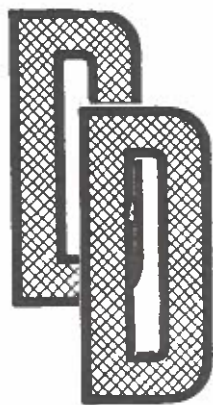

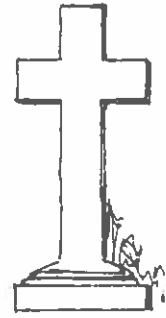
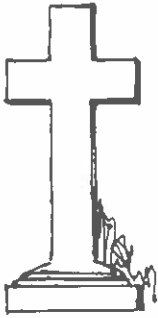

Mr. McKelvey is a charter member of the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan and is currently serving as treasurer.





George A. Ferris

Honorary Chairman

George A. Ferris was elected to the Board of Directors of Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel Corporation on September 20, 1985. At the same time, he was appointed Vice Chairman and Chief Executive Officer.

Mr. Ferris was Vice President - Basic Products Operations for Ford Motor Company until his retirement in 1981. Prior to that time, he was general manager of the company's Steel Division from September, 1968, to October, 1975, when he was elected a company vice president.

He had responsibility for the Steel Division, Glass Division, Casting Division, and the Plastics, Paint and Vinyl Division.

Mr. Ferris joined Ford in 1935 in the Rouge manufacturing complex and became a quality control general foreman in 1943. Two years later he became general foreman of open hearth operations.

Mr. Ferris held a number of Steel Division managerial positions between 1950 and 1960. He was appointed melting operations manager in 1960 and later was named general operations manager of finishing operations. He was named assistant general manager of the division in 1967 and general manager in 1968.

Born September 1, 1916, in Bay City, Michigan, Mr. Ferris holds an associate degree in industrial management from Henry Ford Community College. He also studied industrial management at Wayne State University.

Mr. Ferris and his family reside in Detroit.

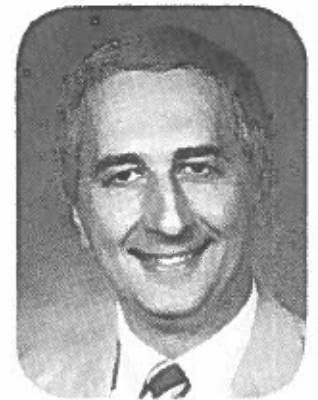

Andy Urbanic

Introducing tonight's "Man of the Year" is Andy Urbanic, Assistant Football Coach at the University of Pittsburgh. Urbanic's long and successful coaching career has deep roots in the Ohio Valley, where he graduated from Bethany College in 1959. From there he went on to become Head Football Coach at Dillonvale High School from 1959-1962, and Head Football Coach at Triadelphia High in 1962 and 1963, before returning to his alma mater as Assistant Football and Track Coach and Head Swimming Coach.

In 1964 he moved on to Wheeling Central High as Head Football Coach. In 1968, Urbanic left Wheeling Central to become Head Football Coach at Penn Hills Senior High in suburban Pittsburgh, where he remained and prospered until 1980. In 19 years as a head coach, Urbanic's teams went 157-50-3, including eight state championships, six undefeated seasons, and a 32-game winning streak at Penn Hills from 1976-1978.

In 1980 he accepted the position of Assistant Football Coach at Pitt. In addition to coaching the Panthers' offensive backfield, Urbanic also has served as Director of the Foge Fazio Football Camp, the Pitt Panther Football Clinic, and the Pitt Spring Benefit Game. He also has had his own summer football youth camp at Edinboro University since 1978.

A member of the American Football Coaches Association, Urbanic has also served as President and Director of the Pennsylvania State High School Coaches Association. Urbanic, his wife, and two daughters reside in Penn Hills.

A Long Time Friend, Gone But Not Forgotten

Paul Maguire

ESPN

Paul Maguire brings to ESPN the kind of experience that television viewers demand from football analysts. His on-camera experience for ESPN encompasses color commentary of action in the college ranks and the USFL.

