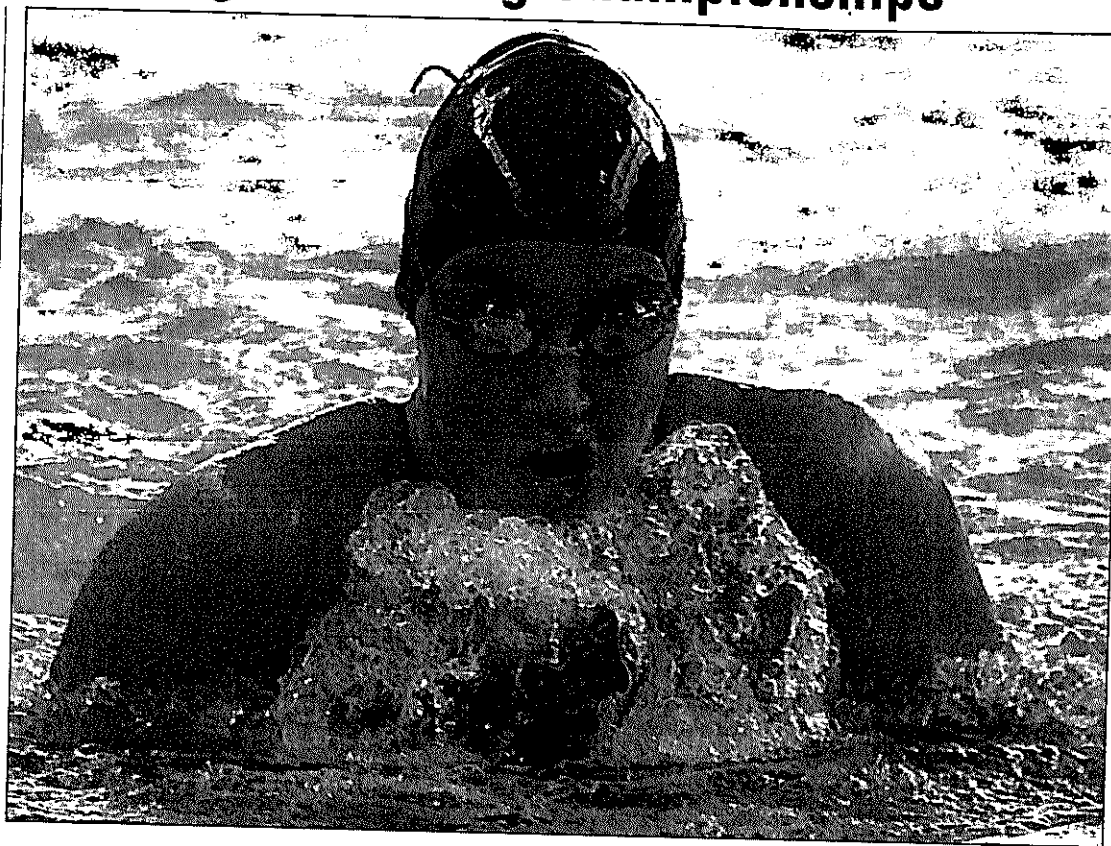

Linsly Registers Sweep

Wheeling Park girls take second in Class 4A-5A

STEUBENVILLE — According to senior Zach Hamm, the Linsly boys' and girls' swim teams had a little extra motivation to win team titles at the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Swimming Championships at Steubenville Big Red's Natatorium.

Longtime swim coach Bill Brubaker was honored before the meet and it was announced that Brubaker's name would now bestow the championship meet.

"That was unexpected that they were going to name the



meet in honor of him, and we said 'we're getting it for him. This is for Brubaker,' " said Hamm, who won four golds as the Cadets ran away with the Class 3A-1A boys and girls team titles and scored the most points on the afternoon with 394.

Steubenville Catholic Central was second in the boys' competition with 46 points.

The Linsly girls totaled 173 points, 66 more than second-place Barnesville.

The Parkersburg South boys

won the Class 4A-5A team championship with 337 points, besting second-place Morgantown's 255.

