

# Hazlett, Sosenko Swim Stars

Bert Hazlett of team champion Linsly Institute and Weir High's Eric Sosenko were the individual standouts Wednesday night as the 37th annual Ohio Valley Athletic Conference swimming championships were completed at the Linsly Institute pool.

Both swimmers captured two individual firsts--setting one record each--and were members of record-setting relay teams.

Hazlett's individual record came in the 100-yd. butterfly. He swam the event in 54.35 seconds, breaking the previous mark of 54.40 which was established by former Linsly swimming star Alex Welker in 1977. Hazlett captured the 100-yd. backstroke in 59.36 seconds and teamed with Frank Westphal, Mark Bond and Randy James for a 1:47.91 clocking in the 200-yd. medley relay, which qualified the quartet for the Eastern Interscholastic Swim Meet, scheduled the weekend of Feb. 27-28 at Lawrenceville, N. J.

Sosenko captured the 200-yd. individual medley in 2:09.14 and won the 100-yd. breaststroke event in 1:02.99, shattering his own OVAC record of 1:04.6 in the event.

The Red Rider star then joined teammates Jorgen Anderson, David Baczewski and Steve Wojcik to capture the 400-yd. free style relay in 3:35.62.

In the team scoring, Linsly Institute extended its domination of the OVAC meet to a 37th straight year. The Cadets, who have gained the conference championship each year the meet has been held, collected 409 points, while Brooke was second at 241 and Weir took third place with 209 points. Wheeling Park trailed at 150.
