Convocation Center

The 1995-96 season marks the start of the 28th year of Ohio basketball in the Convocation Center, one of the finest facilities in the Midwest, if not the entire nation.

Built in 1968 at a cost of \$8.5 million, the "Convo" is one of the largest arenas in the Mid-American Conference. Its nearly 13,000 seats include more than 12,000 permanent theatretype seats and several hundred courtside retractable bleacher seats.


their new home, (including a remarkable streak of 26 consecutive victories). Ohio has never had a losing season at home and boasts a 74.5 percent (222-76) record over its first 25 years.

During the 1994-95 season Ohio's women were 12-0 in the Convo.

Perhaps the most exciting game ever played in the Convo was on February 14, 1983, when the Bobcat men stunned Ray Meyer's DePaul Blue Demons 63-62 in double overtime.

nament contest with Illinois mark the Convo's most exciting week. While the Convo has been the scene of exciting basketball and the home of several university sports camps in years past, it is much more than just a

sports facility. It houses the Ohio University athletics department as well as the modern training room used by Ohio's sports medicine department.

The Convo also serves as home to nearly 300 students, who are housed in the facility's residence hall.

The Convocation Center continuously has served as a major factor in the rise of Ohio University and its athletic prestige over the past 27 years.
