State Champs

With the reminiscence of the last year's tournament ringing in their ears, the Purple Riders climaxed an outstanding season by battling their way through the district tournament to become Class A Champs for the second successive year, thus entitling them to compete in the state tournament, which is a fitting reward for the hard work that goes into making a winning team.

With one of the most aggressive and cleverest coached quintets to appear in a state tournament in recent years. Martins Ferry rolled to the first state championship in the school's history when it defeated the Lakewood combine, 37 to 30, in the finals at Columbus. The Champs fought their way into the finals by edging Lima Central, 33 to 32; upsetting Canton McKinley, 40 to 27, and edging Xenia Central, 36 to 34, in the semi-finals

The Martins Ferry - Xenia semi-finals encounter was one of the most thrilling contests in the 19-year history of the state scholastic tournament. The Champs left the gallant Xenia team 9 to 5 at the quarter, 19 to 17 at the half, and 27 to 24 at the third quarter. In the final period, the Xenia outfit rallied brilliantly to the the score at 32 - all, and then at 34 - 34. With the score at this point knotted, Groza drove in for an attempted crip shot. He was fouled as the gun ending the game sounded. "Chief" then stepped calmly to the foul line and sank both shots to give his team victory.

In the finals, Lakewood's combine gave the protégés of Coach Baker a real battle for three quarter, but they could not hold to the pace, and in the final minutes of play the Champs won going away. For three quarters the game was a dog fight like the Champs had in the semi-finals against Xenia Central. Lakewood held an 11 to 9 lead at the quarter, but by half - time the Champs knotted the count at 14 - 14. In the third period Lakewood went back in front and held a 25 to 23 lead at the end of the period. During that hectic third quarter the lead changed hands on eight different occasions. "Chief" Groza, who was the hero, of the Champs' play throughout the tournament tied the score at 25 - all soon after the last period opened. That was the spark that set the Ferry team aftre.

In short, the champs won the title by out speeding and outlasting every team it opposed.

The 1941 State Champs were honored by two berths on the all state tourney team. "Big Chief" Groza by tallying 51 points in the four games, coupled with his excellent rebound work, won himself the place of all state center, while Willie Elias was honored with a guard position. Eddie Joseph was named the best foul shooter, and Bill Young the most improved player in the tourney.

We are more than proud of our team, coaches, and loyal fans of Martins Ferry. We hope that Ferry will continue with its fine sportsmanship and basketball tactics that put them at the peak of success.




