DAPPER DAN "MAN OF THE YEAR" BILL VAN HORNE

Bill Van Horne, sports editor of the Wheeling News-Register whose distinguished career has now spanned some 52 years, has been chosen to receive the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club's highest award.

He is the "Man of the Year" at this banquet.

"This is a long overdue award for a man who has dedicated his life to sports in the Ohio Valley," Dapper Dan president Jerry Hamill said, "Bill has also been a great booster and contributor to our club for many years."

A tireless worker on behalf of Dapper Dan since the Upper Ohio Valley chapter was organized in the mid-'60s, Van Horne introduced many of the past recipients for the "Man of the Year Award" at the annual banquets and has also handled the introduction of numerous Dapper Dan Hall of Fame inductees.

Now he will take his place among such "Men of Year" as Notre Dame coach Lou Holtz, U.S. Olympic wrestling coach Bobby Douglas, major league baseball greats Bill Mazeroski, Phil Niekro, Joe Niekro, Rollie Fingers, pro football's Bob Jeter, Danny Abramowicz, Lance Mehl, Andy Dorris, Tom Keane, Fred Bruney, and Tim Spencer, and basketball's John Havlicek.

All of the above greats had their roots in the Ohio Valley and most of them are personal friends of Van Horne's.

Van Horne previously was honored by the Dapper Dan Club in 1983 when he was presented the organization's prestigious Robert S. McKelvey Award. The McKelvey Award is named in honor of the founder of the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club.

Van Horne was also honorary banquet chairman one year.

Bill was sports editor for the Martins Ferry-Bellaire Times-Leader for 25 years before joining the News-Register in 1966.

Over the years he has been honored many times for his contributions to sports by organizations in both Ohio and West Virginia. He's a past president of the West Virginia Sports Writers Association and a former member of the board of directors of the Football Writers of America. He still serves as the West Virginia state chairman for the Heisman Trophy selectors committee. He is also on the West Virginia University all-time team committee.

He was named the state sportswriter of the year in 1973 and has received the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference's "Mr. Mat" Award, given annually for contributions to the sport of wrestling. He also has received the OVAC's "Cal Giffin" Award, for contributions in track and field, and three times has been named the Mountain State's wrestling writer of the year.

When the Ohio Valley Wrestling Coaches Association published a book on the history of valley amateur wrestling in 1985, it was dedicated to Van Horne. "A man for all season," he has also been an honorary referee for both the Bellaire Relays and the Wheeling Park Track Classic, two of the largest track meets in the area. For many years, he was public address announcer for both the Bellaire Relays and the OVAC championships.

The long-time sports editor also received the West Virginia Sports Writers Association's Gene Morchouse Memorial Award for distinguished service to his craft.

He was presented the Chairman's Award for the Elby's Distance Race (twice) and has been inducted into the Wheeling-Oglebay Tennis Club Hall of Fame.

In 1989, he was honored with a testimonial dinner at the Wheeling Civic Center and his friends, from coast to coast, showed up for the memorable occasion.

Last summer at Toledo, he was presented the Ohio Baseball Hall of Fame Media Award. This past fall he was honored in his home town of Martins Ferry, as "Bill Van Horne Day" festivities were held in conjunction with the annual Martins Ferry-Bellaire football game. At that time, the Martins Ferry Area Chamber of Commerce established an award in his name to be presented each year to the outstanding English student at Martins Ferry High School.

Van Horne currently serves on three Halls of Fame Boards - for Dapper Dan, the West Virginia Sports Writers Association and the Wheeling City Hall of Fame.

In addition to his coverage of local high school and college events, he also reported on such major events as the World Series, the Russian-American track meet, the Pan-American Games, the NCAA wrestling tournament, the major league baseball All-Star Game, and numerous college bowl games.

He was commissioner of the old Times-Leader Baseball League for more than 20 years and was also publicity director for the Wheeling Ironmen professional football team and the Wheeling Blues professional basketball team. He was also a play-by-play football and basketball broadcaster on radio in his younger days and for five years had a weekly radio program called "Saturday Sports Page of the Air," presented over WTRF-AM & FM, now WOMP.

