BUD KEYSER -- THE FOUNDER

Bud was head track coach at Bellaire in 1955 when he organized the first Bellaire Relays. That year, the meet was composed of eleven teams, but each year it grew larger, and, at present, there are forty teams in the Relays. It was through the efforts of Bud, who developed the Relays in those formative years, and men like him that the Bellaire Relays has grown to be the large and successful meet it is today.

Bud graduated from Bellaire High School in 1938 where he was a member of the track and tennis teams. He then entered the Marine Corps and served in World War II with duty in the Central Pacific.

After he was discharged, he went to college at Ohio Northern before transferring to Kent State where he graduated in 1949.

His first coaching job was at Bellaire High School where he was head track coach for seven years. He started the first cross country at the school. He left Bellaire in 1957 and went to Martins Ferry, serving as an assistant track coach for nine years.

The Relays committee is extremely grateful for what Bud has done. His contributions to education and athletics have been immeasureable. We are very proud to say that he is one of our town.







Note 2: No use of tobacco by coaches, participants, or managers will be allowed. Use of tobacco by officials and meet personnel is addressed in 3-1-1 note.
3-2-9	The use of wireless communication devices other than official equipment shall be approved by the games committee.
4-5-9e	A competition using or aided by a wireless communication device during competition shall be disqualified.
4-5-12; 7-2-11;	Vaulters found using a pole rated below the vaulter's weight or an illegal pole
7-4-6	shall be disqualified from the event.
5-3-7	When alleys are used around one curve, a curved starting line within each alley should be used.
