# Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Criteria

## 1990 HALL OF FAME/WALL OF FAME INDUCTIONS

Today, September 15, 1990, is a very special day for Bellaire High School. This afternoon is the eighth annual Bellaire High School Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame inductions. Today at halftime, members of the Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame will be introduced. They were officially inducted into the Hall/Wall of Fame at ceremonies occurring in the high school cafeteria at 11:00 this morning.

Criteria for the **Hall of Fame** is the following:

- a. A member must be or have been a Bellaire High School student
- b. Any individual team winning a state championship
- c. Any captain of a major college team (major college to be interpreted as in NCAA Division I

Note: In that it was difficult determining whether some of the larger colleges were Division I at the time of the participant's captaincy, it was decided that all major colleges or universities would be considered, rather than only Division I, up to and including the 1984 school year.

- d. Any first team AP or UPI All-American selection - This will include all NCAA Divisions, including NAIA
- e. Any place winners (Top six places). This will include all NCAA Divisions, including NAIA.
- f. Any member of the United States Olympic Team.

g. An established member of any of the major professional teams sponsored by the United States (established member to be interpreted as two or more years of registered participation unless injured).

NOTE: It was decided, through board adopted policy, in February, 1987, that the following would be included in the Hall of Fame Policy: "Not more than two members (not meeting the above criteria), selected by unanimous vote of the Hall/Wall of Fame Committee each year, will be considered through written nomination and information to support the nomination presented to and considered by the committee. This will apply to public nominations only and will be retroactive through 1987."

Criteria for the **Wall of Fame** is the following:

- a. All regional, district and OVAC championship teams, along with athletes who made All-State
- b. A student who has distinguished himself/herself in athletics and has brought credit to Bellaire High School will be considered by the Hall of Fame committee for induction through recommendations made to the committee.
- c. Consideration will be given to non-Bellaire High School graduates who have distinguished themselves in athletics which has brought credit to Bellaire High School, as recommended to the Hall of Fame committee.

The Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame Committee consists of Principal Steve Kish, Athletic Director Mike Sherwood, Chairman Thomas E. Rataiczak, one Board member, Mr. Dan Frizzi, Sr.; two coaches, Mr. Terry Brinker, and Mr. John Magistro; two Touchdown Club members, Mr. Roosevelt Henry, and Mr. Dave Ice; four people from the community, Mr. John Myers, Mr. Leo Ragni, Mr. Bruce Dunlap, and Mr. Kelley Archer.

# CHET DANIELS

## Class of 1947

Ask any Big Reds football aficionado who dates back to the 40's who the best lineman ever to play for Bellaire High School was and the unanimous name given will be that of Chet Daniels. Chester Daniels, a member of the 1947 graduating class and Captain of the 1946 OVAC Championship football team, earned seven letters in three sports at BHS: three each in football and basketball and one in track. The rugged guard earned a lot of post-season honors two years running, including All-OVAC, All-Valley, All-Eastern Ohio, and All-State. Daniels was also selected to perform on Ohio's South All-Star squad. A leader in the classroom as well (he was a class officer during his freshman, sophomore, and senior years), Daniels was voted as the team MVP in 1944.

Upon graduation, Chet enrolled a long way from home - The University of Oregon - and quickly made his name known on the Duck's roster. After earning his freshman numeral, Daniels went on to play and letter three years. At 5'9", 195 pounds, number 69 was selected to the Saturday Evening Post 1948 All-Sophomore team and enjoyed a banner year, seeing his team capture the Pacific Coast Conference Championship and earn an invitation to perform in the 1949 Cotton Bowl in Dallas, Texas, against the Mustangs of Southern Methodist University. This marked the first time in the history of the PCC that a member school played in a major bowl game outside of the Rose Bowl. Another unique feature of this game was the fact that this was probably the first game in which blacks were permitted to play in the deep South. This Cotton Bowl team was inducted into the Oregon Hall of Fame in 1989.

