DAPPER DAN CO-MAN OF THE YEAR

RICH DONNELLY - PITTSBURGH PIRATES

Rich Donnelly is in his fifth season as the Pirates' Bullpen Coach. In that role, he does much more than answer the bullpen phone and make sure the relief pitchers are warmed up prior to entering a game.

Donnelly also coordinates workout schedules during spring training and all phases of the regular season pre-game routine. During the game it is his responsibility to keep a book on opposing hitters and to go over that material with the relievers so they are prepared for whom they may face when they enter a game.

A former catcher, Donnelly was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins in 1967 after playing four seasons at Xavier University in Cincinnati. He had been drafted twice previously by the Yankees, but opted to stay in school. A veteran of 22 years in professional baseball, the Steubenville Ohio native spent 16 seasons in the Washington\Texas organization before joining the Pirates.

Rich began his pro career as a player at St. Cloud Minnesota in the Northern League in 1968. He tied for the league lead in games played in his first pro season and led league catchers in putouts (486), assists (58) and fielding percentage (.984).

Donnelly spent four years as a player prior to becoming manager of the Rangers' Greenville (Class A) club in the Western Carolinas League in 1972 at the age of 26. He managed the Rangers' Western Carolinas League clubs for four seasons, earning Manager-of-the-Year honors in each of his first three years when his clubs advanced to the playoffs. In 1974, his Gastonia club won the league title.

In 1976, the Rangers promoted Donnelly to manage at the Triple-A level in the Pacific Coast League. He piloted the Sacramento club in 1976, then Tucson for the next three seasons.

In 1980, he joined the Texas Rangers' staff as a bullpen coach, but returned to manage at the Triple-A level in the American Association for the 1981 (Wichita) and 1982 (Denver) seasons. He returned to Texas in 1983 and was the Rangers' first base coach for three seasons before being named to his current post with the Pirates on December 12, 1985.

Graduated from Steubenville Catholic Central High School in 1964 where he played baseball and basketball... Was named to the All-State team in baseball, which included Al Oliver, Larry Hisle and Gene Tenace... Graduated from Xavier in 1969 where he received B.S. degree in education... Was Xavier's MVP as a senior... An outstanding racquetball player who competes in tournaments during the off-season... Favorite major leaguers as a youngster were former Pirates Jim Pagliaroni and Bill Mazerowski... Brother (Jerome) was a pitcher in the Kansas City A's and Cincinnati organizations... Coordinates Pirate/Giant Eagle clinic program for club's community relations department... Served as an assistant coach for Steubenville Catholic Central High School boys' basketball team this past off-season.

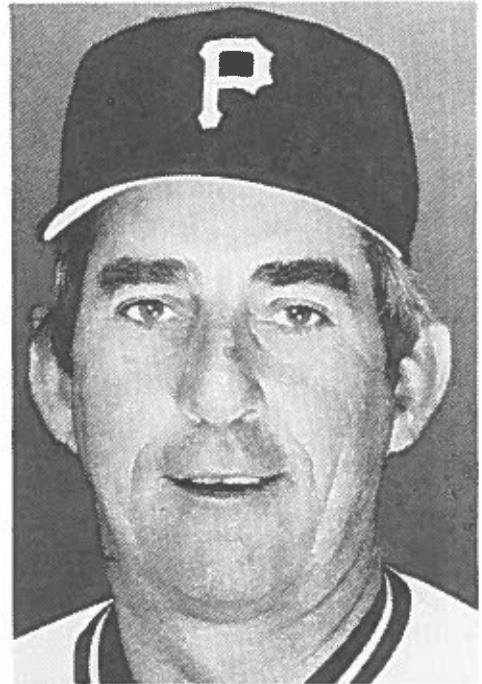


DAPPER DAN CO-MAN OF THE YEAR RAY MILLER - PITTSBURGH PIRATES

Ray Miller is in his fourth season as Pitching Coach for the Pirates. One of the most respected pitching coaches in baseball, he was named to his current post on October 20, 1986.

His duties include overseeing pitching mechanics, helping prepare game plans and scouting reports on opposing hitters, keeping daily pitching charts and records of how long each reliever is up in the bullpen during the course of a game.

