Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Criteria

1988 HALL OF FAME/WALL OF FAME INDUCTIONS

Today, September 17, 1988 is a very special day for Bellaire High School. This afternoon is the sixth annual Bellaire High School Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame inductions. Today at halftime, members of the Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame will be introduced. They were officially inducted into the Hall/Wall of Fame at ceremonies occurring in the high school cafeteria at 11:00 this morning.

Criteria for the **Hall of Fame** is the following:

a. A member must be or have been a Bellaire High School student

b. Any individual team winning a state championship

c. Any captain of a major college team (major college to be interpreted as in NCAA Division I

Note: In that it was difficult determining whether some of the larger colleges were Division I at the time of the participant's captaincy, it was decided that all major colleges or universities would be considered, rather than only Division I, up to and including the 1984 school year.

d. Any first team AP or UPI All-American selection - This will include all NCAA Divisions, including NAIA

e. Any place winners (Top six places). This will include all NCAA Divisions, including NAIA.

f. Any member of the United States Olympic Team.

g. An established member of any of the major professional teams sponsored by the United States (established member to be interpreted as two or more years of registered participation unless injured).

NOTE: It was decided, through board adopted policy, in February, 1987, that the following would be included in the Hall of Fame Policy: "Not more than two members (not meeting the above criteria), selected by unanimous vote of the Hall/Wall of Fame Committee each year, will be considered through written nomination and information to support the nomination presented to and considered by the committee. This will apply to public nominations only and will be retroactive through 1987."

Criteria for the **Wall of Fame** is the following:

a. All regional, district and OVAC championship teams, along with athletes who made All-State

b. A student who has distinguished himself/herself in athletics and has brought credit to Bellaire High School will be considered by the Hall of Fame committee for induction through recommendations made to the committee.

c. Consideration will be given to non-Bellaire High School graduates who have distinguished themselves in athletics which has brought credit to Bellaire High School, as recommended to the Hall of Fame committee.

The Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Committee consists of two board members, Mr. Bruce Dunlap, Jr. and Mr. Dan Frizzi, Sr.; two coaches, Mr. Terry Brinker, and Mr. John Magistro; two Touchdown Club members, Mr. Roosevelt Henry, and Mr. Dave Ice; three people from the community, Mr. John Myers, Mr. Leo Ragni, and Mr. Kelley Archer.

Mr. Busby participated in football and track at West Liberty State College where he was chosen as co-captain of the football team and chosen All-NAIA All-American, as well as All-Conference. In track, he held the school record for the shot put for several years. After leaving West Liberty State College, he had a brief pro career with the Cleveland Browns, the Wheeling Ironmen, and the Ohio Valley Panthers. In addition, Mr. Busby served as an assistant football coach for two years at St. John Central High School.

MR. JOHN CLARK was a charter member of the Bellaire Touchdown Club and the Bellaire Relays Committee. He served as a track official for 35 years and received the Cal Giffin Track Award in 1985. In addition, he was chosen as the Honorary Referee for the Bellaire Relays in 1982. Mr. Clark was well-known as a track official and served as head timer in the Ohio State Championships for fifteen years.

MR. GENE CROSS, a 1951 graduate of Bellaire High School, was a two-year letterman in football and a three-year letterman in basketball where he was chosen to the All-Eastern Ohio All-Star Team as a scoring leader. He also participated in track at Bellaire High School and was an Ohio Valley Junior Independent Tennis Champion and American Legion baseball participant. He went on to play at West Liberty State College where he was a running back in football for two years, participated in basketball for two years, and was a member of the All-Conference Championship Team during those two years. Mr. Cross played one year of baseball professionally with the St. Louis Cardinals organization in Albany, Georgia, and played five years semi-pro baseball. After graduation from Bellaire High School he attended Dawson College on a full scholarship where he lettered two years in basketball and was a member of the Big Sky Empire Conference Championship Team before he was sidelined by an injury. Mr. Ewart went on to graduate from West Liberty State College in 1980 with a Business Administration Degree.

