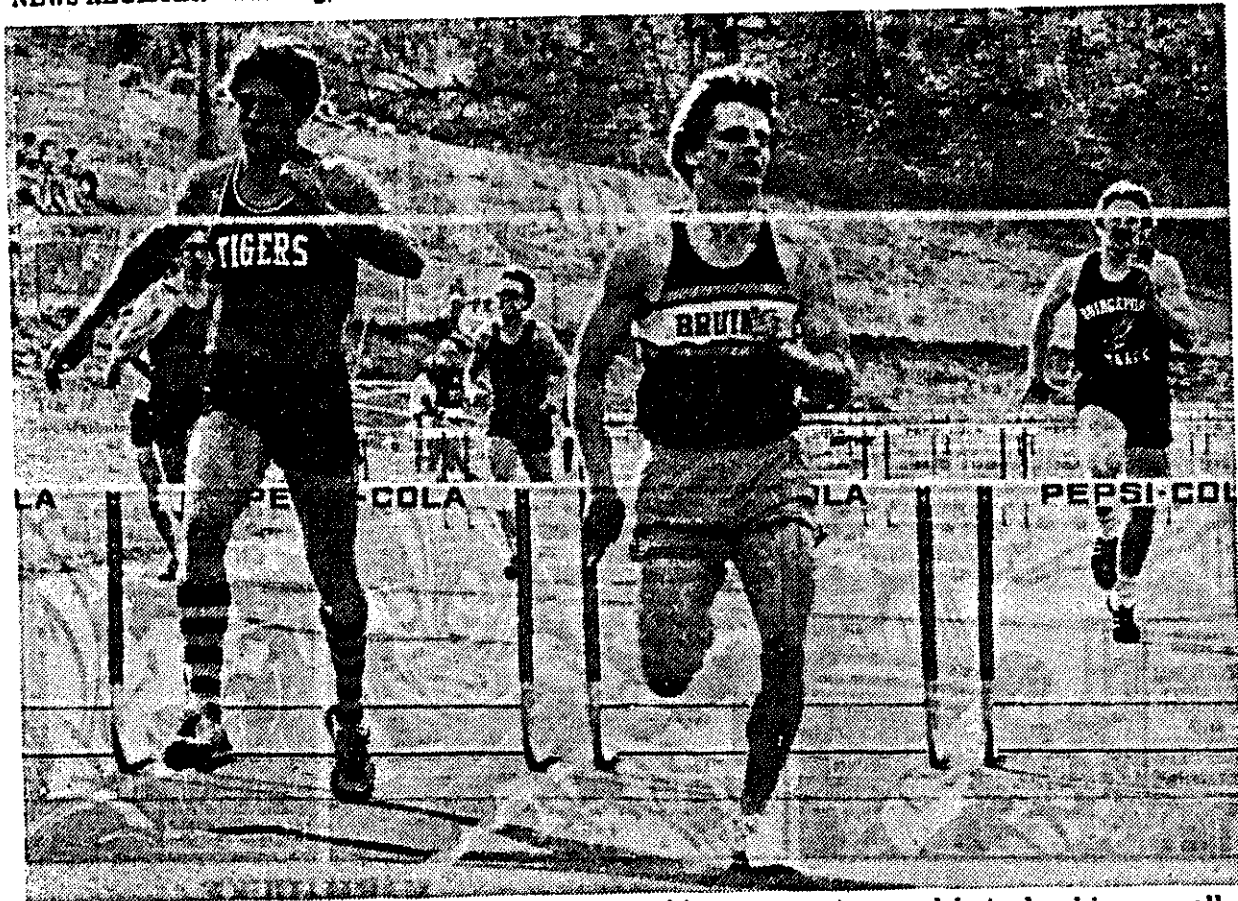

John Marshall, Wellsville and Barnesville are the newly-crowned champions in girls' track and field in the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

In a marathon meet at Shadyside Wednesday, with the action starting in the warm, bright sunshine of the afternoon and concluding in the chilly night air at almost 11:30 p.m., St. Clairsville, Meadowbrook, and Springfield—the three 1981 titlists—were deposed.