Miller, who formerly managed the Minnesota Twins, is best known for his successful stint as pitching coach of the Baltimore Orioles. In seven and a half seasons (1978-1985) in that role, he coached two Cy Young Award winners (Mike Flanagan and Steve Stone), and five different 20-game winners (Flanagan, Stone, Jim Palmer, Scott McGregor and Mike Boddicker). Baltimore also appeared in the World Series twice during his tenure, losing to Pittsburgh in 1979 and defeating Philadelphia in 1983.



Miller, who reports to the Florida Instructional League each fall, also helps oversee the development of the young pitchers in the organization.

Originally signed by the San Francisco Giants, Miller began his pro career in 1964, playing for Lexington (Class A) in the Western Carolinas League. He led the league in shutouts, was second in ERA and pitched a no-hitter (in a 0-0 game called by rain after 8.0 innings on 8/3) before being drafted by the Cleveland organization following the season. He was traded to the Baltimore organization in May of 1971 and ended his playing career with the Orioles' Rochester (AAA) club in 1973, a year in which he became a player-coach. He finished his pro career with a record of 60-65.

From 1974 thru 1977 he served as Baltimore's minor league pitching instructor, then joined the Orioles at the major league level for the 1978 season. On June 21, 1985, he became manager of the Minnesota Twins. The club went 50-50 in his first year and was 59-80 in 1986 when he was replaced on 9/12.

JOE WOOD

Honorary Chairman

Cadiz native Joe W. Wood, vice-president and general merchandising manager for The Athlete's Foot, is honorary chairman for the twenty-fifth Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Banquet.

Wood, a graduate of Cadiz High School and Kent State University, will fly up from Atlanta, where he makes his home, for the occasion.

The Athlete's Foot, a recreational shoe company, operates 450 stores in the United States and has a total of 600, including those in Europe and the Far East.

Wood, who was a halfback on the Cadiz High football team and a sprinter in track, still has close ties with the Harrison County community. In fact, while his father, Darby, is deceased, his mother, Catherine Wood, lives at Cadiz, as does his sister Wendy Lawlis, a school teacher, and his brother, Chris, who is associated with a contractors' supply company and is active in youth baseball circles.

Another brother, Bill, who played football for Bo Schembechler at Miami University at Oxford, is a high school principal in Dayton and yet another brother, Pat, coaches at Dayton Wayne High School. A sister, Mary Jane, teaches at Barnesville.

Joe Wood married his high school sweetheart, Jane Freeburn, and they have one daughter, Kaitlin, 6.

Wood was graduated from Cadiz High School in 1965 and from Kent State University in '69. For five years, he was a school teacher and high school coach. He was an assistant coach in football and basketball and head coach in baseball. He coached two years at Fremont, Ohio and three at Ashland, Ohio, before accepting a position in Columbus with Lazarus Department Stores.

After four years in the Lazarus organization, Wood became regional director for Miller Brothers Department Stores at Knoxville, Tenn. Then he spent two years with Zale Jewelry Co. in Dallas as a division merchandising manager.

Remaining in Texas, he worked for Oshman's Sporting Goods, in Houston, for five years as general merchandising manager. He accepted his position with The Athlete's Foot four years ago.

Donley, himself the 1985 honorary chairman for the banquet spent 43 years in broadcasting. A native of Wellsburg, where he played high school football on the same team as the great Russ Craft, he began and ended his radio-TV career in Steubenville but spent years in Pittsburgh, where he became one of that city's popular sports figures.

"Certainly Red Donley is an ideal choice for the McKelvey Award," said Bertz, "He stands for all the good qualities which made the late Robert McKelvey, first president of our club, such a great person."

A marine corps veteran of World War II, Donley broke into broadcasting business with Radio Station WSTV, Steubenville, in 1946 without advantage of formal training. He was the play-by-play broadcaster for the station's high school football and basketball coverage and served as sports director. He also did horse race announcing at both Wheeling Downs and Waterford Park.

In 1954, when WSTV-TV, Channel 9 (now WTOV) went on the air, Donley became its sports director. Shortly thereafter, he was named to work with Joe Tucker on Pittsburgh Steeler broadcasts and telecasts.