MR. WAYNE FARMER, a 1955 graduate of Bellaire High School, lettered two years in football and two years in track, being chosen to numerous All-Star Teams in football. He graduated from Purdue University in 1960 where he was a three-year letterman in football, was chosen to many All-Opponent Teams in the Big Ten, was a First-Team All-Big Ten Honoree, and was selected as an Honorable Mention All-American.

MR. GERALD FARNARIO, a 1955 graduate of Bellaire High School, was a three-year letterman in football. He was chosen as an All-Eastern Ohio Honoree, chosen to the All-State Team, and was captain of our 1954 OVAC Championship football team. He also captained the Ohio All-Stars in the Ohio/West Virginia All-Star game and was chosen as the Most Valuable Player in that game. Mr. Farnario attended the University of Kentucky for one year.

MISS LUCILLE FITCH is a 1945 graduate of Bellaire High School who coached Girls' Basketball from 1953 to 1976 and also in 1982. Miss Fitch taught at Bellaire High School from 1953 to 1982. Her girls' basketball team, both varsity and reserve, remained undefeated during an 8 1/2 year period from 1961 to 1968. During a period of time in which no Ohio State Girl's Championship existed, her teams were ranked annually as some of the best in Ohio. Miss Fitch is a graduate of Bethany College.

MR. RICHARD GIANANGELI, a 1967 graduate of Bellaire High School, lettered two years in football and basketball. In football he was chosen as the Most Valuable Player, rushing for 800 yards, scoring fifteen touchdowns and nineteen extra points. He was also the Most Valuable Player in the Ohio/West Virginia All-Star Game and was chosen to numerous All-Star teams. In basketball, he was a member of the OVAC Championship Team in 1967. In both basketball and football, teams he participated on were two of the highest scoring teams in Bellaire's history.

MR. CALVIN GIFFIN, a 1947 Bellaire High School graduate, was a three-sport letterman, participating in football, basketball and track. He was a member of the 1946 Bellaire OVAC Champion football squad and he played in the Ohio/West Virginia All-Star football game. At West Liberty State College, he received his B.S. Degree in 1951 and a Master's Degree from West Virginia University in 1966. Mr. Giffin served as OVAC president in 1973, was a member of the Ohio High School Athletic Association, and received two awards of merit from the OHSAA. He was chosen as a member of the track Hall of Fame by the Ohio Association of Track Coaches, posthumously received an Alumni Achievement Award from West Liberty State College in 1976, was a Commissioner of the OVAC football and basketball officials, a member and past president of the Eastern Ohio Coaching Association and a member of the State Board of Control of the OHSAA. In addition, he was cross country, track and assistant football coach in his many years as a teacher/coach at Bellaire High School.

MR. EDDIE GLASER, a 1923 graduate of Bellaire High School, was a two-year letterman in football as quarterback and participated as a third baseman and catcher on the baseball team.

MR. CHARLES HORNE, SR., a 1926 graduate of Bellaire High School, lettered four years in football, playing positions of guard and fullback. He was chosen as a member of the All-Valley and All-OVAC teams. He attended Muskingum College for three years and was the second player from Bellaire High School to play in Ohio Stadium when Muskingum played Ohio State.