Maguire, who teams with veteran play-by-play man Jim Simpson for ESPN's telecasts, enjoyed extensive experience in the broadcast booth and on the playing field prior to his employment as an analyst for ESPN.

A 1960 graduate of The Citadel with a degree in physical education, he led the nation in touchdown receptions (10) during his senior year. Maguire played professional football for 11 years as a linebacker and punter with the San Diego Chargers (1960-63) and the Buffalo Bills (1964-70), winning championships in 1963, '64 and '65. Maguire was one of only 19 original AFL players still active at the time of the league's merger with the NFL in 1970. He was named to the Buffalo Bills Silver Anniversary All-Time Team, as a punter in May 1984.

Prior to joining ESPN, Maguire did color commentary of NFL games for NBC (1971-79).

Maguire's aggressive, feisty and often humorous style as a pro football performer is typical of his provocative manner in analyzing telecast action.

Maguire received strong reviews from media critics. Wrote Sports Illustrated's Bill Taaffe, "Expert commentator Paul Maguire has emerged as the equal of ABC's Frank Broyles. Maguire is irreverent, humorous, unpredictable and unpretentious. He's also downright prescient when it comes to predicting plays."

USA Today's Rudy Martzke said of Maguire's transition to the college game from the pro game, "Maguire has moved to the top echelon of college analysts. Maguire's ability to explain is unmatched."

Maguire is a voting panelist for the Associated Press weekly college football poll.

Maguire, who was born on August 22, 1938, lives with his wife Beverly and their children Kelly, Kristin, and Kathryn in Eden, New York.

“Man Of The Year”

Paul S. (Bud) Billiard, who led his Brooke High Bruins to the West Virginia Class AAA State Championship last fall, has been named the 1985 Dapper Dan Man of the Year and will be the guest of honor at the 20th Annual Charity Sports Awards Banquet on Sunday, February 16 at the Wheeling Civic Center.

Billiard is the fifth high school coach to receive the Dapper Dan's highest honor. The others are last year's honoree, Reno Saccoccia of Steubenville Big Red; Tom Korab of Steubenville Central in 1971 and Abe Bryan of Big Red and Glen Trout of Stanton Local, who shared the Man of the Year honors at the first banquet in 1967.

A Wellsburg native, Billiard has spent his entire athletic and coaching career in the Ohio Valley. He earned three varsity letters at Wellsburg High School, received all Valley Honorable Mention and was captain his senior year of 1958-59. He has four varsity letters from his football career at West Liberty State College, earning All WVAC honorable mention as a sophomore, first team on offense as a junior and first team on defense as a senior. He also captained the Hilltoppers as a senior in 1963.

He earned a masters degree in health education from West Virginia University in 1978.

A veteran of 19 years in the teaching profession, Billiard started his coaching career at Central Catholic High School in Wheeling as an assistant to Andy Urbanic.

Urbanic, who went on to a successful coaching career in Pittsburgh high school football and most recently on the staff of the University of Pittsburgh, will present the Man of the Year award to Billiard at the banquet.

After coaching at Wheeling Central from 1967 to 1971, Billiard accepted a position as an assistant on Vince Rea's Brooke High staff in 1971 and also served as assistant wrestling coach until 1973 when he became the head coach in that sport for six years.

He gave up wrestling when he became head coach of the Bruin football squad, replacing the retiring Rea in 1979. Billiard's Brooke teams have compiled an overall record of 67 wins, 15 losses and one tie in seven seasons, capturing five OVAC titles, six Mountaineer League championships and last fall's march to the state title. His teams have been in the West Virginia playoffs six of the seven years he's been at the helm, earning state runner-up honors in 1980.

Billiard coached the 1981 West Virginia All Stars to a 7-6 win over Ohio in the annual all star game at Wheeling and in 1982 served as defensive coordinator for the North squad in its 19-14 victory over the south in West Virginia's annual all star tilt.

