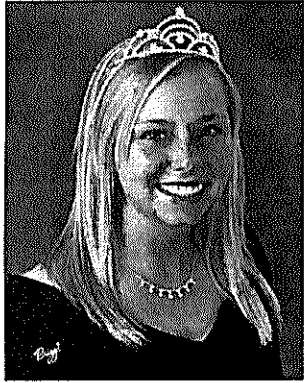

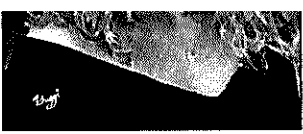

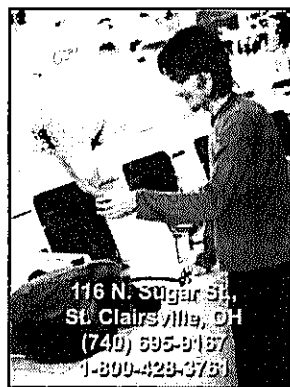
Also on Wednesday, the "Evening with the Stars" dinner will be held at the White Palace at Wheeling Park. Reservations are required for this event.
