A. JAMES MANCHIN
W.VA. STATE TREASURER

A. James Manchin began his "love affair" with West Virginia from a barracks provided by the United Mine Workers Union in Farmington, in Marion County, West Virginia, in 1927. He is the son of the late Kathleen (Mama Kay) and Joseph (Papa Joe) Manchin.

He attended West Virginia University and Fairmont State College, where he earned Bachelor's and Master's degrees in political science, sociology and education. He was a coach and citizenship teacher for seven years in the public school system. Manchin served in the United States Navy during World War II.

His wife, Stephanie Machel Manchin, is a Wheeling native, and they have three children -- Patricia Lee, Mark Anthony Manchin, and Rosanna Manchin Stache. He has seven grandchildren -- Erica Rose Stache and Emily Ann Stache, Crystal Marcella Manchin, Katheleen Maria Theresa Manchin, A. James Manchin II, Tara Rosa Manchin and Scarlet Lee Manchin.

He was elected to the West Virginia House of Delegates in 1949, from Marion County. Later, he was appointed by President John F. Kennedy as State Director of the Farmers Home Administration. Later still, he became special assistant to the national administrator of the Farmers Home Administration. He also served as state director of REAP -- the Rehabilitation Environmental Action Program -- and the success of this program helped earn him the special national recognition award of the "Keep America Beautiful" campaign.

He has received numerous other honors during his public service, including the Freedom's Foundation Award of Valley Forge, the National Outstanding Service award from the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the Law and Order award from the Fairmont Police Department. In 1974, he was named "Mr. West Virginia" by Salem College. He is also the recipient of the Communications Achievement award from International Toastmasters Club, and is listed in "Who's Who in America".

In 1976, he was nominated on the Democrat ticket, and later elected, by the people, to the office of Secretary of State of West Virginia. He was elected to a second term in that office in 1980. In November 1984, he was elected Treasurer of State of West Virginia, and is currently serving the people of West Virginia.

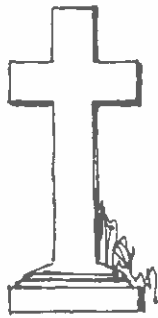

R.S. McKelvey Memorial Award - 1988

Joseph Thomas Jr.

A native of Wellsburg, Thomas played football at Wellsburg High School and the University of Miami in Florida prior to entering military service in 1944. After two years of service football, he played one year of semi-pro football with the WIU Weirton in Weirton. He then signed with the Philadelphia Eagles and was on their pre-season roster in both 1950 and 1951, as a linebacker and end, but both years was put out of action by injuries prior to the NFL campaign. He is a member of the NFL Players' Alumni Association.

Subsequently, Thomas was employed by the Weirton Steel Corp. for 30 years and, since his retirement from the steel company, has been manager of Brooke Hills Park in Wellsburg.

Thomas helped start the Wellsburg Colts football program in 1959 and was head coach until 1977. In 1971, he founded the Mountaineers Youth Football League and served six years as its president. He also served as junior director of the Bethany College Sports Camps, the Church Howley Sports Camps and the Andy Urbanic-Bob Goin Champ of Champions at West Liberty State College in the 1960s and 70s. He was a guest moderator for the Bethany College physical education major's youth football seminars from 1964 to 1969.

Utilizing his experience in youth football, the Wellsburg sports enthusiast authored a book titled "Reading, Writing and Youth Football", which was published in 1985. Because of his authorship of the book, Thomas has been invited to speak at the upcoming Kodak "Coach of the Year" football clinic in Pittsburgh.

He is active in Kiwanis International, past president of the Wellsburg Kiwanis club, a past lieutenant governor of the First District Kiwanis International of West Virginia, and is lieutenant governor-elect of West Virginia Division One of Kiwanis. Joe was instrumental in forming the Bethany/Brooke Hills Kiwanis Club in 1985 and serves as secretary of that organization.

Through his affiliation with Kiwanis, youth football and the Pittsburgh Steelers' chapter of the NFL Alumni Association, Thomas has organized bus trips for handicapped children to attend the annual Steelers' alumni game in Pittsburgh. In addition, he is one of the founders and now president of the C.F. Walker Foundation which was formed in 1985 in memory of the late educator, who was principal of Wellsburg High School. The foundation annually provides two \$500 college scholarships for a graduating female and male student from Brooke High School.

Thomas was recognized by Bethany College in 1969 and West Virginia Northern Community College in 1984 for outstanding achievements in the field of youth and community service. He is past president of the Wellsburg High Booster Club, the Wellsburg Colt Football Assoc., the West Virginia-Ohio All-Star Football Game Assoc., and the W. Va. Northern Panhandle Boosters Association.