Billiard has served on the staffs of many football clinics during the summer months.

The 44-year-old coach is married and the father of three children.

Danny Abramowicz

1986 Hall of Fame Inductee

It's called "beating the odds". The experts would say that a product of a small university, with flat feet and less-than-blinding speed, picked 420th in the draft, would have little chance of even making an NFL roster, especially with ten other wide receivers vying for spots.

But tonight's Hall of Fame inductee did just that, then beat the odds again by going on to set a league record, catching passes in 106 consecutive games. His hustle and determination, reminiscent of a counterpart on the baseball diamond, led him to be called "The Polish Pete Rose."

Danny Abramowicz grew up in Steubenville, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Abramowicz. After a stellar gridiron career at Steubenville Catholic Central High, he went on to Xavier University in Cincinnati. Playing under head coach Ed Biles, Abramowicz had 120 catches for 1,685 yards and 14 touchdowns for the Musketeers.

Still, this 6-1, 195-pounder was a long shot to make the New Orleans Saints 1967 squad, but his "great hands" and determination impressed Saints coach Tom Fears, himself once a great wide receiver. Fears put Abramowicz on the kickoff and punt "suicide squads," where Abramowicz was termed "a real head-hunter."

An injury to starter Jerry Simmons gave Abramowicz his first start. In that seventh game of the season, against the Steelers, Abramowicz hauled in 12 passes. By the end of his rookie season, he had caught 50. The next year, he had 54 receptions, and in 1969 he had 72 (including eight in the final game) to surpass Charley Taylor and Roy Jefferson for the receiving crown. His 1969 exploits earned Abramowicz All-Pro honors, the Saints' MVP and most valuable offensive player awards, the Touchdown Club Award, and selection as New Orleans' most outstanding athlete.

Abramowicz was traded to the San Francisco 49'ers in 1973, and it was there that he set the NFL record for receptions in 106 consecutive games. He carried that record into retirement after the 1974 season, and though it has since been surpassed, the gritty style of play that made it happen has not been forgotten.

Abramowicz settled in New Orleans with his wife, Claudia DiPrinizo Abramowicz, and children Danny, Andy and Stephanie. He is in executive sales and part owner of Major Chemical Co., which services the oil-drilling business.

He is also involved in church-related youth work, the campaign against drug abuse and alcoholism, and Independence Isle, a recreational park for the handicapped. He has served as president of the Saints chapter of NFL Alumni, and has worked as a color analyst on the Saints' Radio Networks.

This is the second time Abramowicz has been honored by the local Dapper Dan organization. In 1975 he was named "Man of the Year" in recognition of his pass-catching record.





Edison C. "Etz" Rine 1986 Hall of Fame Inductee

An outstanding athlete himself, "Etz" Rine established himself among the premier coaches of the Ohio Valley in the 1940's and '50's.

Born at Boggs Run in Marshall County, W. Va., he became a four-sports performer at Moundsville High, where he was graduated in 1938. After a year of independent football with the Moundsville Eagles, he was recruited by West Virginia University and played end on a freshman team that played seven games and lost only to Pitt. In 1931, he transferred to West Virginia Wesleyan, which was then a football power, and became a teammate of the legendary Cliff "Gipp" Battles and Leonard "Feets" Barnum. He started every game at end for the Bobcats for three years in what was a glory era for the Buckhannon institution.

After two years as an assistant coach at Moundsville, he accepted his first head coaching post at Cameron High, where he was 15-15-2 in football for four seasons. He moved to Warwood High School and in his first year there (1941), the Vikings went unbeaten for the first time in the school's history as the Green and White were 9-0 and won not only the city championship but also an Ohio Valley Athletic Association title.

Following a 7-2 season in 1942, Rine entered the U.S. Navy. In the service, he rose from ensign to lieutenant commander. He was awarded the Bronze Star for action in the Mediterranean in 1944.

