

OVAC Wrestlers in 28th Dapper Dan Classic

Valley stars to challenge WPIAL elite in preliminary on March 30

PITTSBURGH — The 28th annual Dapper Dan Wrestling Classic has been scheduled for March 30 at the University of Pittsburgh.

In the preliminary event, which starts at 5:30 p.m., wrestlers from the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference will take on wrestlers from the WPIAL.

The main event, slated for a 7:30 p.m. start, features the Pennsylvania All-Stars against the United States All-Stars.

The OVAC All-Stars will be guided by the coaches of the four championship teams from the OVAC tournament.

Rich Wright (Beaver Local-Class AAAA), Larry Shaw (Oak Glen-Class AAA), John Haswell (Shadyside-Class AA) and Jim Potts (Cameron-Class A) will be coaching 12 of the OVAC's finest from this past season.

Numbered among the dozen area grapplers are seven reigning OVAC tournament champions.

The 12 OVAC grapplers boast a combined 1,290-252 career record and were a combined 458-62 this winter.

The WPIAL squad will be coached by Trinity's Jeff Bricker, whose squad was the 2002 WPIAL Class AAA team champions, and Jason Carpetta of Fort Cherry's WPIAL Class AA champs.

There are eight reigning WPIAL individual champions on the western Pennsylvania team. The 12-man squad shows a combined 1339-275 career record and was 419-50 this past season.

In the feature match, the Pennsylvania All-Stars will be led by a pair of Penn State recruits from State College High School.

At 152 pounds, Nathan Galoway was a three-time Pennsylvania state champion and compiled a 136-10 varsity record.

State College 145-pounder Matt Stornolio is the reigning



PIAA champion and concluded his high school career with a 159-7 record.

Three of the wrestlers on the United States All-Stars never tasted defeat on a high school mat.

At 112 pounds, Sam Hazewinkel of Pensacola (Fla.) Christian was 140-0 while winning three straight Florida High School Association titles.

At 135 pounds, Teyon Ware of Edmond (Okla.) North was 132-0 and won four straight Oklahoma state championships. He and Hazewinkel have already signed to wrestle collegiately at the University of Oklahoma.

At 140 pounds, Andy Simmons of Williamston, Mich. was a four-time Michigan state champ with an eye-popping 219-0 high school record.

Festivities for the Dapper Dan Wrestling Classic get under way March 29 with the traditional Pre-Classic Banquet at the Radisson Hotel in Greentree. Olympic gold medal winner Brandon Slay will be the featured speaker at the event, which

starts at 7 p.m.

OVAC Grapplers Fall

PITTSBURGH - The 28th Dapper Dan Wrestling Classic ended on a sour note for the OVAC All-Star team at the University of Pittsburgh's Fitzgerald Field House Saturday.

The WPIAL All-Stars rolled to a 36-6 decision over the OVAC in a preliminary to the featured match between the Pennsylvania champions and a United States All-Star team.

The U.S. team won 26-21.

The OVAC stars captured just two of their 12 matches against a powerful WPIAL contingent that included the current champion or runnerup from each of the WPIAL weight classes.

Still, a number of local grapplers had a good showing.

John Marshall 189-pounder Chris Taylor was named the OVAC's Most Outstanding Wrestler after muscling out a 5-3 decision over Brian Hall of Yough.

Derrick Stickles, Oak Glen's 171-pound OVAC and state champion, came away with the closest decision of the night.

Stickles and 171-pound WPIAL champ Nick Kozar of Derry battled to a scoreless tie through three periods and overtime, forcing a tiebreaker. Stickles earned the nod by riding out Kozar in the tiebreaker.

Two matches featured a pair of two-time defending conference champs.

At 152, John Marshall's Derek George dropped a 4-2 decision to Freedom's Matt Hill, while Shenandoah 275-pounder Jesse Wells lost 10-3 to Bentworth's C.J. Wonsetter.

Burgettstown's Lou Vigliotti was the WPIAL's Most Outstanding Wrestler after running up a 20-5 technical fall against OVAC champ Billy Barath of St. Clairsville at 135.

There were no pins in the event but McGuffey's Jeff Breese also recorded a technical fall, stopping John Marshall's Mike Fasouletas by a 16-0 count.

Dapper Dan has been a man about town in Pittsburgh for nearly three-quarters of a century. Founded in 1936 by Pittsburgh Post-Gazette sports editor Al Abrams, the organization has evolved from a businessmen's sports club into one of the region's most recognizable pillars of charity. And the annual Dapper Dan Sportsman of the Year Dinner has become the preeminent social event on Western Pennsylvania's sports calendar.

