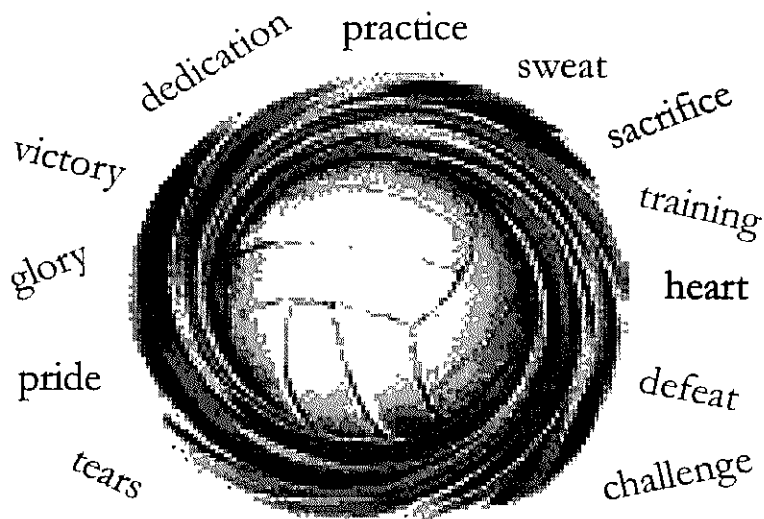

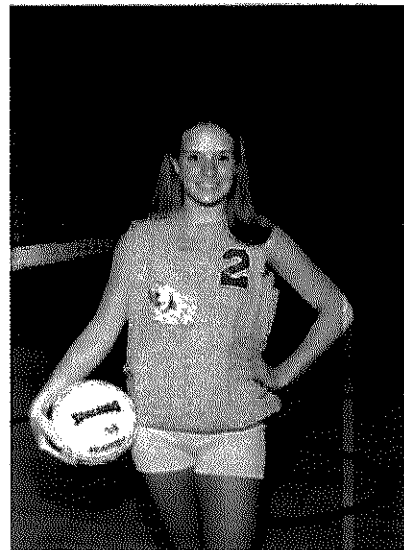

Kristin plans to attend college but undecided on where.



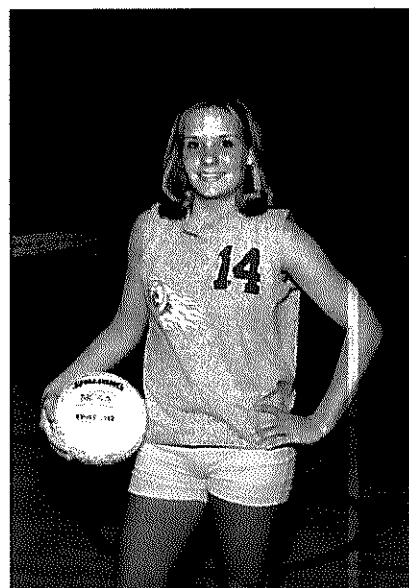
