THE CONVO

This season marks the start of the 29th year of Ohio basketball in the Convocation Center, one of the finest facilities in the Midwest, if not the entire nation.

Built in 1968 at a cost of \$8.5 million, "The Convo" as it is known to Ohio fans is the largest arena in the Mid-American Conference. Its nearly 13,000 seats include more than 12,000 permanent theatre-type seats and several hundred courtside retractable bleacher seats

The inaugural game in 1968 saw Ohio rally from a 13-point deficit to record a stunning 80-70 victory over Big Ten foe Indiana.

That initial win began an era which saw the Bobcat men triumph in 35 of their first 37 games in their new home, (including a remarkable streak of 26 consecutive victories). Ohio has never had a losing season at home.

The Ohio women began playing in The Convo in 1974. During the 1994-95 season, Ohio's women were 12-0 in The Convo.

The facility has been the site of many of the largest men's and women's crowds in MAC regular season history.

An overflow throng of 14,102 on Feb. 28, 1970, saw Ohio's men clinch the league championship with a season-ending 77-76 victory over Bowling Green. A recordsetting crowd of 5,464 on Jan. 8,

1994 watched the Bobcat women trounce arch-rival Miami, 79-68.

Perhaps the most exciting game ever played in the Convo was on February 14, 1983, when the Bobcat men stunned Ray Meyer's DePaul Blue Demons 63-62 in double overtime.

The 1986 men's NIT game against Ohio State and the women's NCAA tournament contest with Illinois mark The Convo's most exciting week.

While the Convo has been the scene of exciting basketball and the home of several university sports camps in years past, it is much more than just a sports facility. It houses the Ohio athletics department as well as a training


The Convo also serves as home to nearly 300 students, who are housed in the facility's residence hall

The Convocation Center continuously has served as a major factor in the rise of Ohio University and its athletic prestige.