The first banquet was in November 1936, six months after Abrams christened the new venture. He and his friends sold 437 tickets at \$5 apiece for that first dinner and they pulled in \$800, which was donated to the DePaul Institute in Brookline. Such outstanding Pittsburgh sports celebrities as Art Rooney, Jock Sutherland and John Harris spoke at the first banquet. A two-fisted tradition of sports entertainment and charity giving was born.

The name? It came from an off-hand remark by George "Red" Lai, a restaurant owner in Pittsburgh and one of Abrams' friends. Abrams and his group wanted to attract membership from the sportsmen and businessmen of Pittsburgh, men who were always dapperly dressed. "We could call them Dapper Dans," Lai said.

In the decades that followed, Dapper Dan's impact on the sports community was remarkable. The group staged the annual Dapper Dan Open professional golf tournament and brought championship prizefights to Pittsburgh, including the Ezzard Charles-Jersey Joe Walcott heavyweight title fight at Forbes Field in 1951 and the only Pittsburgh appearance of an up-and-coming heavyweight named Cassius Clay in 1961. That was the same year Dapper Dan co-sponsored the PGA Championship at Oakmont. Western Pennsylvania sports fans saw the stars of tomorrow at the annual Roundball Classic high school basketball all-star game and the Dapper

Dan Wrestling Classic tournament. Dapper Dan also started and served as caretaker for the Pittsburgh Hall of Fame. All the while, the Sportsman of the Year award grew to be one of the nation's most prestigious honors, recognizing the local sports figure who shined the brightest light on Pittsburgh in the preceding year.

The 1990s saw Dapper Dan undergo dramatic and significant change. The club was re-christened as Dapper Dan

Charities and the Boys' & Girls' Clubs of Western Pennsylvania was designated the primary beneficiary of the fundraising events. The Boys' & Girls' Clubs now operate the Dapper Dan youth sports leagues in flag football, golf, basketball and floor hockey with funding from Dapper Dan.

The challenge of funding these youth programs pushed Dapper Dan to

expand its calendar of events. The Ray Mansfield Memorial Spectacular became part of Pittsburgh's football landscape and even a fashion show found its way onto Dapper Dan's schedule - far afield from the sports arena in which Abrams founded the group, but so appropriate for a group named because of its sartorial splendor. Dapper Dan Charities also added a new level of membership, the Inner Circle, and began calling more and more on Pittsburgh's corporate community for sponsorships of the benefit events.

And, responding to the realities of the times, Dapper Dan decided to present both a Sportsman and a Sportswoman of the Year award at the annual dinner.

The mission has expanded far beyond what Abrams might have envisioned and the once-a-year sports dinner has spawned a year-long effort to raise money for the community's charity needs, but the philosophy has remained unchanged since inception in 1936: Give the ticket-buying public the biggest names in sports and the best in entertainment. "The rest," Abrams said, "comes easy."

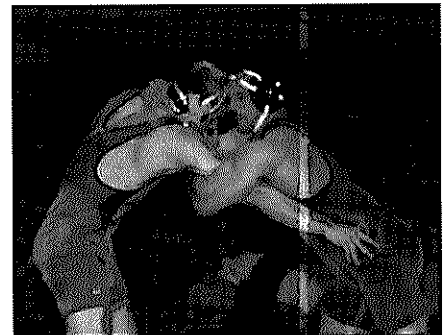

A lineup that features four, four-time state champions and the winningest schoolboy wrestler of all time would seem to be one that is as close to unbeatable as possible.

That is exactly the kind of lineup Pennsylvania's All-Stars face tonight in a most talented and accomplished United States all-star team in the 28th annual Dapper Dan Wrestling Classic at the University of Pittsburgh's Fitzgerald Field House.

The U.S. team will rely heavily on 125-pound Darrell Vasquez, 130-pound Burke Barnes, 135-pound Teyon Ware, and 140-pound Andy Simmons, all four-time state titlists.

In addition, the U.S. team features Matt Herrington, a winner of a national record 243 bouts scholastically, and a two-time New York state champion.

Between them, the 12 all-stars who form the 2002 U.S. team own 2,038 victories and just 86 defeats. Collectively, the U.S. stars have won 37 state titles.

An unenviable task awaits the

Pennsylvania contingent to be sure. But the Keystone State's squad is not without its blue chip talent.

Leading the way is three-time PIAA champion Nathan Galloway of State College High School at 152 pounds. Two-time state champion

Jeremy Walsh of Oley Valley will compete at 130 pounds.

