

## Mike Rodich Assistant Coach of the Year - Sheridan

Coach Rodich began his basketball coaching career as an assistant at Lancaster High School from 1992-1996. He accepted the Head Boys Basketball job at Lakewood High School in 1996 and spent 6 years revitalizing the program finishing as the Division 2 Central District runner up in 2001. For his efforts, he was named Central District Division 2 Coach of the Year in 2000 and District 11 Coach of the year in 2000 and 2001. After 6 seasons at Lakewood, he accepted a position as the men's basketball assistant coach at Denison University from 2002-2006. Coach Rodich spent the next 15 years with his wife Leslie raising and coaching their two children, daughter Rylee, a sophomore nursing student at Columbus State and his son, Raine a junior at Sheridan High School. Mr. Rodich is currently completing his 31st year in education as the assistant principal at Sheridan Middle School. Rodich got back into coaching last year at Sheridan and have been the volunteer assistant there for the last two seasons - finishing as DII State Runner up last year



# Jared Cox Assistant Coach of the Year Maysville

Jared Cox has been coaching for 13 years now, all for the Maysville Panthers. Coaching at Maysville is quite special for Jared as this is his alma mater. He spent the first few years as a volunteer assistant before becoming a middle school coach. 



### **DISTRICT 12 HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 2023**

### Scott Aronhalt, Zanesville

Scott Aronhalt (Zanesville High School Boys Basketball Coach). After serving as an assistant coach at Ashland High School and Tiffin University, Aronhalt began a 31-year stint as head coach at Zanesville, retiring following the 2020-21 season.

He was head coach for 720 games, amassing a sparkling 466-254 record with the crowning achievement coming in 1995 when the Blue Devils captured the OHSAA Division I State Championship. ZHS defeated Westerville North (48-47) in the semifinals and topped Cleveland Heights (69-68 in overtime) in the championship game to cap a spotless 26-0 season.

Aronhalt-coached squads also reached the OHSAA "Final Four in 1997 and 2010. The '97 team lost to Cleveland Heights (60-52 in OT) in the D-II championship game to finish 25-2 while the 2010 squad lost to Port Clinton (51-50) in the D-II semis to finish 17-7.

Under Aronhalt, ZHS won two AP state poll championships and reached USA Today's Top 25 nationally in 1997 after a win against highly-touted Oak Hill.

The Blue Devils won 10 district titles ((1994, '95, '96, '97, 2001, '05, '06, '07, '08, 10) and three regional crowns (1995, 1997, 2000); and were regional runner-up four times (1996, 2005, 2006, 2008). Zanesville competed in various leagues during Aronhalt's years, winning the Buckeye Central Conference twice (1994 and 1995); the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference four times (1996, 1997, 2001 and 2002); the SouthEast Ohio League once (2008); the East Central Ohio League four times (2012, 2013, 2014 and 2018).

He was named Coach of the Year several times in the Eastern District and District 12. He also served as the athletic director at ZHS for several years.


Aronhalt is a 1978 graduate of River View High School where he was a second team all-Ohio and first team all-Eastern District selection who averaged 22.8 points per game as a senior.

### Pat Miller, Maysville

Pat Miller (Maysville High School Girls Basketball Coach). In 18 years as head coach of the Maysville Lady Panthers, Miller enjoyed tremendous success with a sparkling 343-89 record.

During his tenure, Maysville won seven Muskingum Valley League titles; 13 OHSAA Division II Sectional crowns; four OHSAA Division II District championships (2006-07, 2007-08, 2013-14 and 2014-15) and had two OHSAA Division II Regional runner-up finishes (2013-14 and 2014-15). The 2013-14 squad had the school's first undefeated season in girls' basketball and lost to No. 1 ranked and eventual state champion West Holmes (45-26) in the regional final to finish 26-1 and it was West Holmes that also sidelined the Panthers in the 2014-15 regional final (42-34) to finish at 25-2.

Miller-coached teams had seven 20-victory seasons; won 62 consecutive regular season games at one point and never finished below .500 in any season.

He was named Ohio Division II Co-Coach of the Year by The Associated Press following the 2015-16 season. Miller was also named Coach of the Year in the Muskingum Valley League seven times and was also recognized as Coach of the Year in the Eastern District and District 12 on multiple occasions.

Miller, who now serves as the athletic director at Maysville, retired from coaching following the 2020-21 season.


### Debbie Blazek, Bellaire

Debbie Blazek (Bellaire High School, Class of 1991). A four-year letterwinner for the Lady Reds, Blazek tallied 1,099 career points.

After scoring 63 points as a freshman and 225 as a sophomore, she exploded for 434 points as a junior and was selected second team all-Ohio Division II as well as first team all-District 12, all-Eastern District, all-OVAC and all-Valley.

She followed that up with 377 points as a senior and was elevated to first team all-Ohio Division II while repeating as a first teamer on the all-District 12, all-Eastern District, all-OVAC and all-Valley squads, named "Player of the Year" in District 12 and the Eastern District.

Bellaire posted a 15-7 record during Blazek's sophomore season; went 21-2 during her junior year when the Lady Reds won the OVAC and Sectional titles and were ranked No. 6 in the final regular season AP Class AA state poll; and went 22-1 during her senior season (18-0 in the regular season) while wining the OVAC and Sectional titles and earning a No. 4 ranking in the final AP regular season state poll.

She went on to a fine career at West Virginia University, becoming the first Bellaire High female athlete to receive a full athletic scholarship to a Division I school. She was a four-year letterwinner who served as team co-captain as a junior and senior, playing on the Lady Mountaineers' 1992 NCAA Tournament team.

