## THE STONE BRIDGE

On the cover, the sketch of the bridge which connects Bellaire with West Virginia, is being honored for its 100 years of service to the area's railways.

All freight had to be taken across the river by Ferry prior to 1871. The completion of the Stone Bridge made expansion and higher production possible for all area industries. This three-quarter mile span cost \$1,250,000 to construct. The stone was cut locally, from a site which is now the City Park.

The Bellaire Relays salutes this great Landmark on it's 100th birthday. The Stone Bridge is one of the most significant endeavors in making Bellaire and Eastern Ohio the industrial center it is today.

From the whole city of Bellaire, and Bellaire Relays in particular, we say "Thank you for your undying and continual work in behalf of Bellaire Relays."

His credits are extensive and we have mentioned only a few. Perhaps his greatest achievement was his induction into the Ohio Track Coaches Hall of Fame and being named 1971 Barker Award Winner.

Mr. Earich's officiating career includes 40 years in football, and with the 1972 season, 50 years in track. He has officiated the State Meet 31 years, Mansfield Relays Referee 16 years, Trumbull County Meet 36 years, and has been Bellaire Relays only referee since gaining state prominence.

Mr. Earich was a great athlete at Ohio University. He earned 4 letters in football, 3 letters in basketball, 2 letters in baseball, and 1 letter in track. He earned All-Ohio honors in both football and basketball and is a member of Ohio University's Hall of Fame.

Mr. Earich was born in Millfield, Ohio. He spent 45 years as a teacher and administrator in Ohio's public schools before retiring in 1970. He is married to Mary Rowe Earich and the father of one son, Rod. The Earichs are the proud grandparents of five boys and a girl.

