“The Tri-State Clash of Champions” was jointly conceived by former East Liverpool High School wrestling coach, Nick Trombetta, now Dr. Trombetta, CEO of PA Charter Cyber School, and Mr. Ed Driscoll, Trombetta’s highly respected mentor, head wrestling coach and administrator at Quigley Catholic High School in Baden, PA. Although Dr. Trombetta has moved on to greater challenges, he continues to support Ohio Valley wrestling with his generous financial contributions. Coach Driscoll continues in his original capacity as a Coordinator of “The Clash”.

An eight years hiatus followed Trombetta’s departure to an administrative position in Aliquippa, PA.

With Driscoll’s continuing enthusiasm and Wheeling Park’s, Gene Monteleone’s belief in the worth of the event “The Clash” was re-born in 2003.

Since its inception, “The Clash” has showcased some of the finest wrestling talent in the Tri-State Area.

It has served a dual role, providing true wrestling fans the opportunity to witness a format for outstanding high school level competition, unparalleled any where in the area, while affording college coaches the luxury of scouting prospective recruits vying against quality opponents.

The worth of all the effort expended, in staging such an event, bore the sweetest of fruit in the 1989 Clash. Troy Keith, unheralded and unrecruited OVAC Champion from Meadowbrook High in Ohio, handily defeated Mike Michalec of Hopewell 12-4. Michalec had just finished 3rd in the AAA Division of the PIAA State Tournament. Coach Pat Pecora of Pitt-Johnstown, who was in attendance, immediately recruited Keith. Keith is now a teacher and highly respected head wrestling coach at his high school alma mater, Meadowbrook High.