In 1960, he became sports director at Channel 11, Pittsburgh (now WIIC) and held that position for 10 years. In 1962, he succeeded Ray Scott as play-by-play announcer for the University of Pittsburgh.

Donley rejoined Channel 9, Steubenville, in 1972 and remained with the station until his retirement. During his days in Pittsburgh, he won five Golden Quill Awards for his distinguished news coverage. One of those awards was for a documentary which he wrote and narrated on the late Art Rooney.

Red and his wife, Mary Margaret Kyro Donley, have one son, Shawn, who is with U.S. Naval Air Research and resides at Warminster, Pa. Red and Mary Margaret also have a grand-daughter, Jennifer.

1991 - RENO S. SACCOCCIA

Steubenville Big Red Football coach Reno Saccoccia was honored by the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan as its 'Man of the Year' at its 1985 banquet.

Saccoccia, who 'Man of the Year' tribute came after he had coached Steubenville to the 1984 state Division II championship, has been selected as this year's recipient of the Carl Hamill Memorial Award, named in honor of the long-time, ultra-successful Weirton coach who is a member of the Dapper Dan and West Virginia State Halls of Fame.

Although he has been head mentor of Big Red for only eight seasons, Saccoccia has established himself among the valley coaching greats with a record of 90 victories against only 12 defeats. All of his Steubenville teams have made the Ohio playoffs and Big Red has been in the Division II finals three times - in '84 when it won and in '87 and '88, when the Steubenville forces lost close games to Akron Buchtel.

The fiery, dynamic Saccoccia's teams have also won four Ohio Valley Athletic Conference 4-A championships - in 1983, '86, '88, and '89. He was selected by the media as the OVAC 'Coach of the Year' after his '84 powerhouse won its state championship and finished 13-0.

Under Saccoccia, Steubenville has posted perfect regular-seasons records in 1983, '84, '86, '87, and '88.

Saccoccia is a Steubenville native who attended St. Anthony's Grade School and was graduated from Steubenville Catholic Central High School in 1967. He played collegiately at the University of Akron, where he was graduated in 1971.

His first coaching job was at United Local High School, where he was head track coach. He remained on the staff there for six years before returning to Steubenville as an assistant under Bill Bohren. A year later, he became eighth grade coach at Harding Junior High and served in that capacity for three years before joining Bob Hedmond's varsity staff.

Two years later, he was appointed head coach after Hedmond's retirement. He is also now serving as athletic director.

Saccoccia and his wife Patricia, are the parents of three children.

He is the brother of Ray Saccoccia, now the Big Red head basketball coach.



PAUL KALIVODA

1989 Hall of Fame Inductee

Kalivoda is a World War II veteran who has dedicated 38 years to coaching and teaching.

A 1938 graduate of Toronto High, he was a tackle for the Red Knights. He went on to Ohio University, where he lettered for three years in both football and wrestling. He wrestled in the light heavyweight and heavyweight divisions for the Bobcats.

After graduation from college, he was named head coach at Hamden High in the Athens area and the next year he became basketball coach at Hamilton Twp. High, in the Columbus area.

Kalivoda was in the U.S. Navy from 1944 to '46. Then he returned to Eastern Ohio and was named head football, basketball, and baseball coach at Dillonvale High, now part of the Buckeye SouthWest consolidation. His Night Riders were a formidable force in the Eastern Ohio League and his teams won three district basketball championships.

In 1950, the Toronto product was named basketball and baseball coach and athletic director at the College of Steubenville. In '53, he returned to high school ranks as head coach in three sports at Irondale High. His Ironmen won the Jefferson County Class B basketball title in his first year at the helm.

In '55 Kalivoda returned to Toronto High as an assistant in football and head basketball coach. His 1956-57 cage squad won a sectional championship.

With the death of Geoge "Gabby" Kuzler, himself a member of the Dapper Dan Sports Hall of Fame, Kalivoda became Toronto High athletic director. He also found time to coach a new sport at the school--wrestling--and built a winning team.

In football, he was the Red Knights' line coach and was known affectionately by his charges as "The Bear".

The veteran coach was on the faculty at Toronto High for 25 years. He also officiated basketball in high school ranks for seven years.

In '83, he was named Eastern Ohio District "Athletic Director of the Year."

