We are proud to be honored by one of the youngest 70-year-olds in the country, George L. Rider, former outstanding track and cross country coach at Miami University, he retired in June 1962 and Miami lost one of the most astute track and field coaches in the nation.

In his 39 years at Miami, he's developed several individual national champions as well as many conference championship teams, has been accorded many personal honors and has been either coach or teacher to men who have achieved national recognition as coaches, and in other fields.

He has coached two generations of several families, and there now are grandfathers among former members of his Miami teams - although few of either generation can match his workweek.

Rider has conducted track clinics in India, Iran and Germany for the U. S. Department of State and the U. S. Army; assisted the Canadian Olympic training program; served as president of the National Collegiate Track and Cross-Country Coaches Assn. and on various committees of the NCAA and state and national physical education associations.

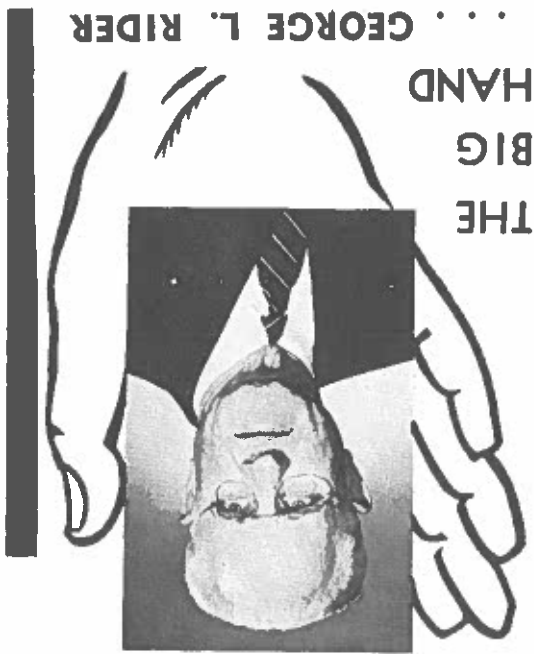
In 1957 he was elected to the Helms Foundation Track and Field Coaches Hall of Fame. He was elected honorary president of the International Track and Field Coaches Assn. in Athens in 1959.

He was the first president of the Ohio Track Coaches Assn. and vice president for five years of the NCAA Fourth District.

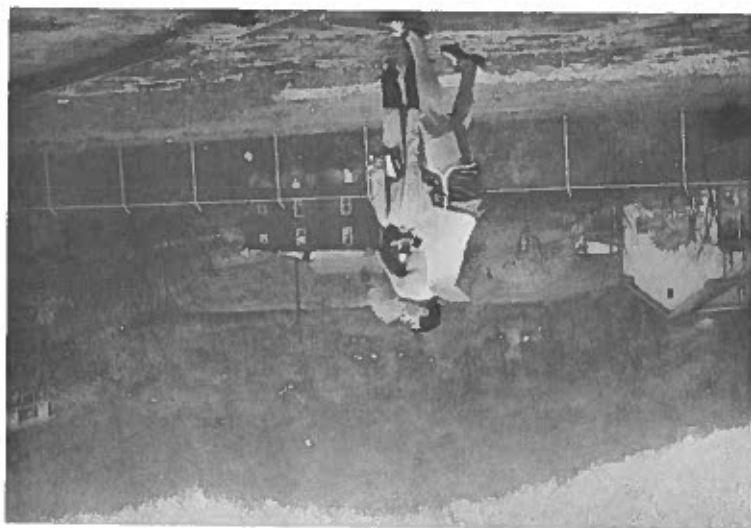

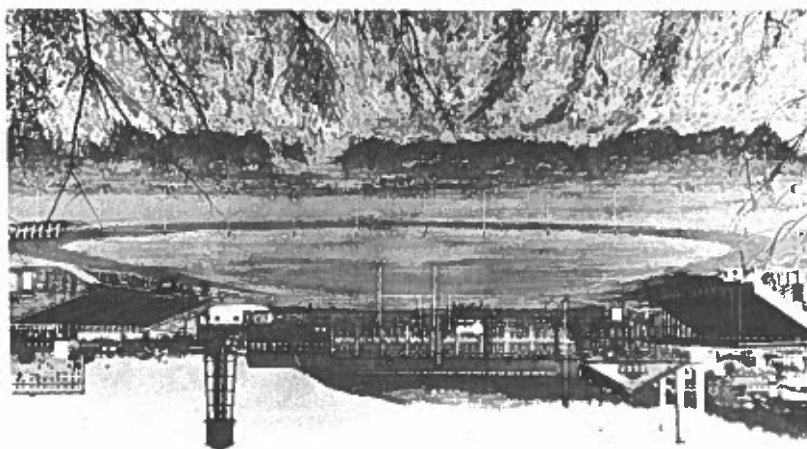

## C O N G R A T U L A T I O N S ! ! !

We wish to congratulate Cleveland Glenville who last year took home the championship trophy. Glenville was runner-up in 1965 and exceeded their previous year's performance by nosing out Cleveland East Tech. Their all around balance made them a true Bellaire Relays Champion. On behalf of the Bellaire Relays Committee - - - Congratulations again.

**Location:** Nelson Field - 26th Street, Bellare  
**Track:** The Track is a 440 yard track with a 220 yard Straight away.  
**Scoring:** Five places will count and scoring (including relays) will be as follows: 6 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1.

**Spikes:** Not to be worn in grandstands or field event bleachers.

The area adjacent to the finish line will be fenced off and contestants found in this area will cause his teammates to be disqualified. The finish line officials must have a good view at all times.

A medical tent will be located in the middle of the field and available to all teams. This area will be supervised and directed by Dr. Peter Lanchione along with a competent staff.

All relays will be run against time.

**Relay Exchanges:** The 880 yard sprint relay will be run in lanes and the team will exchange batons in their respective lanes. In all other relays, the California exchange will be used and the teams will be placed in position of the incoming runner.

**Restrictions:** Any boy who runs the 880 or the mile cannot take part in more than one other track event. The relays shall be counted as track events. No boy can compete in more than four events of which only three can be track events.

Shot put and discus will be thrown from cement. All other field event areas are of asphalt. Golf rubber shoes should be worn but 1-8 inch spikes acceptable.

The shot put and discus will be run in flights according to the best distances. All schools entering teams in our relays must abide by the rules and regulations adopted by their State Associations.
