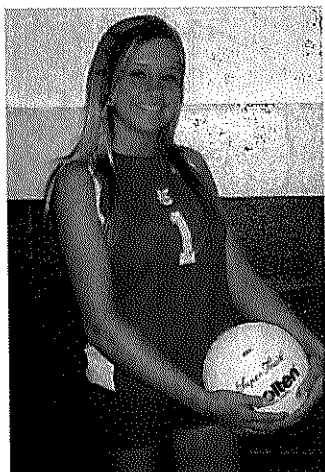

Lizzy plans to attend a four year school and is undecided on her major.



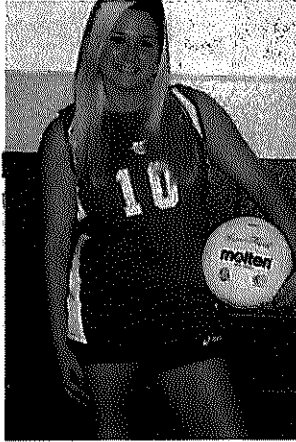

Emily plans on attending college in the fall and majoring in computer science.

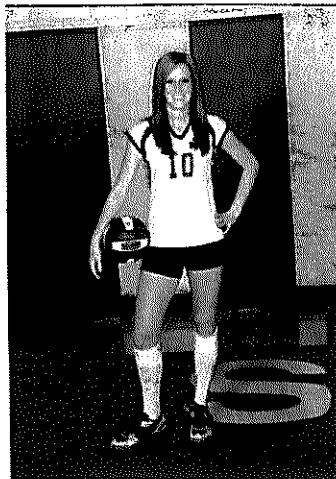

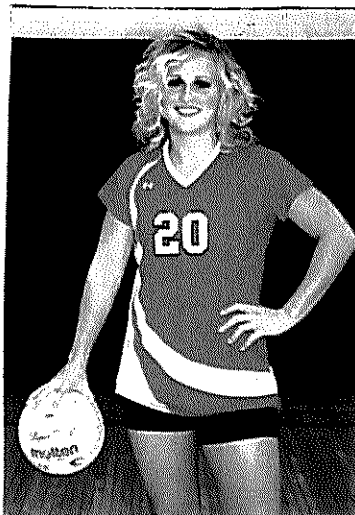

Samantha plans on attending college to earn a degree in nursing.



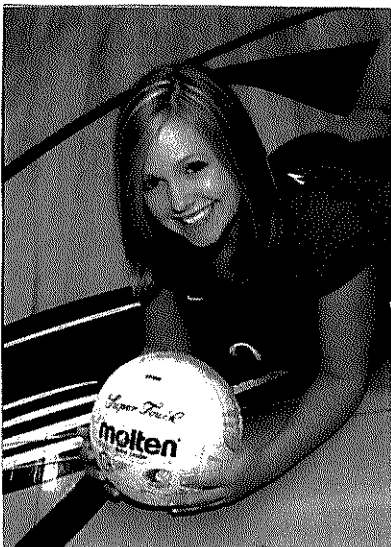

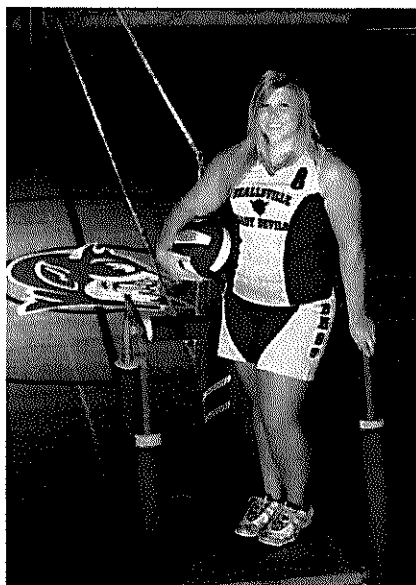

Kerri plans on attending college to earn a Bachelor's degree in Biomedical Science and then continue on to medical school and specialize in Anesthesiology or psychiatry.



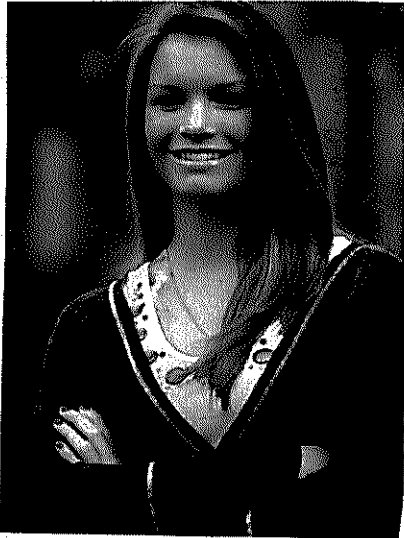

She plans on attending college for radiology.

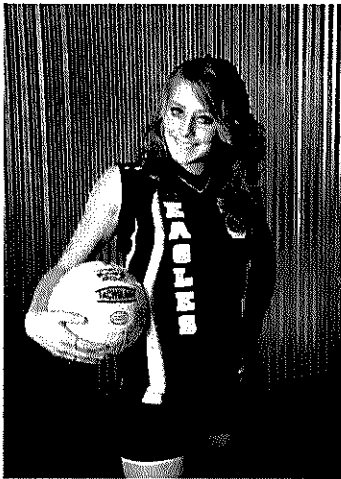