### Jessica McKenzie, West Muskingum

Jessica McKenzie (West Muskingum High School, Class of 2005). One of the best to ever play in the Muskingum Valley League, McKenzie tallied more than 3,000 points combined between high school and college, including a West M school record 1,794 points for the Lady Tornadoes.

As a junior, she averaged 22.6 points per game and received first team All-Ohio Division III honors and was first team and Player of the Year on the All-Eastern District D-III, All-District 12 D-III and all-MVL squads.

McKenzie averaged a double-double of 25.8 points and 12 rebounds per game as a senior while also averaging three assists and three steals per contest. She repeated as a first team All-Ohio D-III selection, this time being named state Co-Player of the Year in the division. Again, she was first team and Player of the Year on the All-Eastern District, All-District 12 and All-MVL squads. She played in the OHSBCA North-South All-Star Game and the District 12 All-Star Game.



Jessica McKenzie

She was also a four-year volleyball standout at West M, earning District 12 and MVL all-star recognition.

She went on to an outstanding hoops career at Muskingum University (2006-2009), finishing with 1,383 with a career scoring average of 17.7 points per game. She set Lady Muskie records for points in a game 37 against Manhattanville (2008-09 season) and highest career field goal percentage (.580).

McKenzie was a three-time first team All-OAC selection (2006, '07, '08) and was the OAC Player of the Year and a second team NCAA Division III All-American as a senior. She was also a two-time Academic All-OAC first team selection.

McKenzie was also a two-time OAC honoree in volleyball. As a senior, she led OAC in blocks (171) while also

### J.R. Battista, Bellaire


J.R. Battista (Bellaire High School, Class of 1992). After playing his first two years at Wheeling Central. Battista transferred to Bellaire to play for his uncle - District 12 Hall of Fame coach Gene Ammirante - at Bellaire.

In just two years with the Big Reds, he tallied 1,114 points in 47 games while collecting 294 rebounds and 83 steals.

As a junior, he scored 519 points and earned All-Ohio Division III special mention along with first team All-Eastern District Division III, All-District 12 Division III, all-OVAC Class 3A and All-Valley.

As a senior, he tallied 595 points (26.0 average) and was first team All-Ohio, All-Eastern District (Player of the Year), All-District 12, all-OVAC and All-Valley. He played in the OVAC Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Basketball Classic and OHSBCA North-South All-Star Game.

Bellaire finished with a 20-3 record in his junior year, winning OVAC Class 3A and OHSAA Division III Sectional titles; and the Big Reds were 19-6 during his senior season, winning OVAC, Sectional and District crowns.



J.R. Battista

He went on to play college basketball at West Liberty where he was a four-year letterman, three-year starter and senior captain. He was named all-West Virginia Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WVIAC) as a senior.

Battista then spent several years assisting Ammirante at Bellaire before taking over as head coach. His first stint in charge of the Big Reds was 2011-2017 and he returned to the post starting in 2019.

Battista serves as Director of the OVAC Samuel A. Mumley All-Star Basketball Classic.

### Jedidiah Stephen, Shenandoah

Jedidiah Stephen (Shenandoah High School, Class of 2002). On the basketball court, Stephen helped guide the Zeps to a 50-17 record during his career. He scored 25 points a game as a senior and finished his career with 1,278 points, which stood as the school record until being eclipsed by Christian Duniver during the 2020-21 season. He scored 549 points during his senior campaign, including a single-game high of 55.

Stephen was a first-team All-Ohioan as a senior and earned Ohio Division III State Player of the Year honors to go along with Eastern District Division III Player of the Year. He was first team All-Eastern District, All-District 12, All-OVAC and All-PVC as both a junior and senior; was the Eastern District nominee for "Mr. Basketball" and took part in both the OHSBCA North-South and OVAC All-Star Games.

In addition to his hoop exploits, Stephen excelled in baseball and football and is the only Shenan-doah athlete to receive all-state honors in three sports.

A four-year baseball starter for the Zeps, Stephen was one of the finest hitters the Ohio Valley has ever seen. He led the Zeps in hitting as a senior at .541, which still stands as the school's all-time best, and for his career, Stephen batted a lofty .475. He belted 12 home runs as a senior, which ranked second in Ohio that season.


He was named to the all-Eastern District team three times and carned first-team all-Ohio from the Ohio High School Baseball Coaches Association as a senior. Along with that, he was named all-OVAC and all-PVC multiple times during his career. As a senior, he was named OVAC Class AAA Player of the Year and was chosen for the Mizuno All-Star Team.

Stephen was also a four-year letterman in football. He had a brilliant senior season at quarterback/defensive back/punter, earning first-team All-Ohio, All-OVAC and All-PVC accolades as well as invitations to both the OHSFCA North-South and OVAC All-Star Games. He finished his prep career with 4,110 yards and 42 touchdowns passing and he ran for 1,992 yards and 32 touchdowns. On the defensive side, he picked off 19 passes and as a punter, he averaged 41 yards per kick.

The recipient of Shenandoah's Myron Miley Senior Award and a PVC Scholar-Athlete, he was inducted into the OVAC Hall of Fame in 2013, the Mid-Ohio Valley Sports Hall of Fame in 2014 and the charter class of the Shenandoah Athletic Hall of Fame in 2021

Stephen signed a baseball scholarship with The Ohio State University and made a major impact. A four-year letterman, he started 195 games at third base and shortstop and batted .286 for his career. He had 135 hits, 18 home runs, 95 RBI, scored 83 runs and drew 40 walks. He was a second team All-Big Ten selection as a senior and earned Academic All-Big Ten honors multiple times.

He was drafted in the eighth round of the 2006 Major League Baseball Draft by the Baltimore Orioles and played four years in the minor leagues before an injury ended his playing career.