In his junior year, Daniels received a first team berth on the U.P. All-Pacific Coast Conference football team and was named U.P. All-American, Honorable Mention. During that year, he led the NCAA in place kicking, booting 46 points through the uprights (31 PAT's and 5 field goals). He was 9th in PAT's with 31, his PAT average was second with a .912 average (31/34), and was first in field goals with 5.

The following excerpt was taken from a program describing Daniels:

*"CHESTER DANIELS - (5'9", 193) Last season, "Cool Papa" Daniels, an all-coast guard, led the country in points scored by placekicking. In the ten games he pumped five field goals and 31 extra points through the uprights for a total of 46 points. His average was also sensational, missing only one field goal try and three extra point attempts. His batting average of .912 on extra points topped the PCC and ranked second only to G. Smith of Michigan State (.927) in the national standings. During the season he established numerous new Oregon records in both field goal and extra point kicking. Daniels picked up his nickname of "Cool Papa" from his habit of always plucking a blade of grass from the field and putting it in his mouth before looking at the uprights after trying a field goal or extra point. He started the system two seasons ago to aid his concentration on the kicking point. Daniels also rates as a fine guard on both offense and defense. As a sophomore he played regularly on defense for the co-championship team and last year ranked fifth in time played with 317 minutes of both offensive and defensive play. Daniels is majoring in Business Administration."*

Daniels, a lifetime resident of the Oregon area, works for the Portland Development Company and visits his hometown on a regular basis to see family and friends. Last season, Chet, a 1984 Wall of Famer, saw his 1946 OVAC Championship team inducted into the Wall of Fame.

# WALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

**TERRY BRINKER \*\* 56466 Jordan Run Road, Bellaire, Ohio 43906** An outstanding athlete in high school, Terry Brinker earned a total of eight varsity letters in four sports at BHS before graduating in 1973. During his sophomore and junior years, Brinker lettered twice in football and track and once in basketball, but during his senior year he decided to try his hand at wrestling, a sport that would mean a lot to him later in life. In addition to lettering three times his final year, Brinker was selected team captain in football and track and saw post-season honors in both sports for All-OVAC, All-Valley, All-Eastern Ohio, and All-State. He twice went to the State meets, first as a wrestler at 167 pounds, and then as a low and high hurdler. That summer, he was selected to play in the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star game where he was selected tri-captain. Going to Waynesburg College upon graduation, Brinker lettered in football his freshman year, receiving NAIA Special Mention honors and being named NAIA Defensive Player-of-the-Week. He then transferred to West Liberty State College where he lettered in football and track for two years. A two-time All-Conference hurdler in the intermediate hurdles, Brinker earned his third numeral in track before graduating from WLSC. After graduation, Brinker got a teaching job at Shadyside High School. It was there that he returned to the mat sport, initiating not only the Tiger wrestling program but also the Shadyside Wrestling Invitational Tournament which is still being run today. He then returned to his alma mater where he has been teaching for the past twelve years. In 1984, Brinker was selected to fill the vacancy of head wrestling coach when his cousin and Wall of Famer Jeff Stolz retired. Brinker is married to the former Jill Perry and they have three children: Nathan, Andrea, and Michelle.

**BRUCE DUNLAP III \*\* 65920 Patterson Hill Road, Bellaire, Ohio 43906** Another stellar BHS athlete earning eight varsity letters in three sports is Bruce Dunlap, Class of 1978. Lettering in football and track for three years and wrestling for two, Dunlap was a three-sport performer throughout high school. He was selected to the All-OVAC squads in all three sports his junior and senior years and made All-Eastern Ohio honors three times his senior year. He also represented BHS in Columbus as the heavyweight representative at the State Tournament. Dunlap was chosen to play in the Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Football Game after graduating and served as a captain of the game. He also recorded the fastest pin for a heavyweight wrestler at 0:13 seconds, a record that still stands today. Enrolling at Waynesburg College, Dunlap played and lettered in football all four years before being chosen All-Conference his senior year. Presently working for Stone and Thomas, Dunlap is married to the former Brenda Palkovich and has two children: Brice and Bridget.

