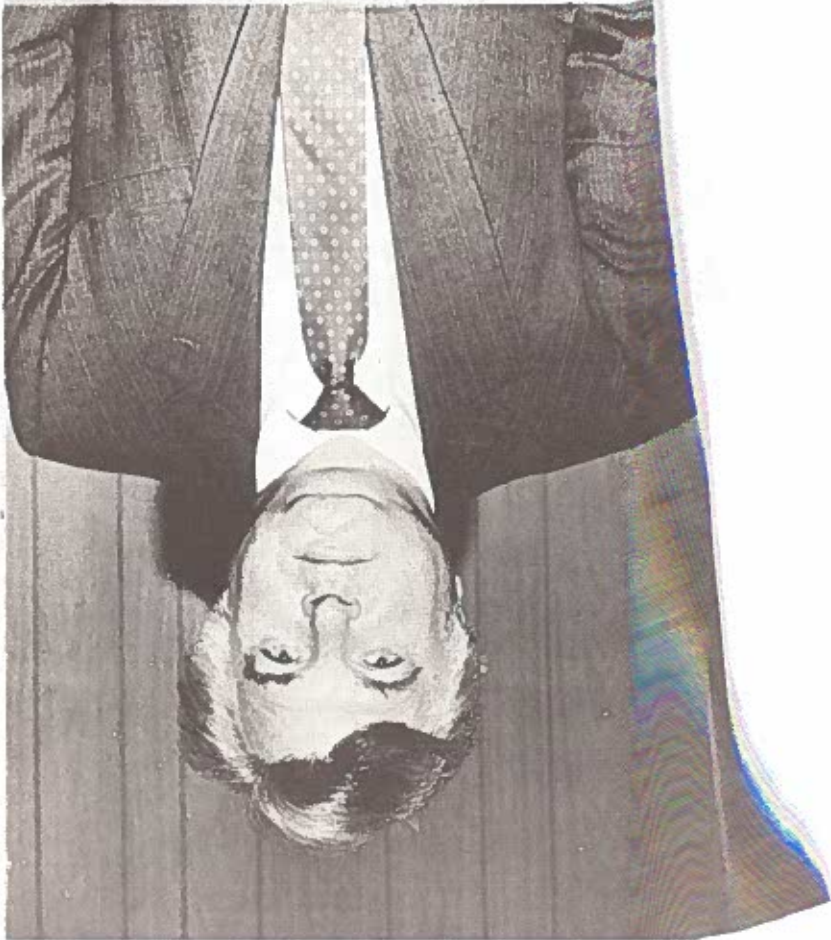

Through the untiring efforts of Calvin Giffen, the Bellaire Relays expanded very rapidly.

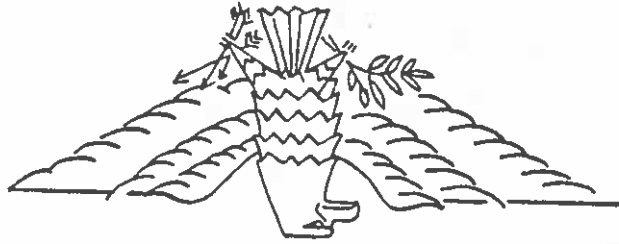
Top quality teams and athletes in Ohio were given the opportunity to participate and to compete against top athletes from other states.