Thomas and his wife, Carol, are the parents of two daughters and a son and have five grandchildren.



CARL R. HAMILL AWARD



The Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan introduces a new award this year in honor of Weir High's long-time teacher, coach and civic leader.

Coal Hamill, a long time member of Dapper Dan, coached all three major sports at Weir from 1929 to 1950. He produced many state championship teams and was named to the Hall of Fames at Bethany College, West Virginia Sportswriters, Ohio Valley Coaches, and Dapper Dan.

But Carl Hamill was much more than a successful coach. He was an outstanding civic leader in his community, devoting much time to local organizations and charities.

He took great pride in his later years watching some of "his boys" become the leaders in the community.

This award is to be presented to a coach with at least 20 years of athletics and coaching experience that exemplifies the same leadership characteristics of Coach Hamill. He must be active in civic affairs and charities as well as promoting the higher education of his students and athletes.

Paul Billiard, a veteran Ohio Valley coach has 21 years of coaching experience and began his head coaching career at Broke High in 1979. Like Coach Hamill, he is a perfectionist, and since 1979 he has built one of the finest programs in the state of West Virginia. His teams have to their credit: 91 wins, 17 loses, 1 tie, 6 OVAC Championships, and 8 trips to the playoffs. Twice they were runner up, and twice State Champions. His past season of 13-0 was Brooke's first unblemished record and brought them national recognition as well as the State Championship.

He, too, is an outstanding civic leader not only in his community but all of Brooke County. He has devoted much time to the youth baseball program as well as youth wrestling. He is active in many church and civic organizations in Wellsburg and has appeared on many charity programs in Ohio and West Virginia.

Coach Billiard has also aided many of his athletes in obtaining scholarships. He truly has mirrored the Carl Hamill image.

Dr. Joe Maroon

Dr. Joseph C "Joe" Maroon, a stellar high school and collegiate football player who became one of the nation's leading neurosurgeons, is the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club's Man of the Year.

Dr. Maroon, who is now chairman of the Department of Neurosurgery at Allegheny General Hospital in Pittsburgh, is being honored because of his outstanding work in sports medicine and his close association with athletics throughout his career. He has made enormous contributions to sports because of his surgical skills and his research.

He remains closely associated with sports as team neurosurgeon for the Pittsburgh Steelers. From 1972 through '83, he was also consulting neurosurgeon for the University of Pittsburgh Panthers.

Now 47 years old, Maroon first made headlines in the Ohio Valley as a four-year letterman in football, basketball and baseball at Bellaire St. John's Central High School. He was second team All-OVAC as a sophomore and made all-conference and all-valley as a junior and senior as the 150 pound backfield standout for Coach Henry Healy's Fighting Irish. In his junior year, St. John's

went unbeaten and won an OVAC title and in his senior year, when he made All-Ohio, the Green sustained only one loss. He was the leading scorer and ground-gainer for the Irish and also played as a defensive back. In his senior season, he tallied four touchdowns in four different games.

In the spring of '58, Maroon was selected for all-state baseball laurels and that summer he captained the victorious Ohio team in the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star football game.

A standout in the classroom, as well as on the athletic field, the little halfback also received the Coca-Cola Award for his outstanding scholastic and athletic achievements. Although very small for a college player at 5'6", 150 pounds, He received a football scholarship at Indian University at Bloomington and was a starting halfback in 1960 for the Hoosiers, averaging 5.3 yards per carry and made Academic All-American.

While busy with his career in medicine, he remained active in sports and won the Indianapolis Athletic Club squash championship in 1972 and the Wheeling YMCA Racquetball tournament in 1978. For the last five years, he has been participating in triathlons, such as the National Triathlon at Hilton Head, S. C. in 1986 and 1987; taking first place in his age group in the Bud Light Triathlon at Cleveland last year; and posting his best time of 2 hours, 27 minutes for a one-mile swim, 25-mile bicycle race and a 6.2 mile run in the Miami Triathlon.

The doctor has been active in many professional and scientific societies, not the least of which have been the American College of Sports Medicine, the National Football League Physicians Society, and the National Association for Disabled Athletes. He is now serving on the editorial boards of four medical publications including "The Physician and Sports Medicine".

While attending Indiana University's Medical School from 1961 to '65 he put together a film, "The Initial Management of Football Head and Neck Injuries" which was produced jointly through the Division of Intercollegiate Athletics and the Medical Education Resource Program at the university. His paper received the Ensminger Award, presently annual by the Indiana Chapter of the American College of Surgeons for the best paper on trauma.