**DANIEL L. FRIZZI SR. \*\* 1065 Birch Street, Bellaire, Ohio 43906** A graduate of Bellaire High School in 1945, Dan Frizzi Sr. was a three-year performer and letter winner for the Big Reds, serving as captain his senior year. After the conclusion of the 1944 season, Frizzi received many honors, including first team center on the WWVA All-Valley Football team, All-OVAC, All-Eastern Ohio, and was selected to Shadyside High School's All-Opponent Club. A lifelong resident of Bellaire, Frizzi has been a pillar of the community, operating Frizzi's Market in West Bellaire. He has also served for years on the Board of Education, representing it as president several times and serving as a delegate to numerous State and National Conferences. Frizzi was instrumental in instituting the Hall of Fame/Wall of Fame at Bellaire High School and has served on its board since its inception. Like their father, Frizzi's five sons - Dan, Dick, Dave, Doug, and Dean - are all established members of the Bellaire community.

**ALFRED "TATER" HAVELKA \*\* 5033 Jefferson Street, Bellaire, Ohio 43906** Although some of the youngsters today might not remember "Tater" Havelka, his name is still talked about by many of the old timers. Havelka played and lettered in football for three years at BHS, being accorded All-Valley honors his junior and senior years. He also was named First Team UP All-State and was selected to play in the first Ohio-West Virginia All-Star Game in 1939. Havelka is credited with being the last person to drop kick extra points for Bellaire High School. But Tater's fame was on the baseball diamond where he enjoyed over twenty years with the Bellaire Civics and took extreme pride in his ability as a catcher. Havelka also spent two years playing AA baseball at Orlando, Florida. A veteran of four years with the US Marines, he served at Guadalcanal, Bougainville, Guam, and Iwo Jima. Havelka's squad was the one responsible for the historical flag raising at Iwo Jima during World War II. During his military time, he also played baseball with the Marines at New River, North Carolina, and Quantico, Virginia. He is married to the former Marilyn Hayes and has one son, Tom.

**ARTHUR L. JONES \*\* 804 Howard Street, Bridgeport, Ohio 43912** Probably one of the most prolific wrestlers ever to take the mat at BHS, Art Jones, Class of 1972, enjoyed an outstanding four-year career at Bellaire High School. During his freshman year, Jones recorded 13 wins against 1 loss and finished second in the giant OVAC Wrestling Tournament. As a sophomore, Jones enjoyed another stellar year with a 22-1 record, building his totals to 26 pins and 58 takedowns over two years. Undefeated in dual meets, Jones took first place in the St. Johns Invitational, a feat he would repeat two more times, becoming the first wrestler to do this. Wrestling at 98 pounds, Jones earned first place Sectional and District berths and was a State qualifier. He was also voted MVP and received trophies for Most Pins and Most Takedowns from the Touchdown Club, another feat he would repeat during his junior and senior years. As a sophomore Jones once again finished second in the OVAC Tourney. Jones highlighted his junior year by becoming the 98 pound OVAC Champion and was undefeated for the second straight year in dual meet competition, recording a 23-1 record with 19 pins and 35 takedowns. Although he won the Sectionals, Jones was forced to settle for a second-place finish in the Districts. Moving to 105 pounds his senior year, Jones sported a 21-0 record with 14 pins and 30 takedowns. He again repeated as OVAC Champion, this time winning the coveted Dave Belkorte Award as the tournament's most outstanding wrestler. Jones took first place in the Sectionals and District and once again was a State qualifier. Under Coach Dennis Penza, Jones was responsible for helping his team bring the first big wrestling trophy to BHS, that of District runner-up. Upon graduating, Jones did not give up wrestling. For the past eight years, he has coached the Island Eagle Wrestling Club, not only sending several of his athletes to championships in the tri-state area, but also seeing several of them become outstanding champions in West Virginia high school competition. Jones' two sons, Aric and Marcus, have been wrestling since they were 7 and 3, and are well on their way to filling their father's shoes.