After the war, Rine became coach at Linsly Military Institute in Wheeling and gave that school some of its most storied teams as his Cadets posted 39 victories against eight losses and one tie in five seasons. In 1947 and '49, his teams suffered only one loss. At that time, the Cadets were playing such teams as Weirton, Wellsburg, Bellaire, Martins Ferry, Steubenville Central, Moundsville, and Boys Town, Neb., in addition to the city schools. His greatest star at Linsly was John Reger, who went on to play in the NFL as a linebacker with the Steelers and Washington Redskins.

This staunch disciplinarian and wily strategist left coaching in 1950 to work for Metropolitan Life Insurance but returned to the sidelines as coach at Wellsburg High in 1952. He was 12-6-1 in two years at Wellsburg and his Orangemen gave their school its first victory over neighboring Follansbee in eight years.

In 1955, Rine returned to Linsly and completed his head coaching career with five campaigns there. His 1955 team lost only one game.

As a head coach, Rine saw his gridders win 114 games against 57 losses and eight ties in 19 seasons.

After he retired from his head coaching post, Rine remained at Linsly as a teacher and superintendent of buildings and grounds. Later, he returned to Wellsburg and coached reserve football at Brooke before going into retirement.

"Etz" also served as a track coach and was a basketball coach four years at Cameron and one year at Linsly. But football was his first love.

Jule Rivlin 1986 Hall of Fame Inductee

Jule Rivlin was one of the basketball greats of his era. As ball-handler and shot-maker, he was a magician. A fiery competitive spirit and a brilliant basketball mind helped make him an outstanding coach, as well as a colorful, crowd-pleasing player.

Born Feb. 2, 1917 at Washington, Pa., the son of Daniel and Celia Rivlin, he came to Wheeling as a teen-ager and was a track and basketball star at Triadelphia High School. In 1935, he won both the 100 and 220-yd. dashes in the state high school track meet.

When "Riv" was a junior in high school, Triadelphia won 20 straight games before a two-point loss to Weirton in the regional tournament.

At Marshall College (now Marshall University), Rivlin twice led the Thundering Herd to Buckeye Conference championships (1938 and '39) as a player and later coached the Big Green to a Mid-American Conference title.

Rivlin established a Marshall record, since eclipsed, when he tallied 530 points in his sophomore year as he led the Herd to a 28-4 record and an appearance in an invitational tournament at Kansas City.

During his senior year, "Riv" tallied 563 points and was second in the nation in scoring to Hank Luisetti as he sparked Marshall to a 26-3 mark. He was picked on the small-college All-American and veteran coach Cam Henderson acclaimed his ace, particularly adept as middle man on the fast break, as "the greatest player I ever coached".

Rivlin went on to the Akron Goodyears, an AAU team, for one year before entering the service in World War 2. He was player-coach for the Fort Warren, Wyoming, team which went to the semi-finals of the national AAU tourney.

Following the war, the Wheelingite joined the Toledo Jeeps of the National Basketball League as player-coach. He has said that his greatest thrill in basketball came at the 1947 World Professional Invitational Tournament at Chicago Stadium, where he was named the most valuable player. His team advanced all the way to the finals before losing to Indianapolis.

Subsequently, Rivlin returned to Wheeling as player-coach of the professional Wheeling Blues. He also coached at McKinley Vocational High. His Blues won three All-American Basketball Conference titles.

Also active in baseball as an umpire and as president of the Intelligencer League, he realized a long-time ambition when named as coach at Marshall in 1955. In his first year in command, the Herd won the Mid-American Conference title and an NCAA tournament berth.

Rivlin remained at Marshall until the end of the 1963 season. He finished his coaching stay there with 100 victories against 88 defeats. Hal Greer, who was to become one of the greatest stars of the NBA, was one of his players.

In 1972, Rivlin was inducted into the West Virginia Sports Hall of Fame. He has subsequently been named to the Marshall University and Wheeling City Halls of Fame.
