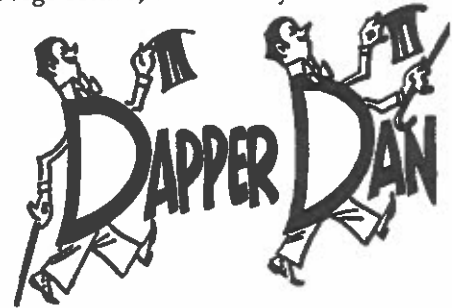

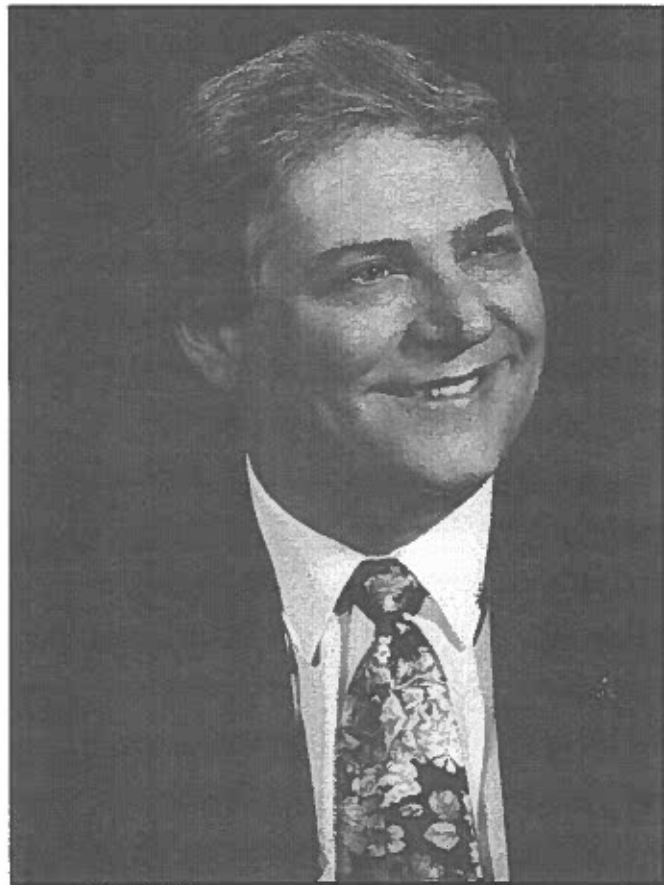

DAPPER DAN "MAN OF THE YEAR" MIKE LINSKY

1996 marked the third state championship for Mike. The 1968 Sherman, WV graduate has won two at Duval in 1978 and 1982.

The 1996 championship marked the first for Mike at John Marshall High School and the first ever in football at John Marshall.

The Hampden Sidney and Marshall graduate has been coaching for 25 years. His overall record is 143 wins 94 losses, 89 and 60 at John Marshall.

Mike and his wife Sandy live in Glen Dale with their four children, Jeremy, Lori, Mica and Chelsea. Mike is involved in many school activities, especially his weight training program, which really paid off this year.

The Monarchs finished the regular season with a 9-1 mark. The only blemish came in the seasons final game against Wheeling Park by the score of 14-6. Once in the playoffs John Marshall defeated University High School of Morgantown 36-0. Next, it was Wheeling Park, this time the Monarchs defeated the Patriots 24-10. North Marion was the final step to the championship game for the second time in 1996, John Marshall beat a strong North Marion team, 27-18.

On a beautiful December day, the temperature in the 40's, sunny, and a standing room only crowd of over 10,000, packed Wheeling Island Stadium (Estimated 8,000 Monarch fans).

With a big play defense, heads up special teams play, a strong running game and a key passing game, the Monarch's team with Mike and his staff produced a victory over Capital by the score of 29-22.

1997 CARL HAMILL AWARD CARL FODOR

This award is given annually to an active or retired coach who exemplifies coach Hamill's dedication, not only to his players but to his entire community.

Carl Fodor has the distinction of being a member of the last West Liberty football team coached by the legendary Joe Bartell. He began his athletic career at West Liberty in 1956, when he played offensive end and defensive tackle for the Hilltoppers.

In addition to his success on the football field, Fodor excelled as a member of the West Liberty basketball team. He earned three letters in basketball and was a member of Ollie Olson's 1957 team that posted a record of 23-6 and upset powerful conference champion West Virginia Tech on the way to winning the conference tournament.

The following year Fodor was recognized for his athletic accomplishments when he was named the college's most outstanding athlete.

After his graduation from West Liberty in 1959, Fodor joined the Weir High staff as a teacher, head wrestling coach and assistant track and football coach, later serving as head football and track coach. During his tenure as wrestling coach, he produced three state championship squads and 11 individual state wrestling champions. His teams compiled a 77-29 dual meet record and his 1965 team went undefeated in dual meets.

As head football coach from 1962 through 1967, Fodor twice guided his teams to impressive 8-2 seasons and during his last three years as head coach, his teams dropped only nine games. His track teams also enjoyed great success as they compiled a dual meet record of 34-4; and his 1965 team captured the Region I championship while finishing third in the state meet.

After he retired from coaching, Fodor went on to serve as assistant principal and principal at Weir Jr. High and assistant superintendent of Hancock County Schools.

Ohio Valley Athlete of the Year Joey Galloway

EAHAWK'S '95 DRAFT.....FIRST PICK: JOEY GALLOWAY

1991, Joey Galloway caught 14 passes for 255 yards. In his second game of '92 he tore his right anterior cruciate ligament while returning kickoff, and had to have knee surgery. In 1993, Galloway returned to catch 45 passes for 927 yards and 11 TD's. He also ran the ball 7 times for 146 yards and two touchdowns and returned 18 punts for 97 yards. At the end of the year, he was named All-Big-Ten. Galloway was suspended for 2 games in '94 for taking money from a financial adviser after the '93 season. His stats for the '94 season were 36 receptions for 523 yards and 5 TD's. He also carried the ball 12-52-1 and returned 15 punts for 150 yards and 15 kickoffs for 401 yards and a score. In the Citrus Bowl, Joey caught 8 passes for 146 yards and two TD's. He destroyed Alabama: Finally, he was named offensive MVP at the East-West Shrine game after catching 6-112-1.*

Joey Galloway has tremendous speed, quickness and acceleration. Although he has had knee surgery and some shoulder problems he seems to have recovered fully. He has the ability to explode away from defensive backs and is very good in adjusting to the ball by looking back over his shoulder. He can bench press more than 2 times his weight, and has been timed at 4:17 in the 40 yard dash.

WHAT SOME PUBLICATIONS HAVE BEEN SAYING ABOUT GALLOWAY:

"Galloway does not have the size of a Westbrook or a Stokes in a day and age when everyone seems to favor the bigger receivers. Nevertheless, with his great speed and acceleration, if he is even, he is leavin', and he will make some outstanding adjustments on the deep ball. Unlike many speed-type receivers, Galloway can pluck the ball with his hands, is very strong and has great instant speed and suddenness. He also can return kickoffs and punts and run reverses, and he is known as a quick returner" -- Joe Buchsbaum, Pro Football Weekly

He has the best speed in the draft. Galloway ran a 4.19 at Ohio State's pro day in March. His abilities as a kick returner improve his stock. Galloway finished sixth in the NCAA in kickoff returns with an average of 26.7 yards. But his meal ticket is receiving. He started three years at Ohio State and averaged better than 17 yards per catch. He torched Alabama for 146 yards and two touchdowns in the Citrus bowl" -- The Sporting News