The Mohigans girls grabbed the Class 4A-5A team trophy with 342 points ahead of Wheeling Park's 255.

"You can accomplish everything individually, but when it comes to the team and everyone steps up and does what they do, we all win and we all accomplish something as a team and that's a much better feeling," said Hamm, who won the 100 fly in pool-record 54.89.

He also touched the wall first in the 100 back in 57.46 and teamed with Drew Bastian, Chris Reardon and Reese Boyd to win the 200 medley relay in 1:46.22 and partnered with Bastian, Reardon and Cameron Thompson to capture the 200 free relay in a meet record 1:33.87.

There were a few surprises, one of which came from Brooke sophomore Jessie Wayne after winning the 500 free in 5:49.27.

"I was swimming against great competition like Bekah Shephard, Emiliee Heilman, Emily Lederman and Hannah Cebula, so, yes, I did surprise myself," Wayne admitted after swimming the last four 50s the best in 35.39, 35.08, 34.67 and 33.98."

"This has set my standards higher than what I had expected. It definitely opened my eyes a little bit."

Wheeling Park's Cecelia Jebbia was also a four-time winner. She won the 200 free (2:01.46), 100 free (55.90) and partnered with Heilman, Katlyn Curnes and Cristin Dolan to win the 200 medley relay in 1:58.81, which set a pool and meet record, and the 400 free relay comfortably in 3:56.24.

"This meet really helps us as we get ready for regionals and states," said Jebbia, a

junior, who was favored in her individual events.

"It's really nerve-racking and it's a lot of pressure, but I really do think it helps me to win my races. It really pushes me. I kind of like it."

Parkersburg South coach Steve Lutz, like Brubaker, also took a bath in the pool after winning the team title.

The day, though, belonged to Linsly. The Cadets won half of the 22 events, finished 1-2 in the boys 50 free and did not finish in the top five in five races.

Since the Cadets do not participate in the state meet, the OVAC meet culminates their team season.

Linsly senior Cameron Thompson won the 200 free comfortably in 1:50.31.

Cadets sophomore Zoe Scarpone won the 200 IM in 2:14.82 and the 100 fly in 1:02.12.

Scarpone teamed with Samantha Schaal, Eve Scarpone and Brie Weimer to win the 200 free relay in 1:49.94.

Bastian, a sophomore, had the first surprise of the day when he beat Barnesville senior Chris Baker in the 200 IM in 2:05.31. Baker came back to win the 500 free in 5:06.88, .05 seconds ahead of Reese, a freshman.

John Marshall junior Jade Worrell grabbed the 50 free in 26.12.

Linsly finished 1-2 in the 50 free with sophomore Liam McNeil (23.29) and sophomore Reardon (23.77).

St. Clairsville's Michael Eaton touched the wall first in the 100 free in 49.62 and the 100 breaststroke in a pool and meet record 59.90.

Curnes, a Wheeling Park junior, won the 100 breaststroke in 1:09.49, eclipsing the meet record of 1:09.93 set by Weir grad Kelsey Ferguson in 2010.

Linsly finished the meet by coming from behind to win the 400 free relay. Reese, Marc Gittings, McNeil and Thompson finished in 3:35.72.

OVAC swimming begins Tuesday

• Qualifying to be held at Park, Linsly and Brooke; Finals slated for Saturday

Another week and another Ohio Valley Athletic Conference championship is on tap.

With wrestling in the rear-view mirror, it's time to shift focus to determine who are the best swimmers in the OVAC.

For the second straight year, the swimming championships will get under way Tuesday evening with qualifying at three sites and the top 16 in each individual event – regardless of location – will earn a trip

to Steubenville's Natatorium inside the Crimson Center for Saturday's finals. It's worth noting that all relays will make the trip to Steubenville. There are no qualifying swims for the relay races.

The qualifying swims, which begin at 5:15 p.m., will be held at Linsly, Wheeling Park and Brooke and geography was used as the method for assigning the sites.

