





RESULTS OF 1961 BELLAIRE RELAYS
(Points on a 6-4-3-2-1 basis)

General Information

Place: Nelson Field - 26th St. - Bellaire

Spikes: Are not to be worn in grandstands
on field event bleachers.

Registration: Nelson Field.

Shot Put and Discus will be thrown from
cement. All other field event areas are
of asphalt. Soft rubber shoes should be
worn but 1-8 inch spikes acceptable.

A medical tent will be located in the
middle of the field and available to
your team. This area will be supervised
and directed by Dr. Peter Lancione along
with Doctors Tom Ring, Leo Covert, John
Foster and Charles Messenly.

All relays will be ran against time.

The area adjacent to the finish line will
be fenced off and contestants found in this
area will cause his team mates to be dis-
qualified. The finish line officials must
have a good view at all times.

Relay Exchanges: The 880 Yard sprint relay
will be run in lanes and the team will ex-
change batons in their respective lanes.
In the other relays, the California ex-
change will be used and the teams will
be placed in position according to the
position of the incoming runners.

Points: Five places will count and the
scoring (including relays) will be as
follows: 6-4-3-2-1.

Restrictions: Any boy who runs the 880
on the mile run cannot take part in more
than one other track event. The relays
shall be counted as track events. No
boy can compete in more than four events
of which only three can be track events.

Track: The track is a 440 yard track
with a 220 yard straight away.

The shot and discus will be run in flights
according to best distances.
All schools entering teams in our relays
must abide by the rules and regulations
adopted by their state associations.