Born March 9, 1921, in Martins Ferry, Van Horne graduated from Ferry High in 1939 and headed to the National Journalism Institute at Northwestern University, Evanston, Ill. Just two years later he was named the sports editor of the Times-Leader.

Van Horne and his wife, Gladys, reside in the North Park section of Wheeling. Gladys Van Horne is the family editor for the

Richard W. Craven Jr., of Toronto, has been named as the 1993 recipient of the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club's Robert S. McKelvey Award.

The award honors the memory of the late Bob McKelvey, founder of the Dapper Dan Club, and has been presented annually since 1975.

"Dick Craven is very worthy of this award," said Jerry Hamill, Dapper Dan Club president. "He represents the ideals which Bob McKelvey made such an integral part of our organization. Dick has not only been on our board of directors but has served as both treasurer and president of the club. He has been a tireless worker in behalf of Dapper Dan. Moreover, he has been an enthusiastic supporter of his home town of Toronto. He is truly a community-minded citizen."

A life-long resident of Toronto and a graduate of Toronto High School, Craven is the owner of the Craven Insurance Agency and has been in business 38 years.

A member of the Toronto Booster Club, he has been the treasurer of that organization since 1969. He has been the public address "voice" of the Toronto Red Knight athletic teams since 1970.

A man of varied interests, he is a member of Dyer Country Club and Skippers Haven Yacht Club. Moreover, he is a charter member of the Toronto Community Band. He has also been a member of the Toronto Band Fathers and served as vice-president.

Craven, who resides in Toronto with his wife Peggy, attends the North River Avenue Church of Christ and is a member of the church choir. He is also a 32nd degree Mason and a member of the Toronto Masonic Lodge, as well as the Scottish Rite and the Valley of Steubenville.

1993 CARL HAMILL AWARD TERRY DEPEW

Terry Depew, highly-successful football coach at Linsly School, is this year's winner of the Carl R. Hamill Award.

Jerry Hamill, who is not only a son of the late Carl Hamill, long-time Weir High coach who produced state champion teams in football, basketball and baseball, but is also president of the Dapper Dan Club, expressed his family's enthusiasm for the Linsly mentor.

"We are proud to have Coach Depew as our honoree for this year," Jerry Hamill said. "The award was established not only to honor outstanding coaches but also men who exemplify the kind of integrity and dedication to school and community for which my father was so well known. We talked to many people before deciding upon a winner and everyone who knows Terry Depew told us of his high standards, his coaching intelligence, his work ethic, and his ability to motivate his young athletes."

Depew has been a head football coach for 13 years at Linsly and has posted a record of 82 victories against 43 losses and a tie. He has produced two undefeated teams back to back (1986-87) and his Cadets have won two Ohio Valley Athletic Conference championships (1987 and '89).

Moreover, his teams produced a 26-game winning streak, which began late in the '85 campaign, extended through the '86 and '87 seasons and through the first three games of the '88 campaign to set a school record. His '88 squad finished with just a 5-5 record but the next fall the Cadets dropped their opener at Martins Ferry, 171-4, and then won nine straight to claim the OVAC double-A crown.

One of his former players is Willie Clay, now a defensive back with the Detroit Lions and a member of the Georgia Tech team which was national co-titles in 1991.

The Linsly mentor is a former Bucknell University gridder and was graduated form the school at Lewisburg, Pa., in 1973. He played his high school football at Juniata High at Mifflintown, Pa.

After one season as a graduate assistant at Bucknell, Depew accepted a post on the staff of Kiski Prep School at Saltsburg, Pa., and served there for five years before coming to Linsly as an assistant. He spent only one year on the Linsly staff before being promoted to head coach.

Depew has been selected to coach the West Virginia team in the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Rudy Mumley All-Star Game on three occasions.

A busy man at the private school, he also serves as assistant headmaster under Reno Diorio and is also business manager. He teaches calculus and statistics and is assistant baseball coach under Gary Sprague.

Depew and his wife, Kathy, have on son, B.J., 16, a junior at Linsly where he was second team all-valley and all-state lineman this past fall.

The Linsly mentor has established himself as an active member of the Wheeling community. He is a member of the Christ United Methodist Church, a volunteer coach for summer league baseball and is an assistant coach in the Wheeling Amateur Hockey Association program.