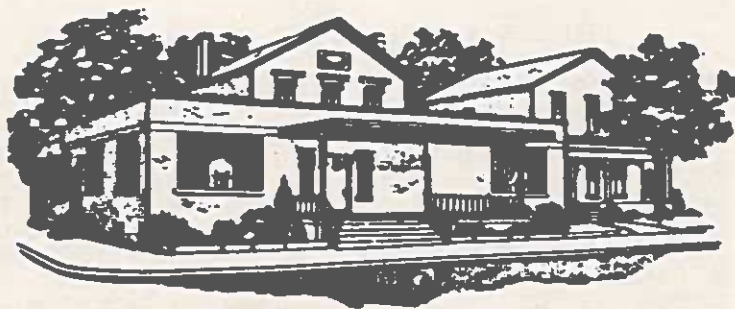

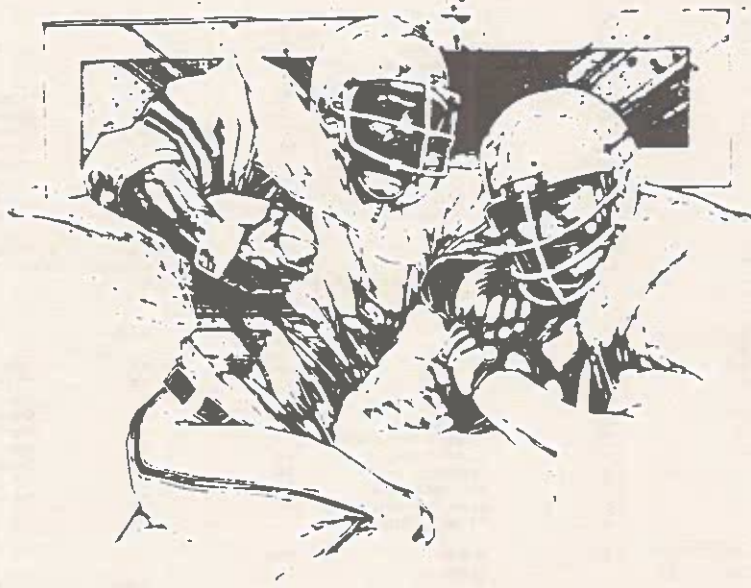

CLASS OF 1988

MR. DAVE HUDSON, a 1968 graduate of Bellaire High School, was a three-year letterman in football, serving as co-captain, and was a two-year letterman in basketball and track. He was chosen to numerous All-Star teams in football, was co-captain of the Ohio All-Stars in 1968, and was chosen as the Most Valuable Football Player. He received his B.S. degree from West Virginia University in 1972 and an M.S. from West Virginia University in 1974. Mr. Hudson received a full scholarship in football to West Virginia University and was a letterman for the Mountaineers.

MR. ANELLO LIBERATI graduated from Bellaire High School in 1952 where he was a three-year letterman in football, being chosen to the All-Valley, All-East Ohio and All-State football teams where he played offensive guard and defensive linebacker for the Big Reds. He was a three-year letterman in football at Kent State, graduating in 1955. Mr. Liberati served as an Ohio Valley football official on the high school, college, and semi-pro levels for thirty-one years.

MR. ARTHUR L. 'BUDDY' MATTHEWS played center in football for three years and was a guard and forward in basketball. He also participated in baseball.

MR. JOHN MALIK, SR. graduated from Bellaire High School in 1927. He participated in football, basketball and track and was a four-year letterman in football, being chosen to various All-Star Teams. Mr. Malik attended Notre Dame University and played under Knute Rockne until he was injured in his sophomore year.

MR. SYLVAN 'SHUMAN' MENDELSON graduated from Bellaire High School in 1934 where he was a four-year letterman in basketball, holding the record for the most points scored, was captain of the basketball team his senior season and was chosen to the All-Ohio Valley basketball team for three years. In addition, he was a two-year letterman in football and was rated the best softball pitcher in the Ohio Valley in Fast Pitch Softball. He attended Blue Ridge Prep School in Hendersonville, North Carolina, participating in football and went on to Ohio State University where he was a one-year letterman in basketball and football.

MR. DAN MLYNEK, a 1974 Bellaire High School graduate, participated in football and track. He was chosen as the Outstanding Athlete in 1974 in track and was chosen as the Most Valuable Player by the Big Reds Touchdown Club in 1973. He received a sportsmanship award in 1972 presented by the St. Johns Central Boosters and received the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Outstanding Achievement Award in football in 1974. He was chosen to the UPI "AA" All-Ohio Team in 1972 and 1973, and was on the first team defense in the North/South Game in Canton, Ohio in 1974. In addition, he was also chosen to the OVAC All-Conference Team in 1973.

MR. GEORGE 'RED' MOONEY graduated from Bellaire High School in 1939. In football, he was a quarterback and was chosen All-Valley in 1937 and 1938. He went to West Nottingham Academy where he was honorary captain of the football team, graduating in 1941. He attended the University of Miami until his senior season where he was fullback and halfback and left college because of a football injury to enter the Marine Corps.

