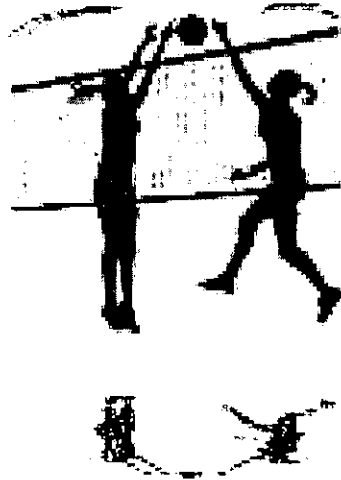

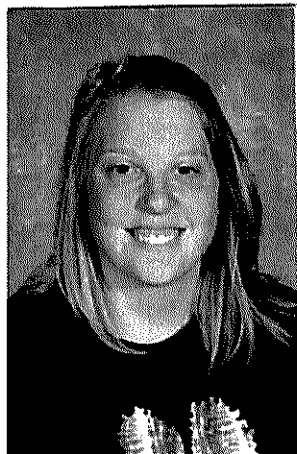

Her future plans are to attend college for graphic arts and participate in volleyball and track.



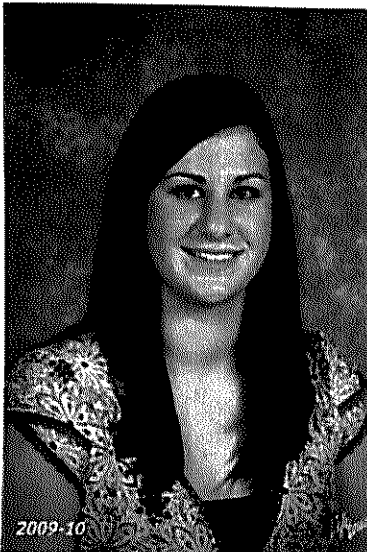

Emily plans on attending Ohio University and majoring in psychology.

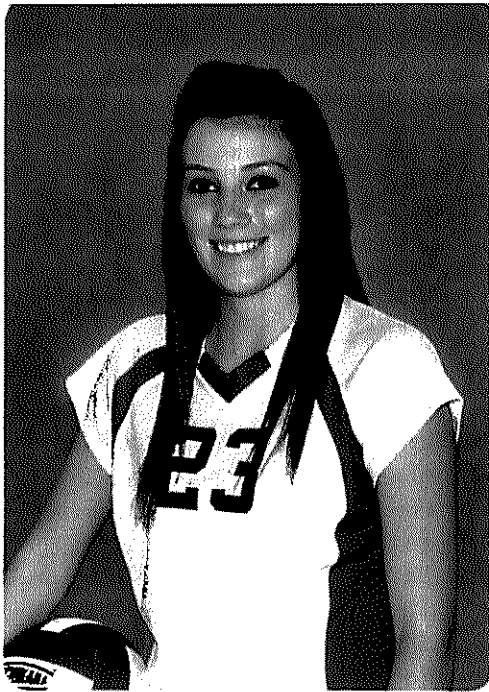

## Bailey Rittberger Bishop Rosecrans High School

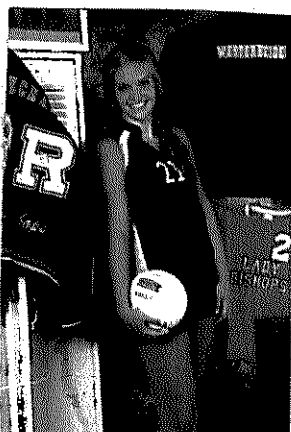

She plans on attending Kent State University and major in physical therapy.



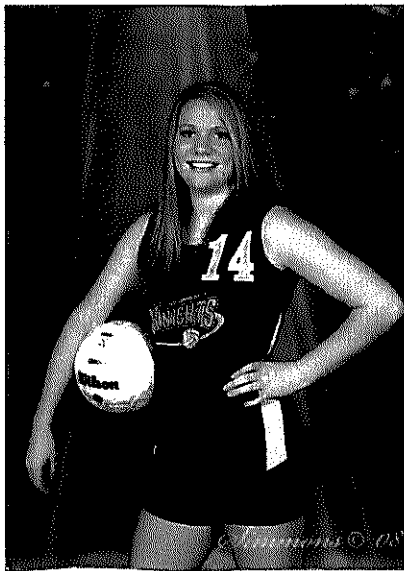

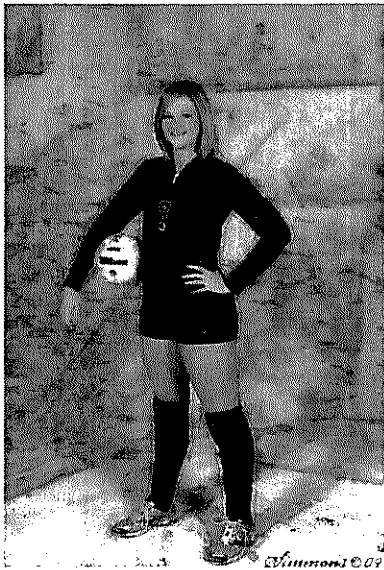

She plans to attend Fairmont State College to become a dental hygienist.



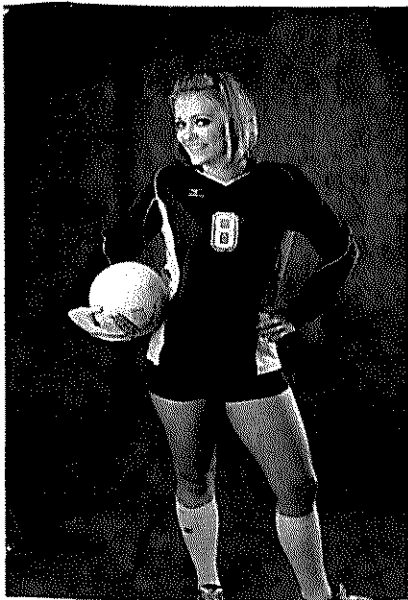