Dr. Maroon is the father of three children - Michael, 16; Laura, 12; and Jonathon, 7; and is engaged to Jean Kell.



CASIMIR J. MYSLINSKI

1988 Hall of Fame Inductee

Casimir J. "Cas" Myslinski, 67, a Steubenville High alumnus who became an All-American center with the Army football team at West Point in 1943 and who served from 1968 to '82 as athletic director at the University of Pittsburgh, has been named to the Sports Hall of Fame of the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan.

Myslinski was honored as the Dapper Dans "Man of the Year" for 1976 after his quiet but forceful leadership had helped to bring about a restructuring of the Pitt athletic program, capped by the Panthers' national football championship.

He will become the fifth Dapper Dan "Man of the Year" to enter the Sports Hall of Fame.

A three year football performer for Steubenville Big Red, Myslinski had entered West Point in September of 1941 as part of the last pre-World War II class.

He undertook an accelerated academic program because of the war, and, in that stepped-up program, graduated in three years with a B.S. in engineering. He also earned pilot wings.

Later, he received a master's degree in education from Columbia University.

Myslinski was captain of the 1943 Army football squad and was selected as its most valuable player.

He was named to virtually every first team All-American team at center and received the Knute Rockne Award as the nation's outstanding lineman.

Following his graduation from the U.S. Military Academy, Myslinski entered the Air Force.

Again, he distinguished himself by being named to the All-Air Force team at center.

A career man in the service, he returned to West Point as deputy head of the Department of Physical Education.

In 1956, he was transferred to the United States Air Force Academy and served one season as assistant football coach under Buck Shaw, in addition to heading up the physical education department.

Myslinski returned to civilian life in 1967. Retiring from the service with the rank of lieutenant colonel, he was named director of athletics at Pitt in 1968 by Chancellor Wesley W. Posvar, who was intent upon enhancing the university's national and international reputation - both academically and athletically.

It was after Myslinski, with Posvar's approval, brought in Johnny Majors as football coach in 1973 that the Panthers returned to stature in the sport which they had not enjoyed since the days of the legendary Dr. "Jock" Sutherland.

When Majors returned to his alma mater, Tennessee, after the national championship season, Jackie Sherrill was hired as coach.

While Myslinski was athletic director, Pitt had eight football bowl trips, a football national title, three basketball tournament teams, and nearly 60 All-Americans in various sports.

The Steubenville product was a leader in implementing a dynamic women's athletic program at the university.

He was also responsible for uniting several contributing bodies to the athletic program to form the now thriving Pitt Golden Panthers Boosters Club.

Cas, and his wife, Sandy, have four married children - Linda, Michael, Dorothy and Patricia.





Donald "Don" Fleming 1988 Hall of Fame Inductee

Donald "Don" Fleming, an All-Southeastern Conference end with the University of Florida Gators and a star defensive back with the Cleveland Browns, will officially get inducted into the Dapper Dan's Sports Hall of Fame at tonight's dinner.

Fleming, who hailed from Shadyside, was just a week shy of his 26th birthday when he was accidentally electrocuted while working as an engineer with a sewer construction crew in Florida. Ironically, his death came on the same day that the Browns had announced that he and his close friend and teammate, Bernie Parrish, had signed for the 1963 season.

Fleming, is regarded as one of his home town's all-time athletic greats, and in his memory the athletic stadium at Shadyside was named 'Fleming Field' as was the Cleveland Browns' practice facility. He was the brother of the current Shadyside High football coach David "Ty" Fleming.

At Shadyside High, Fleming was a standout in football, basketball and baseball, was co-captain of the 1954 football team, coached by Steve "Whitey" Magyar, which was the first team in the school's history to complete its season with a perfect record

and win an Ohio Valley Athletic Conference championship. Shadyside was the highest-scoring team in the valley in '54 and Fleming was an All-Eastern Ohio, All-OVAC and all-valley performer. He established a reputation as a fiery competitor who was equally brilliant on offense and defense.

He also played on an OVAC championship basketball team and was a heavy hitter and catcher-outfielder in baseball. Later he played baseball for the Shadyside Civics and was one of the outstanding hitters in the Times-Leader Twilight League.

Fleming weighted only about 175 pounds when he entered the University at Gainesville, Florida, and became a three-year letterman in football as an end for the Gators. As a senior he was captain of the team and an All-Southeastern Conference selection on a squad that played in the Gator Bowl game, and was also captain of the Florida baseball team which won the Southeastern Conference championship and an NCAA tournament berth.

