Bud Keyser - The Founder

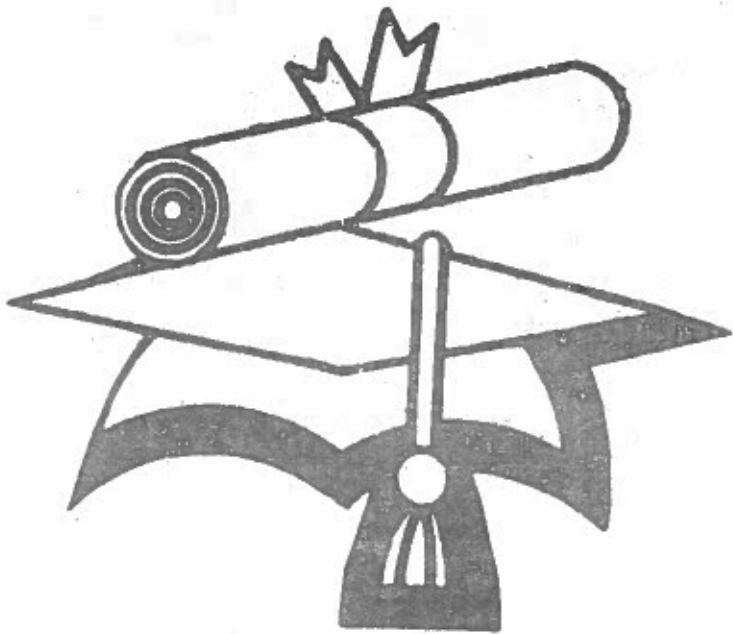
Bud was head track coach at Bellaire in 1955 when he organized the first Bellaire Relays. That year the meet was composed of eleven teams but each year it grew larger and at present there are over forty teams in the Relays. It was through efforts of Bud, who developed the Relays in those formative years and men like him, that the BELLAIRE RELAYS has grown to be the large and successful meet it is today.

Bud graduated from Bellaire High School in 1938 where he was a member of the track and tennis teams. He then entered the Marine Corps and served in World War II with duty in Central Pacific.

After he was discharged he went to college at Ohio Northern before transferring to Kent State where he graduated in 1949.

His first coaching job was at Bellaire where he was head track coach for seven years. He started the first Cross Country team at the school. He left Bellaire in 1957 and went to Martins Ferry serving as an assistant track coach for nine years.

The Relays is extremely grateful for what Bud has done. His contributions to education and athletics have been immeasurable. We are very proud to say that he is one of our town.

## MAJOR TRACK AND FIELD AND CROSS COUNTRY RULES REVISIONS FOR 1997

- 2-2-2; 7-3-17; 7-4-30 Deletes the least number of attempts throughout the competition as one of the criteria for breaking ties in high jump and pole vault.
- 2-2-3; 10-3-2 Crediting a high jumper or pole vaulter with best achievement if it occurs in jump-off for first place.
- 3-2-3c; 4-5-9 Games committee identifies coaches' restricted area and allows coaching from unrestricted area.
- 3-2-4k The games committee may approve the use of voice amplifier systems for starting running events.
- 3-7-8; 3-8-8 When a fully automatic timing system (FAT) is used, the games committee may reduce or eliminate the use of judges and timers at the finish line.
- 3-8-7 In determining qualifiers for a subsequent round, timing to the one one-thousandth (1/1000) of a second using fully automatic timing is permissible.
- 3-9-2; 6-2-5 The event judge may choose to permit a competitor to take final trials in succession.
- 4-5-1 Unsportsmanlike conduct is behavior which is unethical or dishonorable. It includes, but is not limited to, disrespectfully addressing an official, taunting or criticizing an opponent or an official, or use of profanity while a contestant. Penalty is disqualification from that event and further competition in the meet.
- 4-5-2 Unacceptable conduct includes, but is not limited to, willful failure to follow the directions of a meet official, using profanity which is not directed at someone or any action which could bring discredit to the individual or his or her school. Penalty is disqualification from that event.
- 5-7-4 Deleted the article which required the competitor's feet to be in contact with the track surface when using starting blocks.
- 7-3-6; 7-4-12 Metal crossbars are prohibited.
- 7-4-3 A training pole shall not be used in warm-ups or competition.
- 7-4-11 Requires that all exposed projections on the base of the pole vault standards or uprights must be covered or padded.
- 9-4-1 In cross country meets with four or fewer schools, each school is permitted to enter a maximum of 12 competitors unless otherwise agreed by competing schools or state association adoption.
- 10-4-1 Note Beginning in 1998, no national record shall be granted unless the time is recorded by fully automatic timing (FAT).

- 3-2-4d Allows the games committee to restrict items in excess of the traditional school uniform, other than jewelry, such as costumes, hats, caps, kerchiefs, etc.

- 4-3-1; 9-5-1 Specified the full-length jersey shall not be knotted.
- 5-9-8 Relieved relay runner should stay in the lane and step off the track when clear.
