Mackenzie brings a high level of intensity and energy to the game and she is looking forward to meeting and playing with her OVAC All-Star teammates.

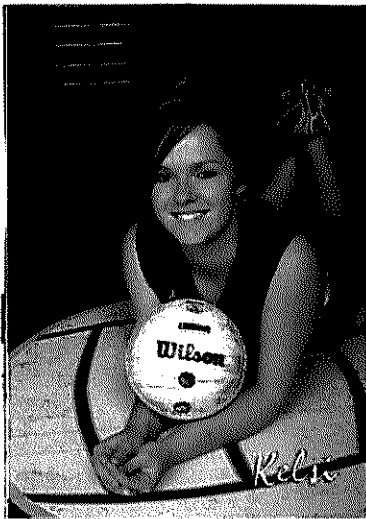