Perhaps the bout of the night will come at 140 pounds where Simmons, who went 219-0 for Williamston High (Mich.), will battle Whitehall's Christian Franco, who went 147-12 in his schoolboy career and earned his first PIAA title a few weeks ago.

Simmons' bouts rarely go the distance and he is a top recruit of Michigan State. Franco will attend the

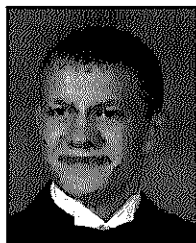
University of Pennsylvania and should provide a stern test for the much-heralded Simmons, who follows in the footsteps of his brother Nick - who competed here last year.

Vasquez of Bakersfield, Calif., will battle Redland's Brian Baglio, who went 127-18 in his career and was most impressive in earning his first state crown this season. Baglio ripped through a difficult 125-pound bracket in style.

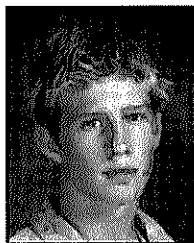
Barnes, who won an individual title in the 2000 Powerade Christmas Tournament, will meet Walsh at 130. Barnes was 128-4 in his career at Lake Stevens in Washington and will attend Boise State. Walsh, a Lock Haven recruit, won 141 of 162 bouts in his schoolboy career.

Ware, an Oklahoma recruit, went undefeated in 132 bouts in high school. He will face Claysburg-Kimmel's Jarrett Musselman, a winner of 141 of 150 bouts and one PIAA crown in his schoolboy career.

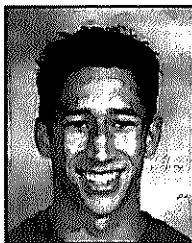

Galloway, 136-10 in his career, faces three-time New Jersey champion Zach Esposito of Blair Academy at 152. Galloway is a Penn State recruit.

Esposito went 171-17 in his career at Blair Academy and will attend Oklahoma State. That bout promises to deliver fireworks.

The U.S. team won't have to wait long to create some noise. It will look for a strong start with 112-pound Samuel Hazewinkel of Pensacola Christian in Florida and 119-pound Christian Staylor of Great Bridge, Va. Both are three-time state champions. Hazewinkel went undefeated in 140 schoolboy bouts while Staylor posted a 163-13 record. Hazewinkel will attend Oklahoma. Staylor is an Arizona State recruit.

Pennsylvania will counter with a pair of wrestlers from Wilson High. 112-pound Jeremy Hartrum went 148-24 in high school while 119-pound Corey Garis was 131-33. Both own a PIAA title.

Two-time Iowa champion Trent

Paulson of Lewis Central will meet State College's Matt Storniolo at 145 pounds. Paulson won 192 of 194 scholastic bouts while Storniolo captured 159 of 166 bouts. Paulson will attend Iowa State while Storniolo will join State College teammate Galloway at Penn State.

At 160 pounds, Johnny Hendricks of Edmond Memorial, Okla., faces Allentown Central Catholic's Dave Rivera. Hendricks, who will attend Oklahoma State, went 142-4 in his scholastic career and won three state titles. Rivera compiled a 106-31 mark and captured a PIAA crown.

Herrington, of LaSalle Institute, will attend Penn. He will battle Garden Spot's Steve Borja, who went 113-22 and won a PIAA title, at 171 pounds.

Blair Academy's Kurt Backes will meet Plum's Matt Cassidy at 189 pounds. Backes, a three-time New Jersey champion, will attend Iowa State. He won 161 of 179 bouts in his schoolboy career. Cassidy, who put on an impressive performance throughout this

past post-season, went 109-25 in his career and won his first PIAA championship a few weeks ago.

At 275 pounds, Mike Behnke, a two-time Illinois champion, will tangle with Tom Parks of North Allegheny. Behnke posted a 158-12 record in high school while Parks, also a top football player, went 114-26 for the Tigers. He won his first state crown this season and will attend Delaware.

The Pennsylvania team owns a combined mark of 1,572-238. It will be coached by Trinity's Jeff Bricker, who will be assisted by Jeff Carpetta of Fort Cherry.

Olympic champion Brandon Slay will serve as honorary coach of the United States squad.

Led by two-time PIAA champion Jeff Breese and Bentworth High School's first state titlist, C.J. Wonsettler, a strong collection of WPIAL all-stars are ready to meet the challenge that will be presented to them this evening by a talented band of stars from West Virginia and Ohio who participate in the Ohio Valley Athletic Conference.