Slated to compete at Linsly are Wheeling Central, Morgantown, Cambridge, Bellaire, St. John Central, East Richland Christian, St. Clairsville and Linsly.

At Wheeling Park are Barnesville, Martins Ferry, University, Parkersburg South, John Marshall and the Patriots.

Swimming at Brooke are: Steubenville, Edison, Brooke, Beaver Local, East Liverpool, Steubenville Central and the host Bruins.

Locally, several individuals and teams have had strong seasons thus far as they enter the most important stretch of the season.

St. Clairsville's boys are led by junior

standout Michael Eaton in the 100 freestyle. His time of 48.96 is the top-seeded mark by nearly five seconds. He also owns the top mark in the 100 breaststroke, posting a 58.72.

Eaton is seeking a repeat in the 100 freestyle. He didn't swim the breaststroke last year, but he's the reigning champion in the 50 freestyle.

Senior Dan Kennon is seventh overall in the 200 freestyle with a 2:05.48, while sophomore D.J. Beck is eighth in the 100 fly with a 1:07.33. Classmate Quentin Clark is 10th in 1:07.67 in the fly and is seeded the same in the 100 breast with a time of 1:15.32.

Senior Nick Tobin is seeded ninth in the 100 freestyle with a time of 56.96. Beck is the sixth seed in the 200 IM with a 2:26.80.

"Our boys have six seeded in the top 16 and all of our 'A' relays are in the top eight," said St. C. head coach Melanie Eaton. "The team has been working hard, but we have been plagued with illness and injury lately. Hopefully, they will all be well in time to qualify and go on to compete and do well on Saturday."

The Lady Red Devils are led by junior Carly Gillespie, who is the fourth seed in the 100 breaststroke with a time of 1:16.19. She's also the fifth seed in the 200-yard IM with an effort of 2:32.39.

Junior Alaina Fasola is seeded sixth in the 100 butterfly with a time of 1:11.31. Her teammate, frosh Delainey Banks, is 10th in 1:13.61.

"The girls team is looking stronger than they have in a while," Eaton said. "We have four girls in the top 16 and all of our 'A' relays are seeded in the top eight."

East Richland Christian's Katie Albert is definitely one to keep an eye on this week. She's seeded third in the 200 freestyle with a 2:10.47 and fourth in the 50 free with a 27.33.

"It should be highly competitive in Katie's two races," said her mother and coach Beth Albert. "The seed times are really close between a lot of girls."

Martins Ferry's girls have two swimmers seeded inside the top 10 overall in three events entering the meet. Junior Shelby Poludniak is 10th in the 500 freestyle with a mark of 6:27. She's also ninth in the in the 100 backstroke with a time of 1:14.15.

Freshman Tara Fogle is the 10th seed in the 200-Yard IM with a time of 2:41.10.

"The team has really worked hard this season as their entry times for the OVAC meet reflect the hard work they have put in," said Riders' head coach Nick Levi. "We hope to use this meet to spring board us into a strong finish."

Barnesville is led by senior standout Christopher Baker, who is the top seed in a pair of events as he tries to add to his OVAC title collection. He's a narrow leader in the 500 freestyle, which he won a season ago, over Linsly frosh Reese Boyd. Baker has posted a 5:12.15, which is .48 ahead of Boyd.

"Christopher spends most of the year as the water and as the season is coming to an end, it's hard to imagine next year without him," said Barnesville head coach Bobbi Jo Johnson. "My hope is that he's able again to take podium in the top position."

Baker is also the top seed in the 200 IM with a time of 2:10.80. He's the three-time defending champion in that event. His effort is 24 hundredths better than Linsly sophomore Drew Bastain.

The lone Shamrocks' girl seeded in the top 10 of an event is sophomore Myka Gordon, who is 10th in the 50 freestyle with a 28.61.

Area swimmers qualify well for OVAC finals

The qualifying is complete and lane assignments are set.

The annual Ohio Valley Athletic Conference Swimming Championship wraps up Saturday at Steubenville High's Crimson Center with action slated to begin at 11:10 a.m.