He is a past President of The Dapper Dan Club and has been inducted in the Ohio High School Athletic Directors Hall at Fame.

He is a past president of the Toronto Education Association and the Eastern Ohio Athletic Directors Association. He is a member of American Legion Post No. 86 of Toronto and has served as chaplain for six years. He is also a vice-president of the OVAC Foundation.

A member of Dyer Country Club, he served on the club's board of directors.

He is vice-president of the parish council of the St. Joseph's Roman Catholic Church at Toronto and is president of the Holy Name Society.

Kalivoda and his wife, Betty, have four children--Mrs. John (Kathy) Bucey of Westerville; Mrs. Gary (Helen Marie) Grimm of Toronto; Paul "Buzzy", of Toronto; and Mike, of Wilmington, Del. Paul and Betty have seven grandchildren.



JOHN J. SORRENTI

Toastmaster

He was graduated from Weir Senior High School in 1956. He attended West Virginia University, The University of Steubenville and received a B.S. degree from West Virginia Tech in Vocational Education.

His work experience has included positions in men's wear retailing with Rodak's Mens Shop in Weirton, purchasing department of Weirton Steel Division, Field Representative for National Lubricating Products in Brilliant, Ohio, Purchasing agent of the Hancock County Schools and Placement Coordinator of the John D. Rockefeller IV Vo-Tech Center.

Over the past 35 years he has been affiliated with radio station WEIR as sports director. In that time he has broadcast basketball, football and baseball games throughout West Virginia and Ohio and also has broadcast in Pennsylvania over WEDO in McKeesport.

He has been involved in various civic and professional organizations including Past President of the Weirton Rotary Club, Past Grand Knight of the Weirton Knights of Columbus, Weirton United Way, the National Institute of Government Purchasing and the American Association of School Administrators, in addition to membership in local booster clubs and the Dapper Dan Club. He is a former Weirton City Councilman and in 1986 was elected as a Hancock County Commissioner. Mr. Sorrenti has wide experience as a toastmaster and master of ceremonies throughout the Ohio Valley at various sports gatherings, and is in demand as a motivational speaker.

He is married to the former Judy Difederico of Steubenville and they have three children - J.J., 24 years old; Janna, 22 years old, and Antoinette, 19 years old.

The "Voice of the Pirates," Lanny Frattare is in his 15th season with the club. Only Bob Prince and Rosey Rowswell have described Pirate action longer than Lanny. On August 9, 1988, Frattare broadcast his 2,000th Pirate game. A native of Rochester, N.Y., Frattare received his B.S. degree in communications from Ithaca New York College in 1970. His baseball broadcasting career began in 1968 when he did play-by-play for the Geneva, New York Senators in the Class A New York-Penn League.

Frattare's association with the Pirates began in 1974 when he served as broadcaster for the Charleston Charlies, the Pirates' Triple-A International League affiliate. He worked the Charlies' games for two years before joining the Pirates' broadcast crew in 1976.

In addition to his duties with the Pirates, he has been the radio voice of Penn State football and done television play-by-play for Ohio State basketball. He also was play-by-play voice of the Rochester Americans of the American Hockey League for two seasons (1974-75 and 1975-76).

Lanny enjoys golf, presidential history and music and he and his wife Liz are both involved in a number of Pittsburgh area civic and charity projects. Lanny also works closely with the Pirates Community Relations Department. The Frattares reside in Upper St. Clair with their two children, David and Megan.

NICK SKORICH

1990 Hall of Fame Inductee



Nick Skorich, a Bellaire native who was head coach of both the Philadelphia Eagles and Cleveland Browns in the National Football League, has been elected to the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club's Hall of Fame.

Skorich, who has spent the last 15 years working for the NFL in the office of supervisor of officials Art McNally, will be accompanied by his wife Teresa.

"Nick Skorich has achieved heights attained by no other Ohio Valley football figure in being head coach of the Eagles from 1961 through '63 and the Browns from '71 through '74," pointed out John Ramer, of Toronto, chairman of the selection committee. "In all, as a player, assistant coach, head coach and as a member of the staff of the NFL office, he has been associated with the league for 40 years and that is a remarkable accomplishment."

Skorich came out of Bellaire when that city was at the height of its gridiron glory and had been dubbed by another native son, the late Francis Wallace, as "the All-American Town."