The squads will meet in the preliminary dual meet of the Dapper Dan Wrestling Classic at the University of Pittsburgh's Fitzgerald Field House.

Breese, who won PIAA crowns as a freshman in 1999 and junior in 2001, won 103 bouts in three seasons at McGuffey High School. He won a WPIAL title in 1999 and placed second the past two seasons. He qualified for the PIAA Championships in 2002 but failed to earn a medal, getting upended in the PIAA Class AAA quarterfinals and again in consolations.

Breese, a North Carolina State recruit, overcame a knee injury and subsequent

operation in his sophomore season to win a second state championship in 2001.

He will meet John Marshall's Mike Fasouletos, who went 33-11 this past season.

As for Wonsettler, he won a WPIAL championship and claimed the Bearcats'

first individual state crown in thrilling fashion at 275 pounds. Wonsettler, who went 123-28 in his career, won two WPIAL titles. He will meet Jesse Wells of Shenandoah, Ohio, who went 98-28 in his career. Wonsettler will attend Penn State.

In addition to Breese and Wonsettler, the WPIAL teams boasts other top competitors.

Latrobe's Mike Ciotti, a 2002 WPIAL

champion and PIAA runnerup, went 94-22 in his career and will meet John Marshall's Allen Taylor, who went 27-13 this past season, at 112 pounds.

At 125 pounds, Greensburg Salem's Brian Sticca will face John Tierney of Martins Ferry, Ohio. Sticca, a WPIAL champion and PIAA runnerup, captured the hearts of wrestling fans by nearly defeating Easton's Matt Ciasulli in the state finals. Ciasulli was a two-time defending champion. Sticca finished his Lions' career with a 98-34 record. Tierney won 147 of 167 schoolboy bouts.

Chad Seybold of Waynesburg Central, a two-time WPIAL champion, and PIAA runnerup this past season, will meet David Tierney of Martins ferry at 130 pounds.

Seybold was 121-25 in his Raiders' career and 38-5 in 2001-2002. David Tierney posted a 149-19-1 career record and was 40-4 this past season.

and earned the bronze medal in the PIAA Championships. Vigliotti finished his career with 122 wins in 144 bouts. He was 39-2 for the Blue Devils this past season. Vigliotti will meet Billy Barath of St. Clairsville, Ohio at 135 pounds.

Barath was 125-36 in his career and went 35-3 this past season.

Greensburg Central Catholic's Deacon Smolleck, who went 39-3 this past season, will battle Beaver Local's (Ohio) Jon Varner at 140 pounds. Smolleck, a WPIAL champion, won 120 of 144 bouts in his career. Varner was 33-10 this past season and went 94-36 in his career.

At 145 pounds, Matt Schiff of Fort Cherry will meet Tucker Brown of Cameron High (W.Va.). Schiff was a WPIAL runnerup in 2002 and placed third in the state. He compiled a 37-4 mark this past season and won 107 of 130 bouts in his Rangers' career.

Brown was 42-6 this past season and posted 146 career wins in 166 bouts.

Freedom's Matt Hill won 43 of 45 bouts this past season. He is a two-time WPIAL champion and two-time WPIAL runnerup. He compiled a 136-26 career record for the Bulldogs.

Hill will square off against Derek George of John Marshall at 152 pounds. George is a two-time OVAC champion and won 41 of 43 bouts for the Monarchs this past season. He compiled a 114-19-1 record in his career.

Norwin's Dave Gardner, a two-time WPIAL runnerup, will battle Cameron's Roger Kupfer at 160 pounds.

Gardner was 33-5 this past season and went 108-21 in his career, which began at Mt. Pleasant before his transfer to Norwin. Kupfer was 42-2 this past season and went 154-10 in his four-year career.

WPIAL champion Nick Kozar of Derry Area, 32-4 this past season, will face Derrick Stickles of Oak Glen (W.Va.) at 171 pounds. Kozar won a WPIAL crown this past season and went 92-17 in his career. Stickles went

39-1 in winning an OVAC championship and finished his career with a 108-9 record.

At 189, three-time WPIAL runnerup Brian Hall of Yough will battle Chris Taylor of John Marshall. Hall went 30-8 this past season and 115-24 in his career. Taylor was 44-1 this past season in winning an OVAC crown and went 98-28 in his career.

The WPIAL squad will be coached by Trinity's Jeff Bricker, who will be assisted by Jason Carpetta of Fort Cherry.

The OVAC team will be coached by Rich Wright of Beaver Local, Larry Shaw of Oak Glen, John Haswell of Shadyside (Ohio) and Jim Potts of Cameron.