MR. GEORGE E. NEFF, a 1940 Bellaire High School graduate, lettered three years in football at the position of left guard, being chosen to the First-Team All-Ohio Valley football team in 1939. He was also a four-year letterman in track. He attended Ohio State University in 1943 where he lettered in football in 1943 and 1944 on teams that went undefeated and won the Big Ten Championship in 1944. He was voted All-Big Ten guard in 1944, playing football for the Detroit Lions in 1946. He has been active in baseball in the Ohio Valley, playing for and assisting the Bellaire Civic Teams. He was elected Belmont County Sheriff for sixteen years, from 1961-1976.

CLASS OF 1988

MR. BOYD NELSON, a graduate of Bellaire High School in 1945, attended Ohio University for one year. Mr. Nelson has been a photographer for the Martins Ferry TIMES LEADER for the past forty years. He is known throughout the Ohio Valley and the states of Ohio and West Virginia as one of the premiere athletic photographers. Mr. Nelson is highly respected for his willingness to donate his time to showcase Ohio Valley talent and to help young people of the Ohio Valley. His tireless efforts on behalf of the youth of our area are known state-wide.

MR. JOHN P. O'GRADY, a 1948 graduate of Bellaire High School, was a three-year letterman in track and football where he served as captain of the football team in 1947. Mr. O'Grady attended the University of Tennessee for one year.

MR. JOHN W. OSTRANDER was a 1971 graduate of Bellaire High School. He lettered three years in football, two years in baseball and one year in track. In football he was chosen to the UPI and Ap All-State Teams and was defensive captain of the All-Valley Team. In addition, Mr. Ostrander was chosen as Tri-Captain of the All-Eastern Ohio Team and captain of the All-OVAC squad. He was also chosen as the Most Valuable Player at Bellaire High School and in baseball was chosen to the All-District Eastern Ohio All-Star Teams.

MR. KELLY SHERWOOD graduated from Bellaire High School in 1971 and was a three-year letterman in football, being chosen to the All-OVAC Team three years, was a member of the All-Valley team two years and the All-District Team two years. He was also chosen honorable mention All-State. Mr. Sherwood held the school record of 40 catches in 1969 and was a three-year letterman in track. He received a scholarship to Marshall University where he lettered in football in his freshman and sophomore years.

MR. PETER R. SKORICH, a 1947 Bellaire High School graduate, served as president of his senior class and was chosen to All-Valley, All-Eastern Ohio, and Honorable Mention All-State Teams in football. In track he achieved several first place finishes and lettered in basketball. He attended Michigan State University, California State University and the University of Redlands. He received a B.S. degree in Business Administration and M.S. degree in Management with a grade point average of 4.00. At Michigan State University he participated in football two years.

MR. JIM SOSTARICH is a 1967 graduate of Bellaire High School. He was a three-year letterman in football, achieving First Team All-Eastern Ohio two years, First Team All-OVAC two years and he was selected to play in the Ohio/West Virginia All-Star game, but could not play because of signing a four-year college scholarship to Marshall University. Mr. Sostarich received a full scholarship to Marshall University and served as co-captain of the freshman football team. He graduated from Marshall University in 1971 with a B.A. in marketing and finance.

MR. JAMES F. TEKELY, SR. is a 1952 graduate of Bellaire High School where he was a four-year letterman in track, serving as co-captain his senior year, a three-year letterman in football, serving as co-captain. In addition, Mr. Tekely was a one-year letterman in baseball and was All-Valley and All-District in track.

MR. STEPHEN C. VALLORIC was a member of the Bellaire High School football and basketball teams in 1921, a year in which they were undefeated under Coach Galbraith. He played quarterback and was the 12th man on the squad. In 1922 Mr. Valloric quarterbacked the team, calling signals from an end position. He served as Athletic Director at St. Johns Central High School in Bellaire from 1945-1975.

MR. ARNOLD SALVATERRA, a 1937 graduate of Bellaire High School, lettered in football, basketball and softball. He attended the University of Michigan for 1 1/2 years, graduating from Ohio State University in 1947. Mr. Salvaterra was a member of the freshman football team at the University of Michigan.
