The BELLARE RELAYS was first conceived back in the winter of 1954, when Charles "Bud" Keyser, track coach, called a meeting of a few interested track persons to discuss the idea of renewing the old "Belmont Relays" which had been abandoned during the war.

From these several meetings, the BELLARE RELAYS was born and the first relays held in April 1955. The first few years, only local schools competed but after Calvin Giffin succeeded "Bud" as coach, Cal began selling the BELLARE RELAYS wherever he appeared with his teams.

From his efforts and the appearance of a number of powerful track teams, BELLARE RELAYS has grown in quantity and quality until it is today one of the two largest track meets in the State of Ohio.

The BELLARE RELAYS is an open competition meet (no classification) and is sanctioned by the National Federation of High School Athletic Association and the Ohio High School Athletic Association.

General Information

Place: Nelson Field - 26th St - Bellaire  
 Spikes: Are not to be worn in grandstands on field event bleachers.

Registration: Nelson Field.

Shot Put and Discus will be thrown from cement. All other field event areas are of asphalt. Soft rubber shoes should be worn but 1-8 inch spikes acceptable.

A medical tent will be located in the middle of the field and available to your team. This area will be supervised and directed by Dr. Peter Lancione along with Doctors Tom Ring, Leo Covert, John Foster and Charles Messerly.

All relays will be run against time.

The area adjacent to the finish line will be fenced off and contestants found in this area will cause his team mates to be disqualified. The finish line officials must have a good view at all times.

Relay Exchanges: The 880 Yard sprint relay will be run in lanes and the team will exchange batons in their respective lanes.

In the other relays, the (California exchange) will be used and the teams will be placed in position according to the position of the incoming runners.

Points: Five places will count and the scoring (including relays) will be as follows: 6-4-3-2-1.

Restrictions: Any boy who runs the 880 or the mile run cannot take part in more than one other track event. The relays shall be counted as track events. No boy can compete in more than four events of which only three can be track events.

Track: The track is a 440 yard track with a 220 yard straight away.

The shot and Discus will be run in flights according to best distances.

All schools entering teams in our relays must abide by the rules and regulations adopted by their state associations.

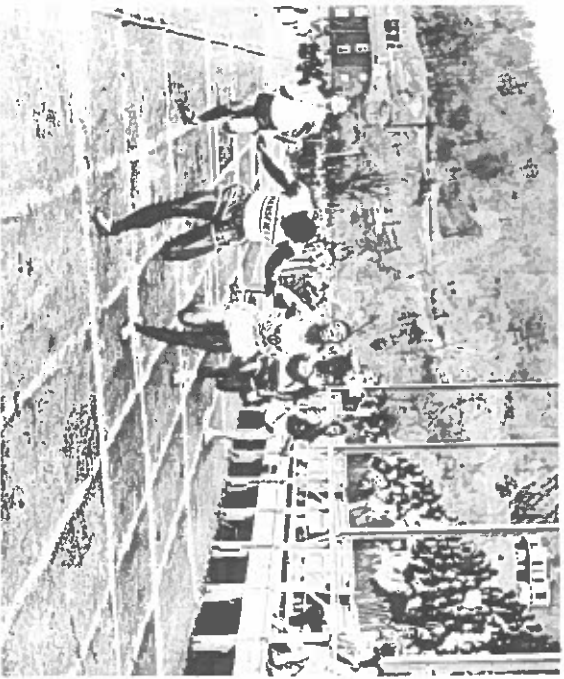