Drafted by the Chicago Cardinals, he elected to go to graduate school during 1959-60, but with the urging of Parrish, the Browns made a deal with the Cards to obtain rights to him. With his weight up to 190 and sacrificing no speed, he reported to Coach Paul Brown in 1960 and became a regular safety in his rookie year. In 1962, he was picked by The Sporting News as a member of the NFL all-league team.

He was posthumously inducted into both the Florida Sportswriters' Hall of Fame and the University of Florida Hall of Fame; and the Florida Alumni Association of the university established an award in his memory.

Alex Groza 1988 Hall of Fame Inductee

Alex Groza, three-time All-American basketball star at the University of Kentucky and twice the most valuable player in the NCAA tournament, has been voted into the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club's Sports Hall of Fame.

The former Martins Ferrian, now 61 years old and residing in Calif., where he is employed as Pacific sales manager of the chemical division of the Reynolds Corp., was the leading choice on a ballot that listed the names of 12 nominees for the Dapper Dan honor.

"Big Al", a member of Kentucky's legendary Fabulous Five, is the brother of Lou Groza, the former all-pro offensive tackle and record-setting placekicking great of the Cleveland Browns who entered the Dapper Dan shrine in 1969 and into the Pro Football Hall of Fame at Canton in 1974.

Alex led the Purple Riders to the Ohio basketball tournament semi-finals in 1943 and '44 and was the state's top scorer in '44 with 628 points as he made All-Ohio.

In his three years as a regular with the Rider varsity, Ferry suffered a total of only four losses and won 72 games.

In his last two seasons, the Purple Riders were 50-2; winning 24 in a row before losing to Newark High in the semifinals of the 1943 Ohio tournament and won 26 straight before bowing to Middletown in the 1944 semi's.

Recruited by the legendary Adolph Rupp, Groza -- rail thin and 6'5½" -- sparked the Univ. of Kentucky Wildcats to 11 straight wins in his freshman season before entering the army. After returning from the army at 6'7" and 220 pounds he was the boss of the backboards as Kentucky posted a 34-3 record and was runnerup to Utah in the NIT.

As a junior and senior, "Big Al" was leading scorer and rebounder on Kentucky's "Fabulous Five", which won two successive NCAA championships and captured 68 victories in 73 starts. He was the most valuable player in the NCAA tournament in 1948 and 49. In the summer of '48 the "Fabulous Five" went to the Olympics in London as a major part of the US. team, which won the gold medal. In fact, Groza was the top scorer on the Olympic team.

He was a three-time All-American. With him in the lineup, the Wildcats were 113-8. In 1949 he scored a school record 698 points. That record stood for 20 years. In his career, Groza tallied 1,744 points, which was a Kentucky record until Cotton Nash broke it in 1964.

The Martins Ferrian played two years in the NBA with the Indianapolis Olympians. In his rookie season he led his team to the Western Division championship and was second leading scorer in the league for two straight years and led the NBA in rebounding both seasons.

Groza coached at little Bellarmine College in Louisville. He coached there from 1959 to 1966. In 1969 he took a front office job with the Kentucky Colonels of the ABA and was named assistant general manager in 1970. In 1972 he moved to San Diego as general manager of the San Diego Conquistadors' ABA team.





Dr. Clyde Campbell

Honorary Chairman

This year's honorary chairman for the 22nd annual Dapper Dan charity awards banquet is Dr. Clyde D. Campbell, president of West Liberty State College.

The 27th president of West Liberty, Campbell is a native of Wheeling and a 1948 graduate of Warwood High. He obtained BS and BA degrees from West Liberty and earned his master's in biological chemistry from North Carolina State University in 1955. He obtained his doctorate in biological and organic chemistry from West Virginia University in 1958.

After he claimed his doctorate, Campbell returned to WLSC, where he taught chemistry for three years before joining Mobay Chemical Co. as a senior research chemist. During his seven years with Mobay, Campbell did fundamental research involving polyurethane polymers and was responsible for recruiting scientific research personnel for Mobay from selected universities. As a result of his research, he holds 31 foreign and domestic patents.

He returned to West Liberty in 1967 as chairman of the School of Natural Sciences and professor of chemistry. Subsequently, he served in the capacities of director of the School of Health Professions, associate academic dean, dean of administration and academic dean.

Campbell is a former member of the Ohio County Board of Education and past president of that group. He has also served as chairman of the board of directors of the Ohio County Heart Association.

