

# PREFFACE

Below you will find listed the O.V.A.C. TRACK FORMAT as it is found in the 1988-89 edition of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Directory and Constitution. It is presented here for those who may not have access to a copy of the Directory. Some of the information presented in the manual is an expansion of the information presented below:

- There will be four (4) Class Championship Meets for boys and three (3) for girls.
- 2. Each school will compete in its own calss.
- 3. Meets will be held on May 3, 4, 5, & 6, and sites and directors for all meets will be assigned by the O.V.A.C. Additional information will be sent by the O.V.A.C.
- 4. Sites and directors for all meets have been recommended by the OVAC Track Committee.
- National Federation Track Rules shall govern all phases of the meets unless specifically covered in the 1986 director's manual.
- 6. The Champion and Runer-up teams in all classes shall receive an award.
- 7. The top six (6) finishers in each event shall receive an award.
- 8. The entry fee will be \$ 30.00 with NO MAXIMUMS on participants. This is to mean a separate fee for each boys and girls team.
- The OVAC Track Committee shall be responsible for directing and supervising all Class Championship Meets.
- 10. Photo electric timer will be used for all class meets.

### EVENT INFORMATION

### RULE CHANGES:

Relay Races - 4x400 meter Relay

Old Rule - 4x400M is run in lanes through two laps, usingt four turn stagger starting lines (blue). The first exchange uses same exchange zone as used for second exchange in 4x200M. The second exchange uses uses regular 4x400M exchange zone. After second exchange, the third relay runner may cut to the inside of the track with a clear one and one-half stride lead. The fourth runner will take a position in the exchange zone relative to a teammates position coming out of the last curve onto the straight-away before the exchange.

New Rule - 4x400M is run in lanes through one lap, using two turn stagger starting lines (red). The first exchange uses the regular 4x400M exchange zone. After first exchange, the second relay runner may cut to the inside of the track with a clear one and one-half stride lead. The third and fourth runners will take a position in the exchange zone relative to a teammates position coming out of the last curve onto the straight-away before the exchange.

### ORDER OF EVENTS

On the following pages are found the established order of events for both the Boys and Girls O.V.A.C. Track Meets. These Order of Events are preceded by lists of the order in which field events and some running events will be run for the next five years (thru 1993).

The Order of Events has been established keeping in mind the separation of specific types of races as much as possible so that a minimum of athletes will have to run races back-to-back. It is a combination of the order of events as run in the State of Ohio and the State of West Virginia.