HENRY J. "Hank" KUZMA 1993 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

Henry J. "Hank" Kuzma -- whose accomplishments as athlete, coach and educator have already landed him in six Halls of Fame -- tonight is being inducted into a seventh


The one-time Duquesne University basketball star, who went on to produce championship hoop teams at both the high school and collegiate levels, has been elected to the Upper Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club Hall of Fame.

Kuzma, 65, thus joins the elite company of athletes and coaches who have attained this lofty status since the Ohio Valley Dapper Dan Club was established in 1967.

Now director of the Franciscan University of Steubenville Foundation, Kuzma was previously named to the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame, the Duquesne University, Tri-State, Western Pennsylvania, Capital Area and Beaver County Halls.

Hailing from Steelton, Pa., where he was one of 10 children in his family, Kuzma became a high school basketball star on a team that was Central Pennsylvania champion. Then he played two years of independent basketball before the late Chick Davies recruited him for Duquesne. He played four years for the Dukes, starting in the 1947-48 season, with his first two seasons under Davies and the last two under Dudey Moore. Led by Charlie Cooper, Red Manning and Kuzma, those Dukes made the NIT field at Madison Square Garden twice and compiled a 70-23 record over the four-year period.

After college, "Hank" played semipro basketball in Harrisburg, Pa., and was employed in the manufacture of Thompson jet engines. His first coaching job was at a school for delinquent boys in Grove City, Pa. He coached three sports.



With such talent as Jim Smith, Paul Brownlee, John Clark, John Blanda, John Nese, Wayne Smith, Jack Cibulka and Bobby Maher on Kuzma's rosters, the Barons made the NAIA tournament field three times. They never lost a gave at Big Red gym and put together winning streaks of nine, 16, 22 and 23 straight games.

The Barons reached their pinnacle in 1958 when the team was selected by the United Press Board of Coaches as No. 1 small-college power in the nation and Kuzma was picked as "small college coach of the year." That was the team which won 23 straight, lost only to Mt. St. Marys, and was considered for the NIT.

After narrowly missing several collegiate jobs, Kuzma moved on to Canon-McMillan High School at Canonsburg, Pa., in 1959. A year later, he was hired as coach at Midland, Pa., High and began a phenomenal run.

In seven seasons, his Midland teams won 141 games and lost 15. Three of his teams were unbeaten during the regular season. Although Midland had only approximately 240 students enrolled in the high school, its charges played in the top division of competition (Class AAA) in Pennsylvania and the dazzling 1965 aggregation, led by Norm Van Lier and Simmy Hill, won 28 straight games and the state championship.

Kuzma coached in the Dapper Dan Roundball Classic in Pittsburgh in 1965.

From 1966 to '68, he not only coached at Midland but was high school principal. Owner of a master's degree from Duquesne, in the fall of '68 he decided to concentrate on school administrative work and became principal at Hershey, Pa., Senior High.

Kuzma remained at Hershey through 1976 and then returned to coaching at Plum Borough, Pa., High, where his cagers won 13 games in his first season and 20 in his second. The two-year mark of 33-13 was the best in the history of the school.


With a career record showing 341 coaching victories, he decided to go back to Steubenville, where he has worked since in various capacities, not only for the university but also as a fund-raiser for St. John's Medical Center and the St. John's Foundation.

Kuzma and his wife, Catherine, an elementary school teacher for 32 years, are proud parents of three sons and a daughter, with all four having outstanding academic qualifications. For nine straight years, they had a son on the varsity basketball team at the U.S. Naval Academy as Henry, Charles and Jim Kuzma were outstanding athletes.

Lt. Commander Charles Kuzma is stationed at Pascagoula, Miss., and his ship-building responsibilities; Lt. Commander Jim Kuzma is a submariner now located at Norfolk, Va., and during Desert Storm was on a nuclear submarine protecting ships in the Mediterranean Sea.

Now a civilian, Henry J. Kuzma is still associated with the navy in that he works as a special investigator in damage and fire control. He is located at Crystal City, near Washington, D.C.


The Kuzmas' only daughter, Mary Kuzma Mosko, a high school valedictorian, has one son, Dave Mosko, a former Steubenville Catholic Central athlete. Mrs. Mosko is a graduate of the University of Pittsburgh and is now in medical school at the University of Cincinnati.