Born in June of 1921, Skorich was the hard-nosed son of a coal miner and the second eldest in a family of nine children. As a teen-ager, he worked in the mines and in construction and pumped gas.

He played center on the Big Red football team at 5'9, 170 pounds and also played basketball and was on the track team. A griddier of all-valley stature, he won a scholarship at the University of Cincinnati and enrolled there in 1939.

At Cincinnati, he grew to all of 190 pounds. He became team captain of the Bearcats, made the All-Ohio collegiate team, and started to think about coaching as a career.

However, he knew he would have to shelve his ambitions for a while. He was graduated from college when World War II was at its height and entered the navy.

Skorich became what was then known as a "90-day wonder" and, after midshipmen's school, was commissioned as an officer. He was in the navy amphibious service and was on the beach at Normandy on a landing craft at D Day, plus six hours. His craft was bringing in tanks and dropping them off on the beaches.

The sturdy ex-Big Red survived the rigors of war and, in his spare time, had letters to read from the Pittsburgh Steelers, who were interested in landing his services when the conflict was over.

"In 1946, I signed with the Steelers for \$3,300, plus a \$200 signing bonus," he remembers. "I weighed 193 at the time and, in those days you were expected to play both ways. I played guard and linebacker. We were playing the single wing under the great Jock Sutherland. I played three years before an injury forced me off the field. I came along at the right time because there wouldn't be a place for me in pro ball now. I was too small for a lineman or linebacker and too slow to be a back."

By the time he departed the Steelers, Skorich was a well known figure in Pittsburgh and was offered the job as head coach at Pittsburgh Central Catholic High School. His success there led to his appointment as coach at Rensselaer Poly in Troy, N. Y., in 1953. A year later, he returned to the Steelers as line coach under Walt Kiesling.

Skorich was with the Pittsburgh team for four years in that capacity and then moved to Green Bay as offensive line coach and overall boss of the Packer offense under Scooter McLean. He joined Buck Shaw at Philadelphia in 1959 and was in charge of the Eagles' running game. That was his responsibility when Philadelphia won the NFL crown by defeating Green Bay in 1960.

When Shaw retired after the '60 season, the Ohioan was promoted to head coach.

The Eagles posted a 10-4 record in '61 and barely missed the conference title but a series of injuries to key players crippled the team and led to two losing seasons. With a change of ownership, Joe Kuharich was brought in as coach and Blanton Collier, then head coach of the Browns, hired Skorich and put him in charge of the defensive line.

In '64, of course, the Browns won the NFL championship—the last they have ever captured.

"We played the Colts in the championship that game," Skorich remembers. "We were seven-point underdogs and we won, 27-0"

After four years as a defensive coach with Cleveland, Skorich moved over to the other side of the ball and became what is, in the modern parlance, "the offensive coordinator."

He held that post until 1971 when he succeeded Collier and became only the third head coach in the history of the Browns' franchise.

Under Skorich, the Browns went 9-5 and 10-4 in his first two seasons as head mentor and made the playoffs. The clubs 7-5-2 in '73 but, hounded by injuries and other problems, the record dipped to 4-10 the next year and the Bellaire product found himself looking for work.

"I was weighing three coaching offers when I learned that the NFL office was looking for someone with a football playing and coaching background to join the officiating staff," Skorich explained, "Art McNally, the supervisor of officials, and Jack Reader, the assistant, were both former referees. Commissioner Pete Rozelle felt that there was a need for someone with input from the coaching side so I got the job. I never anticipated I would stay at it so long."

Skorich had worked year-around in the league office from 1975 until the past two years. Now, at age 69, he works in-season only – in the office three days a week and at a game every weekend. "We evaluate the officials and also the replay officials," he pointed out. "For several years, I did some work as a replay official myself. Now I am directly responsible for evaluating replay officials."

Through the NFL New York office, officials are hired, fired, trained and crews are assigned to games. The league has a year-around program to keep officials involved, though officiating is not a full-time job for any of them.

"Each supervisor has three crews that he has to stay with for half a season," Skorkich said. "Every game is taped and the supervisors spend seven or eight hours on each tape to critique the officials."