Qualifying was held Tuesday evening at three sites — Brooke, Linsly and Wheeling Park — and the top 16 overall qualifiers earned a spot in the championship swim, which will be contested with two-heat finals. No qualifying was required in the relay events. All of those will be swam as finals on Saturday.

Here's a closer look at the area teams' swimmers in the top eight. The entire field for each individual event can be found on Page CX in today's edition.

BARNESVILLE — The Shamrocks will be led to the finals by senior standout Christopher Baker.

In the 200 individual medley, Baker swam all four strokes in 2:08.98 for

Junior Shelby Poludniak posted a 6:13.85 in the 500 freestyle, which was the seventh best time swam on Tuesday. She also punched her ticket to the finals in the 100 backstroke with a 1:11.56 in the 100 backstroke.

Tyesha Allen is the eighth seed in the 100 freestyle with a time of 1:04.05.

ST. CLAIRSVILLE — The Red Devils also were impressive during their qualifying swims at Linsly School.

"We didn't really have any real surprises in the qualifying," said Devils head coach Melanie Eaton. "All but one of our kids, who was seeded in the top 16, made the finals. We're excited for Saturday."

The Red Devils were led by junior standout Michael Eaton, who posted the top qualifying time in both the 100 freestyle and 100 breaststroke. He swam a 1:01.12 to lead the breaststroke by better than six seconds. His effort in that race broke the pool record at Linsly, which had stood for 27 years.

In the freestyle, Eaton posted a 50.66, which was nearly three full seconds better than his nearest competitor.

The Linsly boys won the small school and open title with 394 points, Steubenville Catholic Central finished a distant second with 46 points.

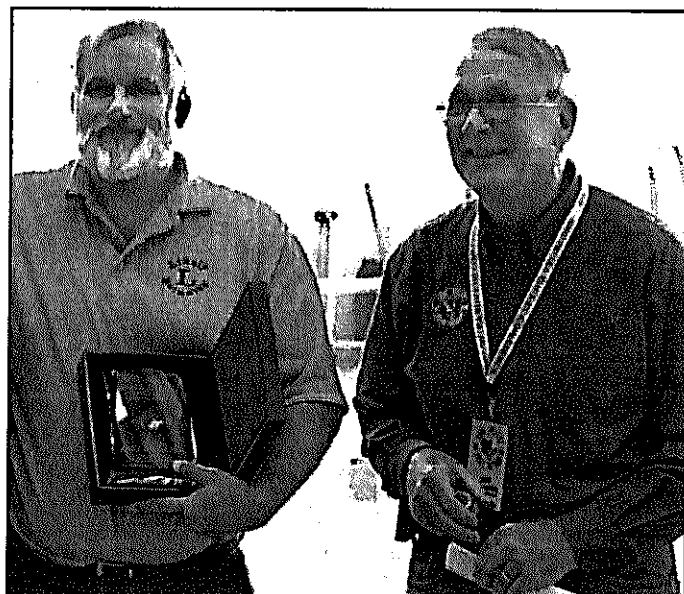

That made Saturday's recognition basically a no brainer for Tom Rataiczak and the OVAC brass.

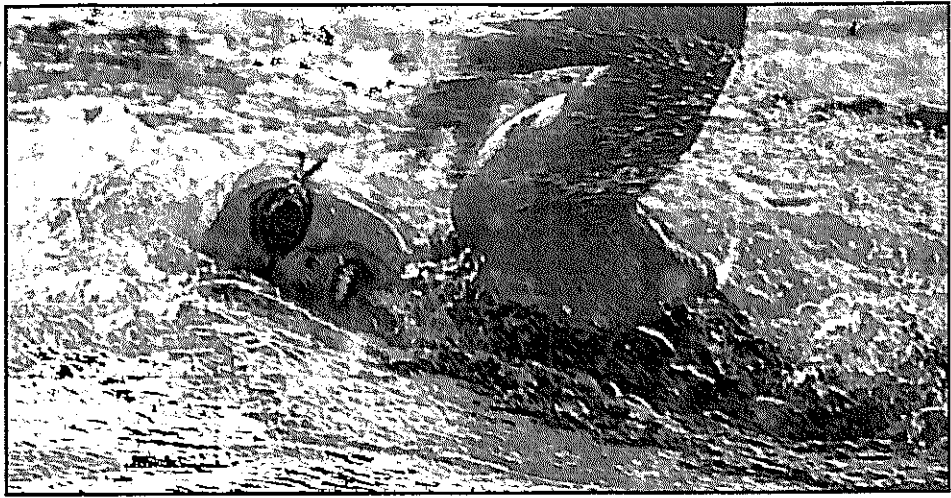
It was formally announced at the annual OVAC Championship that the swimming meet would officially be forever known as the "OVAC Bill Brubaker Swimming Championship."