JOHN REGER 1993 DAPPER DAN HALL OF FAME

John Reger, is a former defensive captain of the Pittsburgh Steelers and a 12-year veteran of the National Football League. He is a native of Wheeling and graduate of Linsly Institute. Reger was signed by the Steelers as a free agent in 1955 and made the team, even though he had the benefit of only three collegiate varsity games to his credit and had been out of the sport for three seasons.

Reger made the Pro Bowl three times during his Steeler days, being in 1959, 1960 and 1962. He was picked in 1961, but was injured and unable to play. He was selected as the Steelers' most valuable player by the Curbstone Coaches Club of Pittsburgh in 1959.



Reger was released by the Steelers in 1963 and picked up by the Washington Redskins, for whom he played for two more seasons before retiring. He came back for the 1966 campaign, retiring for good after that.

At Linsly, Reger played his senior year for a 9-1 team. He was captain of the All-Ohio Valley Athletic

Conference team in 1949 as a fullback and linebacker.

After high school, he played freshman football for the Panthers, but tore up his knee in a game against Indiana. He dropped out of school the following January.

Now, at age 61, he is basically retired except for his work for the Tampa chapter of the NFL Alumni, for which he is treasurer.

John Reger and his wife Janice live in North Tampa. They have two grown children - Kathy, a registered nurse in Hollywood, FL and John, who is a golf professional and a general manager and head pro at the Golf Club of Jacksonville. He and his wife have two grandchildren, John, 5 and Emily, 2.

THOMAS C. EAKIN 1993 DAPPER DAN HONOREE



Thomas C. Eakin founded the Ohio Baseball Hall of Fame in 1976, and has been its president every since.

Mr. Eakin, also known as "The King of Whoville" has the longest biography of any Rotarian listed in Who's Who in America. Eakin's biography is 128 lines long. He has set, and holds, the Rotary International World Record for starting and completing 20 new projects in a Rotary year. This happened when Eakin was President of the Shaker Heights Rotary Club in 1970-1971.

Mr. Eakin is a member of several Hall of Fames including: Ohio Iota (Phi Delta Theta) Hall of Fame, World Biographical Hall of Fame, Cy Young Tuscarawas County Old Timers Baseball Association, Ohio Record Holders Hall of Fame, City of Cleveland Volunteers Hall of Fame, Chautauqua Sports Hall of Famer, American Athletic Association of the Deaf Hall of Fame and received the Police Hall

of Fame's Highest Honor, The Order of Michael The Archangel.

Mr. Eakin, graduate of Denison University has been a leader in numerous civic and social organizations and has received numerous awards for his professional contributions, most notable, the 1978 Governor's Award for Distinguished Ohioans. Other awards and commendations have come from Presidents Truman, Johnson, Nixon, Ford and Reagan; Ohio Governors James A. Rhodes and John J. Gilligan; the Ohio Senate; Louisiana Governor Edwin W. Edwards, for Eakin's promotion of the Superdome in New Orleans, Louisiana; North Carolina Governor James B. Hunt, Jr; Kentucky Governor Martha Layne Collins, Maryland Governor William D. Schaefer, New Mexico Governor Garrey Carruthers; the Premier of London, Ontario, Canada; and from various sports figures and publications, including Sport Magazine. In 1987 Governor Arch Moore, Jr. named Eakin "Honorary West Virginian" for his contributions to the State of West Virginia. Over 300 cities throughout the United States and Canada have proclaimed days in Mr. Eakin's honor for his contributions to the promotion of sports and youth activities. An Ohio record was established in 1987 when he became the only person in the history of the state to have a day proclaimed in his honor, "Thomas C. Eakin Day", by at least one city or village in every county in the State of Ohio.

Among the distinguished biographical references that list his accomplishments are Who's Who in America, Men of Achievement, and Who's Who in the World.

Eakin and his wife, Brenda, and sons Tom and Scott, live in Shaker Heights, Ohio a suburb of Cleveland.

JOHN KONSTANTINOS 1993 DAPPER DAN HONOREE



John Konstantinos, athletic director at Cleveland State University and a former coaching assistant to Lou Holtz, is a special Dapper Dan honoree.

