 to 1964, at Madison High School in Guernsey County, and the other eight, 1968 to 1976, at Barnesville High School. From 1964 to 1968 he was superintendent-principal at Madison High School.

Rigel's eight-year record at Barnesville was 68-89. His 1972-1973 club reached the District Class "AA" finals at Steubenville before losing to Wellsville. That was the deepest tournament penetration by any quintet in Barnesville High history.

His 1973-1974 team posted a regular season 16-2 mark to tie the school record for best single season performance. That club was led by Larry Hall, who was later to star at Muskingum College. Hall's career point total of 1206 is still a school standard.

Rigel is a native of Quaker City, Ohio, and a 1943 graduate of Quaker City High School where he was a member of the basketball team. He is a veteran of the armed services, having served 29 months with the "Seabees" during World War II.

He obtained his Bachelor's Degree from Kent State University in education and his Master's Degree from West Virginia University. He and his wife, Mary Ann, continue to reside near Quaker City. They are the parents of three children.

# **RULES OF THE GAME**

**THIS GAME WILL BE PLAYED UNDER**

**THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL RULES:**

1. Man to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
2. A zone press may be used, but must end after the first trap past half court.
3. Each player must play one complete quarter during the first half. This is to be an uninterrupted time in the game. The only exceptions to this rule would be if a player suffers from an illness or injury, or would have accumulated his third personal foul during the first half.
4. All players must be inserted into the game at least once during the second half unless the player is ill, injured, or ineligible.
5. All quarters will be of an eight (8) minute duration.
6. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
7. In case of overtime, one extra period of a three (3) minute duration will be played. If the game is still tied at this point, a second "sudden death" overtime will be played. The winner will be the first team scoring two CONSECUTIVE points.

## ***East Squad Coaches***

**ALLEN GLITCH** -- Allen has been a teacher and coach in the St. Clairsville School System for the past seven years, serving three of those years as a reserve coach and the past two seasons as head coach. He also served as the assistant baseball coach for six years. A 1969 graduate of Bridgeport High School, Allen lettered three years in both baseball and basketball, playing on both squads in 1969 that made it to the state finals before being defeated.