He is president of the board of directors of the West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. He is also a member of the American Chemical Society, the West Virginia Chemical Society, the West Virginia Academy of Science, the Blue Pencil Club of Wheeling, and the Wheeling Rotary Club. He is an ex officio member of the board of directors of Oglebay Institute.

Dr. Campbell is being honored for his wide range of interests and his dedication in the development of young people. He has established himself as one of the outstanding citizens in the valley -- not only because of the leadership he provides at West Liberty but because he believes academics and athletics can be melded constructively.

Toastmaster

He was graduated from Weir Senior High School in 1956. He attended West Virginia University, Tulane University, The University of Steubenville and received a B.S. degree from West Virginia Tech in Vocational Education.

His work experience has included positions in men's wear retailing with Rodak's Mens Shop in Weirton, purchasing department of Weirton Steel Division, Field Representative for National Lubricating Products in Brilliant, Ohio, Purchasing agent of the Hancock County Schools and Placement Coordinator of the John D. Rockefeller IV Vo-Tech Center.

Over the past 34 years he has been affiliated with radio station WEIR as sports director. In that time he has broadcast basketball, football and baseball games throughout West Virginia and Ohio and also has broadcast in Pennsylvania over WEDO in McKeesport.

He has been involved in various civic and professional organizations including Past President of the Weirton Rotary Club, Past Grand Knight of the Weirton Knights of Columbus, Weirton Community Chest, the National Institute of Government Purchasing and the American Association of School Administrators, in addition to membership in local booster clubs and the Dapper Dan Club. He was elected in 1986 as a Hancock County Commissioner. Mr. Sorrenti has wide experience as a toastmaster and master of ceremonies throughout the Ohio Valley at various sports gatherings.

He is married to the former Judy Difederico of Steubenville and they have three children - J.J., 22 years old; Janna, 20 years; and Antoinette, 17 years old.

GARY ANDERSON

Gary Anderson, field goal kicker for the Pittsburgh Steelers, never saw American football until he came to the United States from Parys, Orange Free State, South Africa. He now resides in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. He graduated from Brettonwood High in Durban in South Africa and then his family moved to Dowington, Pa. where he attended a Philadelphia Eagles' free agent tryout camp and was offered a contract, but with college eligibility remaining, was recommended to Syracuse.

In June of 1982 he became a U.S. Citizen.

Gary ranks as the NFL's all-time most accurate field goal kicker with a career mark of 115/149. He holds eight team records including most points scored in a single season, most field goals in a single season, most field goals in one game, longest field goal, the highest field goal percentage for a career and a single season, and most consecutive field goals made, plus the most consecutive PATs made. He also holds the longest current PAT streak (153) to date.

He is the third-leading scorer in the Steelers' team history with 522 points, needing 79 points to move ahead of Franco Harris into second place behind Roy Gerela. He also needs 32 field goals to break Gerela's career mark of 146.

A threat to score once the Steelers cross midfield, he has booted the three longest field goals in the team's history - 55, 53, and 52 yards. He possesses a powerful leg and consistently puts kickoffs near the opponent's goal line. He had a few opportunities in early 1986 as the offense struggled, which resulted in his lowest point total since his rookie year after three consecutive seasons as AFC scoring leader.

Gary was the first AFC player to win three straight scoring crowns since Gino Cappelletti won four in 1963-66. In 1986 he converted 21 of 32 field goal attempts adding 32/32 PATS for 95 points. In 1985 he broke four team records and won his third straight conference scoring title and his second trip to the Pro Bowl. His record includes 139 points, 33 field goals, five field goals in one game, and 18 consecutive field goals.

He was named Steelers' Most Valuable Player in 1983 and earned a first Pro Bowl trip after scoring 119 points to claim first conference scoring crown. In 1982 he received the NFL all-rookie honors in a strike-shortened season. He enters 1987 as the tenth leading scorer among active AFC players.

Gary graduated with a degree in management-marketing and completed a career with the NCAA recording an 87.4 percent success rate on field goals and was the team's leading scorer each of final two seasons, including 18 of 19 field goal attempts as a senior in 1981. He has a career perfect 72 of 72 on PATS and was the soccer team's top scorer as a freshman and also played rugby.

In the off-season he works as an investment broker for Hefren-Tillotson in Pittsburgh, where he is also active in local charities including sponsoring the annual American Heart Association golf tournament and working with Adelphoi Village in Latrobe, Pa. His wife Carol was on girls' Pennsylvania state championship basketball team at Shaler High in 1980 and is a former championship water skier.