**CHARLES D. "BUD" KEYSER (Deceased) \*\* represented by wife, Mary Helen Keyser, Bellview Heights, Bellaire, Ohio 43906** A 1938 graduate of Bellaire High School, Keyser participated in swimming, tennis, and track. Although BHS didn't have established teams in swimming and tennis, competition between schools was still conducted. As a pole vaulter, Keyser spent several years on the track team, a sport that he later would give much of his life to. He received his Bachelor's Degree from Kent State University in 1949, lettering in tennis and being the number one seeded player on the tennis team two years in a row. He returned to teach industrial arts and business mathematics at his alma mater in 1952, where he coached track. Two of his more noted students were Wall of Famer Bill Thomas, ex-Big Reds hurdler, and Hall of Famer Francis Gibson, considered one of the better shot putters at BHS. But his greatest accomplishment before he left Bellaire in 1957 was founding the Bellaire Relays in 1954-1955. Due to his insight and dedication to the sport, the Relays has grown into one of the largest track meets in the state of Ohio. Upon leaving Bellaire, Keyser moved to Martins Ferry to instruct industrial drafting and later served as supervisor of vocational education. He instructed at Ohio University Belmont, and, in 1968, was called upon to plan, equip, and operate the newly-built Joint Vocational School. He was responsible for adding Harrison County to the JVS, and later (1974) was responsible for building a similar facility in Monroe County, the Swiss Hills Vocational School. Even with all his commitments, Keyser remained dedicated to the sport he loved, serving as a State and area track official and supplying guidance to the fast-growing Relays. He retired in 1977 and taught part time at OUB until his death in 1980. Keyser has two children, John, residing in London, England, and Barbara, a resident of Atlanta, Georgia.

**TODD KINDER \*\* 1253 Birch Street, Bellaire, Ohio 43906** Although he began his three-sport career in Montgomery, Alabama, Todd Kinder returned to Bellaire to complete his junior and senior years, graduating in 1985. During those two years, he played and lettered in football (serving as captain his senior year), basketball, and baseball. Receiving several post season honors in basketball his junior year, Kinder excelled his senior year, being named to All-OVAC, All-Valley, and All-Eastern Ohio squads in all three sports and was tapped All-State in football. He also had the honor of participating in all three All-Star games upon graduation, and was chosen by the Wheeling Intelligencer as the three-sport Athlete-of-the-Year. Upon graduation, Kinder went to Kent State University where he played and lettered for four years as a wide receiver. In 1988, he was chosen as Offensive Player-of-the-Week when Kent State played Ball State. Kinder was recognized by the Dapper Dan of the Upper Ohio Valley for his accomplishments both at Bellaire High School and Kent State University. Upon graduation, he served as a Student Assistant Coach at Kent State, working with the wide receivers and tight ends as well as game day substitutions. Kinder is currently employed as an Account Executive for American Business Equipment, St. Clairsville.

# WALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

**GEORGE KOVALICK (Deceased) \*\* represented by his wife, Evelyn Kovalick, 1103 Burley Avenue, Glendale, West Virginia 26038** It was once said that if you could select one person to coach all sports in your high school and wanted the best coach in every sport, that person would be George Kovalick. A graduate of Bridgeport High School in 1940, Kovalick played guard in football and was an outfielder on the baseball team. Upon graduation, he attended a junior college in Scooba, Mississippi, but was forced to leave after one semester and serve in World War II. Rising to the rank of sergeant, Kovalick saw much action in the China-Burma-India Theater. After the war, he enrolled at Kent State University, where he played football for four years and served as captain his junior year. Returning to coach at his alma mater in 1950, Kovalick became perhaps the greatest influence on athletics ever to coach in the Ohio Valley. One only has to look at his coaching record to understand his impact. From 1950 to 1961, he coached at Bridgeport High School, serving as head coach of football, wrestling, and baseball. Initiating wrestling at BHS, he led the Bulldogs to seven straight OVAC Championships, five District titles, and highlighted his career by winning the State title in 1959. His baseball teams won four EOBL titles, 4 District crowns, and 3 OVAC banners. From Bridgeport he moved to West Liberty State College until 1964, again serving as head coach in the same three sports. His 1963 football squad won the WVC title; his wrestling efforts saw the collegiate career of Bobby Douglas begin; and his 1964 baseball team, starring Joe Niekro, came from the loser's bracket to win the NAIA National title. From there, Kovalick moved to Moundsville High School where he coached football, wrestling, and track until 1968. He served a term from 1969 to 1971 as head wrestling coach in Barstow, California, before returning to the Valley to coach football and wrestling at Weirton High School. His 1973 football team won OVAC honors and finished runner-up in the State playoffs. He also won the State title in wrestling, producing an individual State champ in his son, 185-pounder Mike. In 1974, he came to Bellaire to serve as transportation supervisor, athletic director, and assistant coach in football and wrestling. In his first year, his son, Mike, again became a State titlist, this time in Ohio. Kovalick retired from coaching in 1978 and spent the remainder of his life imparting his knowledge and wisdom to other Valley coaches. The first recipient of the coveted Mr. Mat Award, he was instrumental in building the OVAC Wrestling Tournament, one of the largest in the nation. Present tourney officials still bestow a scholarship in his name each year. His work with the OVAC baseball tournament resulted in the game being renamed the George Kovalick All-Star game. He directed tournaments and meets in all sports, on all levels, and was instrumental in developing the guidelines for many OVAC policies. Kovalick is a member of the Ohio Wrestling Coaches Hall of Fame, the Kent State University Hall of Fame, the West Liberty State College Hall of Fame, and the Ohio Athletic Director's Hall of Fame.

**MONTE MILLER \*\* 4277 Noble Street, Bellaire, Ohio 43906** A 1965 graduate of Bellaire High School, Miller began his sophomore athletic career playing football, basketball, and track before specializing in the latter two his junior and senior years, earning three letters in basketball and two in track. During his senior year, he received many post-season honors, being named All-OVAC, All-Eastern Ohio, All-District, and All-Valley in both sports and All-State in basketball. As a senior in track, Miller held both the Bellaire (6'1 1/4") and the District (6'1") high jump records, becoming Bellaire's first 6' high jumper. He was also Eastern Ohio's leading scorer in basketball his senior year, averaging 23 points per game, and still holds the school record for most field goals in a game (20). Upon graduation, Miller went to Gannon University on a basketball scholarship before transferring to West Liberty State College to receive his Bachelor's Degree. In college he participated in track (2 years) and basketball (4 years), receiving three basketball letters and being named captain his senior year. Miller served three years in security in the United States Army. He has spent most of his teaching career at St. Clairsville High School, where he enjoyed considerable success as a boys' and girls' track coach. In addition to his girls winning five OVAC titles and five District or Regional championships, his 1981 girls' squad was the Ohio State AA Champion. His boys' teams also won two District trophies. Miller is married to the former Ruth Ann Moran and has two daughters, Jackie and Juliann.

# WALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

**CHARLES EUGENE RIEVES \*\* 2941 Castlewood Road, Berwick, Columbus, Ohio 43209** Charles Rieves earned a total of nine letters in three sports before graduating from Bellaire High School in 1951. An outstanding athlete, Rieves participated in football, basketball, and track, receiving several post-season accolades. Upon graduation, he attended West Virginia State before entering the Army in March of 1952, a move which was to last for twenty years. Rieves served in the Korean War in 1952 and spent two tours of duty in Vietnam in 1967 and 1971. While at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, he participated in football in 1956. He retired from the US Army Airborne Rangers in March, 1973, serving as a Green Beret and attaining the rank of Master Sergeant. During his tenure, he received a Combat Infantry Badge (for 7 major battles in Vietnam), a Master Parachutist Badge, two Bronze Stars, an Air Medal (for 50+ assaults into enemy territory), 5 Army Commendation Medals, and five Honorable Discharges. Presently residing in Columbus, Rieves is employed by Queen City Barrell, Cincinnati.