Skorich and his wife, who reside in Princeton Junction, N.J., leave for Super Bowl XXV at Tampa on Tuesday.

"It'll be great to back home and to renew acquaintances," Skorich said. "I'm honored that the Dapper Dans would elect me to the Ohio Valley Sports Hall of Fame. (.sy 168)

Nick and his wife, who is from Flint, Michigan, have two daughters – Paula Mathews, who lives in Somerdale, N.J., and Joanne, of Levittown, Pa. Paula and her husband have presented her parents with two grandchildren.

GEORGE E. KOVALICK

1990 Hall of Fame Inductee

George E. Kovalick, who may have won more championships in more sports than any other man to coach in this area, has been named to the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club Sports Hall of Fame.

Kovalick, who died on his 61st birthday, April 8, 1984, produced title-winning teams in football, baseball and wrestling at both the intercollegiate and interscholastic levels. His squads claimed district, conference, state, and national honors during a coaching career that spanned 28 years.

'Coach K', a graduate of Bridgeport High School and Kent State University, was not the founding father of high school wrestling in the valley but has been recognized by his peers as a dedicated, dynamic individual who did more to promote and expand interest in the mat sport in the valley than any other person.

He could lead by example for he enjoyed unparalleled success.

The first seven Ohio Valley Athletic Conference wrestling tournaments were won by Kovalick-coached Bridgeport High teams. The next eight were won by Martins Ferry, where John 'Corky' Vrotsos introduced the sport after being indoctrinated in the finer points by his good friend from Bridgeport.

A man who was marvelously competitive, meticulous in organization and detail and with an enormous capacity for work, Kovalick is already a member of the Halls of Fame of Kent State University, West Liberty State College, the Ohio High School Wrestling Coaches Association and the Ohio High School Athletic Directors Association.

In 1963, he received the Achievement Award at the Ohio Valley Coaches Banquet at Belmont Hills Country Club to celebrate his feat of piloting West Virginia Conference title-winning teams in three sports. He promptly followed up by directing his Hilltopper baseballers to a national championship at the NAIA World Series at St. Joseph, Mo., in 1964.

A 1940 graduate of Bridgeport High, where he played guard in football and outfielder in baseball, Kovalick served with the U.S. Army in the China-India-Burma theatre of operations during World War II.

He had attended a junior college at Scooba, Miss., for a semester before entering the service but after the war enrolled at Kent State, where he became a four-year varsity gridder. He starred at guard on the Kent football team and was captain of the squad in 1948 as a junior.

Kovalick began his coaching career at Bridgeport and introduced wrestling there in 1950. Building from rock bottom, he developed Bridgeport into one of Ohio's top powers in the mat sport. His grappers not only dominated the OVAC tournaments but won five straight district championships.

In 1955, the Bulldog wrestlers were runnersup in the Ohio state tournament. And in '59, Bridgeport made history by breaking a stranglehold on the state championship that had been held by Cleveland schools since 1942.

While at Bridgeport, Kovalick produced six individual state champions. He also guided the Bulldogs' baseall teams to four Eastern Ohio League championships, four district tournament tited, and three OVAC crowns.

Promoted from assistant to head coach in football at Bridgeport in 1960, he moulded a team that lost only one game. His outstanding work with the Bulldogs won him a coaching post at West Liberty. Originally hired as head mentor in wrestling and baseball and as an assistant in football, he became head grid mentor in 1962 and his team that year lost only one game. The following year, his Hilltoppers dropped their opener to Glenville State and bounced back to go the rest of the way undefeated to capture the West Virginia Conference title.

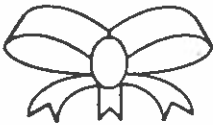
At West Liberty, one of Kovalick's athletes-in football, baseball, and basketball-was Bobby Douglas, who also played for him at Bridgeport. Douglas won an NAIA wrestling championship in 1962 and a year later was a runnerup in both the NAIA and NCAA tournaments. Douglas subsequently transferred to Oklahoma State University, became a two-time U.S. Olympian, and established himself as one of the nation's top collegiate grappling coaches. And he still credits the influence and guidance of Kovalick for the success of his career

Future big leaguer Joe Niekro was one the stars of Kovalick's 1964 national championship baseball team.