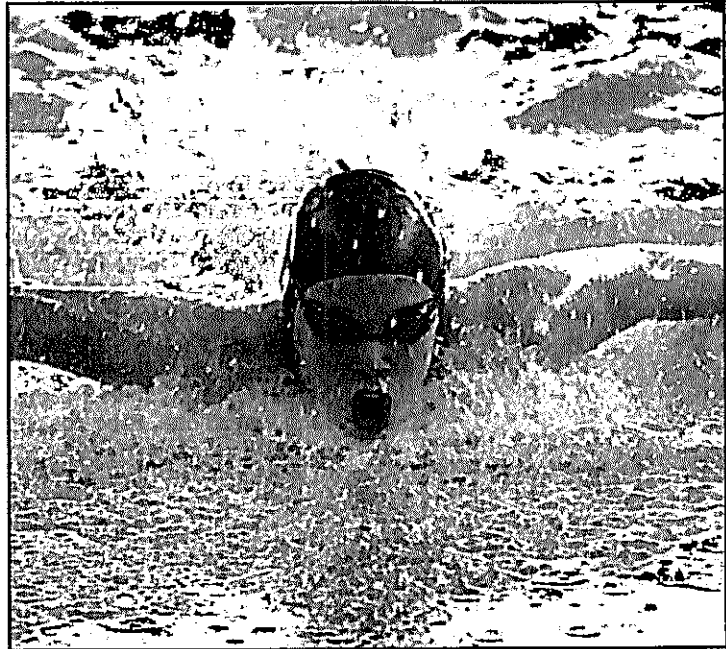

position with 255 while St. Clairsville missed the medal round with a 197 total finishing in third place.

St. Clairsville junior Michael Eaton led local swimmers, setting two new pool and meet records en route to a repeat gold performance.

The first he earned sprinting a 22.42 in his 50 yard leg of the 200 Freestyle Relay to lead the Red Devils' team to a second place finish in the event. He was joined on the squad by Nick Tobin, Dan Kennon and Quentin Clark.

The second record swim was not his personal best, but broke the pool and OVAC meet records with a 59.90 in the 100 breaststroke to garner a gold. He also won the 100 yard freestyle for his second gold medal. He touched the wall with a victorious time of 49.62.

The Red Devils' team made up Eaton, Codi Eaton, Kennon and Tobin also won a silver in the 200 Individual Medley with a time of 1:51.12. The Devils' team of Tobin, Codi Eaton, D.J. Beck and Kennon was fifth in 3:58.64 in the 400 free relay.

Barnesville's Christopher Baker successfully defended his 500 freestyle title. He swam 20 laps in a solid time of

Shelby Poludniak finished fifth in the 400 freestyle with a 4:12.89.

The same foursome swam a 2:06.30 to finish fourth in the 200 medley relay.

Linsly's strong effort got out of the gates quickly when the team of Bastian, Chris Reardon, Zach Hamm and Reese Boyd teamed for gold in the 200 medley relay in a time of 1:46.22.

Cameron Thompson claimed the 200 freestyle with a 1:50.31, while Liam McNeil won the 50 freestyle in 23.29. Hamm got his first individual gold in the 100 fly when he posted a pool-record time of 54.89. He came back with a 57.46 to win the 100 backstroke.