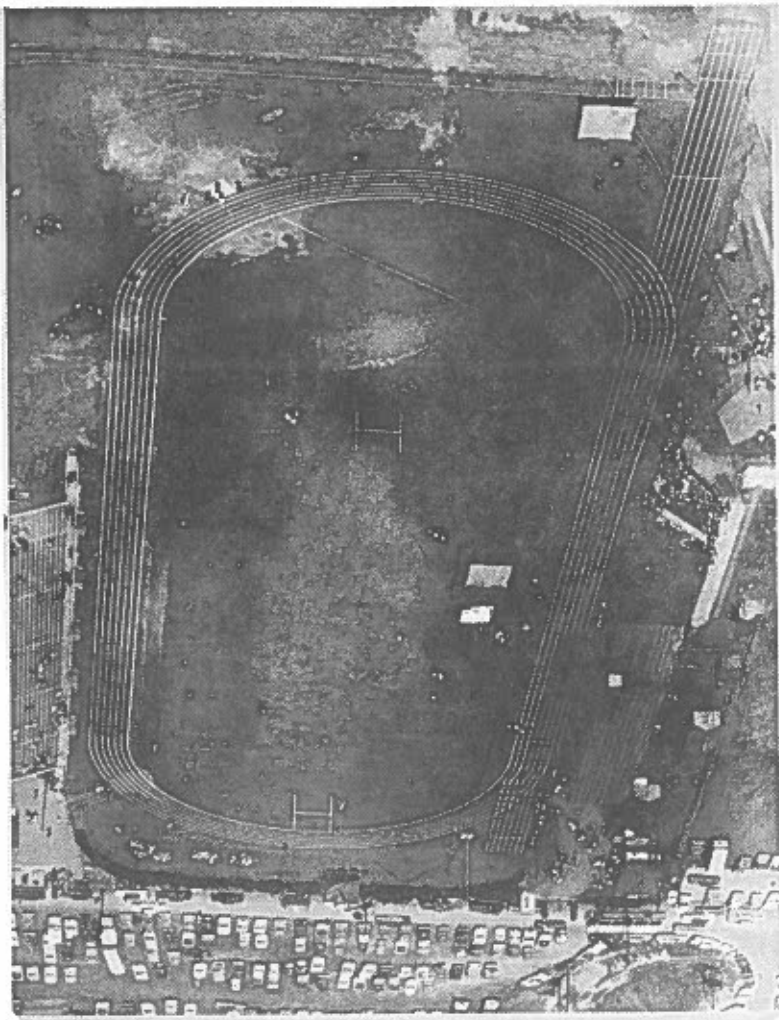

Aerial View of All Weather Track at Nelson Field

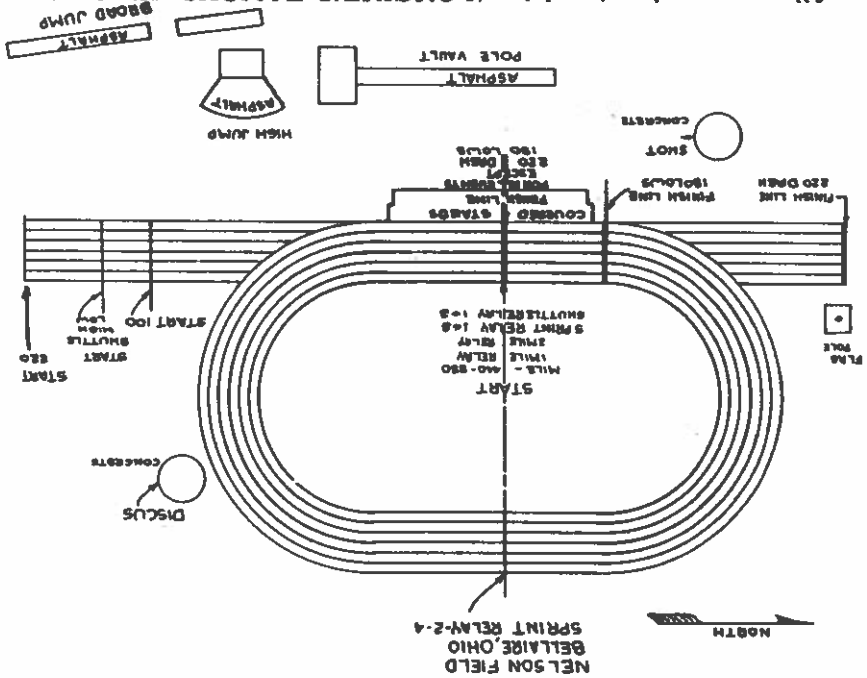

**LOCATION:** Nelson Field - 26th Street, Bellaire, Ohio

**TRACK:** All Weather 440 yards with 220 yard straight away.

**SCORING:** Six places will count 10 - 8 - 6 - 4 - 2 - 1.

**SPIKES:** One fourth of one inch maximum.

The area adjacent to the finish line will be fenced off and contestants found in this area will cause his teammates to be disqualified. The finish line officials must have a good view at all times.

A medical tent will be located at the North End of the field and available to all teams. This area will be supervised and directed by Dr. Thomas Ring along with a competent staff.

All relays will be run against time.

**Relay Exchanges:** The 880 yard sprint relay will be run in lanes and the team will exchange batons in their respective lanes. In all other relays, the California exchange will be used and the teams will be placed in position of the incoming runner.

**Restrictions:** Any boy who runs the 880 or the mile cannot take part in more than one other track event. The relays shall be counted as track events. No boy can compete in more than four events of which only three can be track events.

Shot put and discus will be thrown from cement. All other field event areas are of asphalt. Soft rubber shoes should be worn but 1/8 inch spikes acceptable.

The shot put and discus will be run in flights according to the best distances. All schools entering teams in our relays must abide by the rules and regulations adopted by their State Associations.

## HOUSING

Visiting teams coming over 125 air miles will be provided lodging in private homes. We are sorry but we must limit lodging to the first 25 teams, therefore, it is to your advantage to send in your entry blank early. Housing requests must be postmarked no later than April 17, 1971. All later applications will not be accepted. A maximum of 25 per team will be accommodated. Your team will be fed upon arrival on Friday, your boys will be entertained as our special guests that night in a variety of different ways. They will be given their breakfast on Saturday morning and then transported to the stadium.

## ENTRY FEE

There will be an entry fee of 50 cents for each boy that is entered in the meet. Checks for the total amount should be made to the Bellaire Relays Committee & enclosed with your official entry blank. Coaches & Administrators will be guests of our local Booster Club at a smoker in the Elks Club.

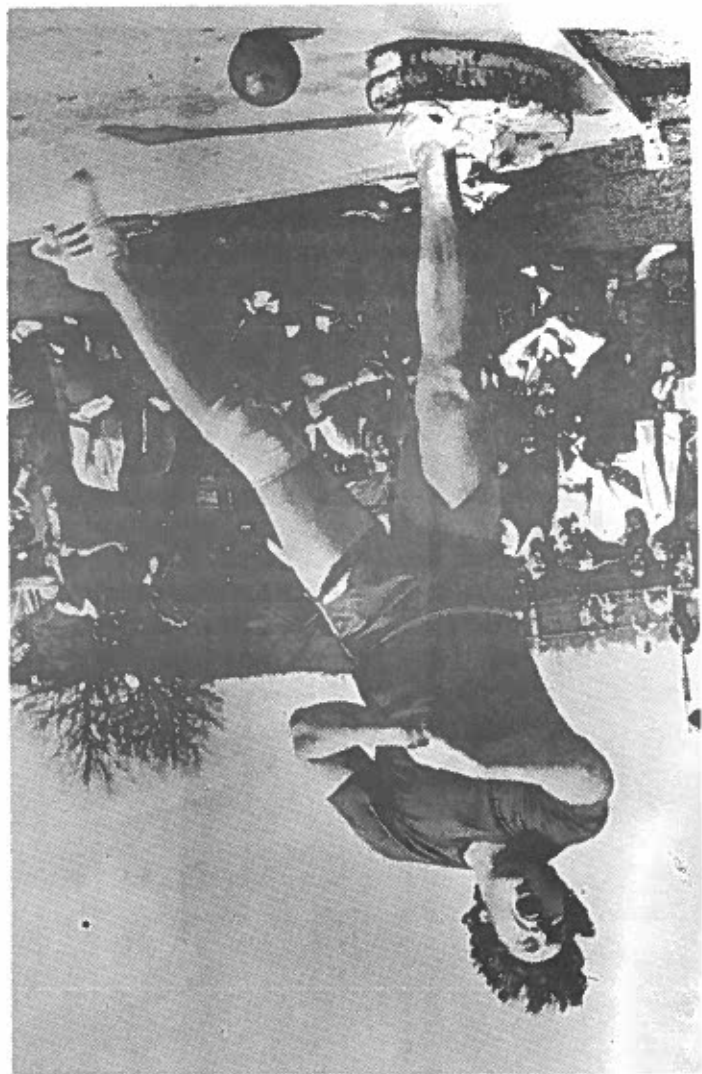