**WILLIE SPARKSMAN \*\* 8322 O'Connor Crescent, Norfolk, Virginia 23503** Another three-sport standout, Willie Sparksman, Class of 1965, received ten letters in football, basketball, and track, serving as co-captain of the 1964 OVAC Championship football team. An All-OVAC and All-Eastern Ohio performer his senior year, Sparksman also received Honorable Mention accolades for All-State football. Sparksman helped set the Ohio Valley and Bellaire High School track records in the shuttle hurdle relay, not to the surprise of many, as they also set the freshmen record in the Ohio Valley in 1961. Upon graduation, he was selected to play in the OVAC All-Star Football game and also performed for the American Legion Post Baseball team in the Ohio Baseball Tournament. Sparksman played football at West Liberty State College, lettering all three years and serving as Co-captain his senior year. But the bulk of his post-high school career has been spent in the U.S. Military where he served 4 years in the USAF Security Police, 4 years on the USS Vulcan, and 12 years in the US Navy, Intelligence and Data Processing Division, where he is a Petty Officer 2C. Getting in a little military football, he was selected All-Conference Defensive Back in the USAF, Atlantic Division, Europe, in 1969.

**PETE TUCCIO \*\* 4428 N. 38th Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85018** A late bloomer in high school, Pete Tuccio, Class of 1946, played football all four years in high school, and ran track his junior and senior year, yet only accumulated two varsity letters. Upon graduation, he entered West Liberty State College where he played and lettered all four years and was selected captain his senior year. A unanimous All-Conference choice in the S.I.C. Conference in 1950, Tuccio also received Honorable Mention All-American his senior year. He held the West Liberty and S.I.C. Conference rushing record of 296 yards in one game. Upon graduation, he entered the United States Air Force, serving in the Korean War, and achieving the rank of First Lieutenant. Tuccio also served as head basketball coach at Carl Hayden High School in Phoenix, Arizona, from 1962 to 1981, and was selected Phoenix Coach-of-the-Year in 1971. Tuccio was recently honored by his college alma mater by being inducted into the West Liberty State College Hall of Fame.

# HARBIN FOOTBALL RATING SYSTEM

Reprinted from The Ohio High School ATHLETE (August, 1988)

The procedure used to rate football teams is based upon a system developed by Jack Harbin of Cleveland and used with his permission. The present procedure has been modified by the Board of Control upon recommendation of the Ohio High School Football Coaches Association.

Points will be earned by each school on the following basis:  
POINT SYSTEM

On the first level:

Points are earned for each game a team wins.  
(FULL VALUE)

Points are earned for each game a team ties.  
(ONE-HALF VALUE)

On the second level:

Points are earned for each game a defeated opponent wins.  
(FULL VALUE)

Points are earned for each game a defeated opponent ties.  
(ONE-HALF VALUE)

Points are earned for each game a tied opponent wins.  
(ONE-HALF VALUE)

Points are earned for each game a tied opponent ties.  
(ONE-FOURTH VALUE)

Points are earned on the following basis:

Division V opponent: win - 1.0 point; tie - 0.50 point  
Division IV opponent: win - 1.5 points; tie - 0.75 point  
Division III opponent: win - 2.0 points; tie - 1.0 point  
Division II opponent: win - 2.5 points; tie - 1.25 points  
Division I opponent: win - 3.0 points; tie - 1.5 points

4.1 Awarding of First Level Points

4.11 For all teams playing a 10 game schedule

- Points are earned for each game a team wins (full value)
- Points are earned for each game a team ties (half value)
- no points are awarded for game lost