A former three-sports star at Yorkville High School who went on to play collegiate and professional football, Konstantinos has been at Cleveland State since 1990. He was appointed there after 10 years as associate director of athletics at Kent State University, his alma mater.

"John is one of our valley boys who distinguished himself as an athlete, coach and administrator and we are happy to have the opportunity to honor him at our banquet" said Larry Falbo, banquet co-chairman. "He's an outstanding person and a true sportsman."

At Yorkville High, Konstantinos played football, basketball and base-ball. He went to Morris Harvey College (now the University of Charleston) and played three years of football there as a defensive back. When Morris Harvey gave up football, he transferred to Kent State, where he played his senior year.

Graduated from Kent State in 1959, he joined the staff at Kent Roosevelt High as an assistant football coach, head wrestling coach and mathematics

teacher and served in that capacity until '65. He won a Metro League championship with his grapplers in '64 and played a role with three league champion football teams.

While teaching, coaching and playing professional football with the Cleveland Bulldogs of the old United Football League, he also found time to work on his master's degree, which he obtained at Kent in 1962.

When the Bulldogs' franchise was moved to Canton in '64, Konstantinos played there. The next year, the team--which switched to the Continental League--was transferred to Philadelphia and the Yorkville product went along as a player-assistant coach. He took a coaching job at Triton Regional High in Runnemede, N.J., but the next year joined the staff at Temple University as an assistant.

Subsequently, he became a member of Holtz's staff at William and Mary College and was there when the Indians won the Southern Conference championship and a berth in the Tangerine Bowl in 1971.

From '72 through '74, Konstantinos was with Holtz at North Carolina State and the Wolfpack participated in three bowl games in as many years.


In '75, "Johnny K" was appointed head football coach at Eastern Illinois University and held that position for three years. In '78 he moved to the University of Arkansas as an administrative assistant with duties as director of recruiting and offensive ends coach under Holz. The Razorbacks played in the Fiesta Bowl, Sugar Bowl and Hall of Fame Bowl during the three seasons he was there prior to joining the Kent athletic staff in 1980.

Originally hired at Kent as associate A.D. in charge of finance, with the responsibility of operating the business and ticket offices, as well as supervising athletic department promotions, he was subsequently promoted twice and from '85 until his move to Cleveland State, was associate A.D. of athletic development and sports services. He acquired a reputation as a fund-raiser and resourceful administrator.

Upon being informed that he was to be a Dapper Dan honoree, Konstantinos said, "I'm looking forward to returning to the Ohio Valley. That's where I obtained the foundation for both my athletic and educational careers. I'm flattered by the honor."

Konstantinos and his wife, Sandra Ann, have two children, Alexandria and Christopher.

NICK TROMBETTA 1993 DAPPER DAN HONOREE



Nick Trombetta is originally from Aliquippa, Pennsylvania and has been involved in education for 17 years (16 as a coach).

A graduate of Quigley High School in Baden, Pennsylvania, he was captain and M.V.P. of the football and wrestling teams. He attended Slippery Rock State College and returned to Quigley to teach and coach in 1976.

In 1979 at the age of 23 Mr. Trombetta was elected to the Aliquippa School Board and became one of the youngest school directors ever to serve in that capacity in the State of Pennsylvania. He served as treasurer and vice president during his term.

In 1980 Mr. Trombetta left his Alma Mater to teach and coach in East Liverpool, Ohio. He became East Liverpool's all-time winningest coach in school history with a record of 149 wins and 24 losses. His teams posted 12 consecutive winning seasons and three undefeated campaigns. His 1992 team went 12-0. He was named coach of the year 9 times by various conferences and leagues and was a finalist for the Ohio Coach of the Year on three occasions. He also served as the head football coach in 1985 of Midland, Pennsylvania.

In 1990, Mr. Trombetta was a recipient of the Outstanding Educator Award from the Ohio Department of Education for his work with troubled teenagers and also was honored by Scholastic Coach Magazine in 1992 as one of America's Outstanding coaches.

In March of 1992, he answered the call from his hometown to return and become principal in their school system. He is most proud of what has been accomplished since that time. He and his staff have instituted 47 new programs which have ranged from advanced Science and Computers, to Dance and Drama.

Mr. Trombetta holds a Masters Degree in School Administration and holds an Elementary and Secondary Principal's Certificate.
