# Happy Retirement Sam

Sam Williams was Assistant Executive Secretary of the WVSSAC from July, 1968 until September 1, 1975 at which time he assumed the Executive Secretary position at the retirement of W. Gordon Elsmar.

Sam was born on August 18, 1920 in Parkersburg, WV, and attended public schools in both Wood and Wirt County. He graduated from Wirt County High School in 1938 and enrolled in Glenville State College. His undergraduate education was interrupted by WWII with service time in the U.S. Air Force in the China-Burma-India war zones. After returning from the military Sam returned to Glenville State College and graduated in 1946. He then returned to Wirt County High School as a teacher-assistant coach from 1946-51. During this time he obtained his MA degree in administration from West Virginia University.

In September, 1951, he assumed the duties as Principal of Wirt County High School and remained in that position until 1961. He then moved to New Martins, Ohio school district as Executive Head for two years. He then returned to West Virginia as Principal of St. Marys High School in 1963 and to the WVSSAC in 1968.

Sam's interest in the activity program included 27 years as a registered football official. His experience in this area included numerous high school and championship play-off games, West Virginia Intercollegiate Conference and finally the prestigious Mid-American Intercollegiate Conference.

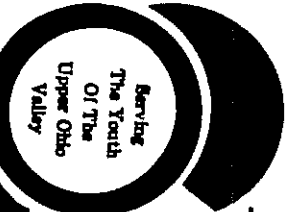

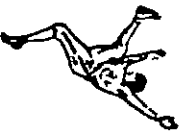

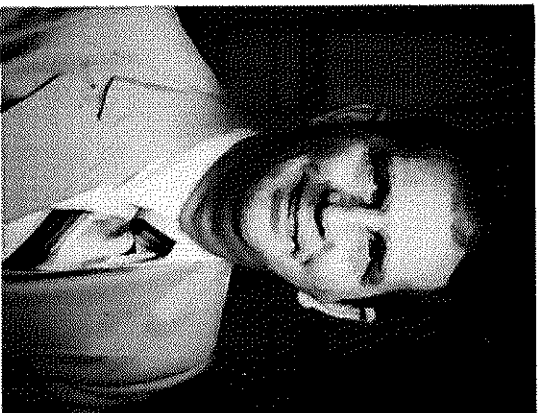

## **OVAC Honoree Assistant Coach JOE KRIVAK**

Joe Krivak also returned to the College Park campus as he spent three years on the Terrapin staff before moving to Navy.

He has played in the Cotton Bowl, and coached in the Cotton Bowl. He has also coached in the Liberty Bowl (twice), the Gator Bowl, Holiday Bowl, the Garden State Bowl and the Aloha Bowl.

He served as Head Football Coach for eight years and Head Basketball Coach for five years at Madonna High School (Weirton, West Virginia). His football teams won a State Championship, two Ohio Valley titles and had a 50-24-2 record. His basketball teams won a State title and was runner-up for State title while winning over 66 percent of their games.

He earned three letters at Syracuse as a linebacker, guard, and center for the Eastern Champions. He also lettered three times in baseball.

He returned to Syracuse in 1969 as receivers and tight end coach, moved to Maryland in '74 with the same duties and at Navy coached the quarterbacks and receivers.

While on the Maryland staff the Terps have won three ACC titles, had a 36-11-1 record and visited the Liberty, Gator, Cotton and Aloha Bowls.

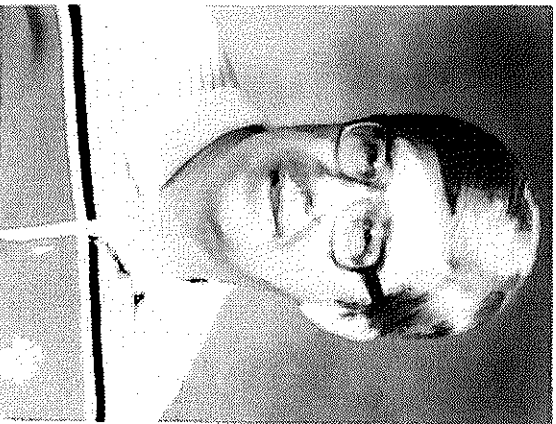
While at Navy the Midshipmen had a five-year mark of 36-21-1 and visited the Liberty, Holiday and Garden State Bowls.

He went to Syracuse from Shade Township High and was born in Central City, Pennsylvania on March 20, 1935.

His wife Jean is a native of Weirton, West Virginia and a graduate of Steubenville Central. They have three sons, Edward, John and Jeff. Edward and John were both starters on Bowie's State Championship Baseball team in 1981. Edward, the third baseman, is now a pitcher at Maryland while John is at Richmond. . . . John was also the shortstop on the 1982 championship team that ran its two year record to 44-0.

The Ohio Valley Athletic Conference was organized in 1943 with F.W. Bowen, J.E. Ewing, J.C. Greer, M.S. Hattala, B.G. Lockhart, J.V. Nelson, C. Patty, C.F. Walker and C.S. Wiseman among those responsible for its basic inception. Mr. C.S. Wiseman became the Conference's first president.

It is the basic objective of the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference to continue the promotion of all high school athletics and to serve in the overall development of proper school relationship, scholarship and sportsmanship within the Conference.