4.12 For all teams playing fewer than 10 games.

- Add total first level points earned as explained under 3.11, section a, b and c
- This total is then divided by the number of games actually played. To determine total first level points, the quotient is then added to the total points earned, one for each open date

4.2 Awarding of Second Level Points

Second level points are awarded as a result of a team defeating or tying an opponent or, sometimes an open date according to the following formula:

4.21 Defeating an opponent awards to the winner the loser's first level points

4.22 Tying an opponent awards the team one-half the opponent's first level points.

4.23 No second level points are awarded for losing to an opponent.

4.24 **Non-member OHSAA school opponents.** The school is assigned a point value based upon male enrollment in grades 9-11. Second level points are awarded based upon the point value of the OHSAA non-member school multiplied times the number of victories by the non-member school (one-half value for a tie)

NOTE: This section requires the reporting of victories earned by a non-member OHSAA school which was defeated by an OHSAA member school. It is the responsibility of the OHSAA member school to report the results of the games of non-member OHSAA schools. This reporting must be made to Lynette Young-Hipsher at the OHSAA office on Monday of each week and on Saturday, November 5, 1988 for the last week. Results unreported will not be credited to the OHSAA member school's second level point total.

4.241 When the non-member school plays more than 10 regular season games, only the first 10 games will count unless the game with the OHSAA member school is the 11th game in which case the nine games preceding it shall be counted.

4.242 When the non-member school plays less than 10 regular season games, the open dates will be considered an open date except in Indiana in which case the Indiana first round tournament game will be counted.

4.25 **A scheduled open date.** Second level points are totaled, divided by the number of games played and the quotient divided by 2 then added to the second level point total.

4.26 **An unscheduled open date** (opponent on strike, closed for economic reasons, fails to honor contract, etc.). Second level points are totaled, divided by the number of games played and the quotient added to the second level point total

4.3 Calculation of Total Points

The sum from the awarding of second level points above will be added to the first level points credited from awarding of first level points to determine the total points.

EXAMPLE: Team A plays a nine game schedule consisting of seven (7) OHSAA member schools, two (2) non-member schools with one open date. Team A won eight (8) games losing one (1) to a non-member school (out-of-state). The eight opponents defeated consisted of four Division I teams at 3 points each, three Division III teams at 2 points each and one non-member team at 2 points which won 6 games during the season.

FIRST LEVEL POINTS are calculated as follows:

Division I	4 schools at 3 points	=	12 points
Division III	3 schools at 2 points	=	6 points
Division III	1 non-member school at 2 points	=	2 points
TOTAL FIRST LEVEL POINTS			20

Total First Level Points earned	20
Divided by number of games played	9
Equals	2.2222 quotient
Add	20 total first level points earned
Plus	2.2222 first level value for one open date
Equals	22.2222 total first level points credited

SECOND LEVEL POINTS are earned and credited based upon the victories attained by OHSAA member schools over their opponents. Team A earned 92.5000 second level points.

Since Team A had one open date on their schedule, defeated one non-member school and lost to one non-member school, adjustments are made to credit Team A at the second level for the one open date and one victory over a non-member school. No second level points are credited in the game lost to a non-member school.

Calculation:	92.5000 second level points credited from OHSAA member schools
Divided by	7 number of games played against OHSAA member schools
Equals	13.2143 average value of each win at second level
	92.5000 second level points credited from OHSAA member schools
Plus	6.6072 second level value for one open date (1/2 of 13.2143)
Plus	12.0000 second level value for win over non-member school (2 points x 6 wins)
	111.1072 Total second level points credited
Summary:	22.2222 first level points
	111.1072 second level points
	133.3294 TOTAL POINTS

**COMPILATION:** Due to the complexity of the system, computer services of the OHSAA are used to record and tally the points earned by each team. The computer operates only on the data fed into it -- that is, did a team win, tie or lose. The margin of victory is not a factor. A win by one point or 20 points counts only as a win -- nothing more.
