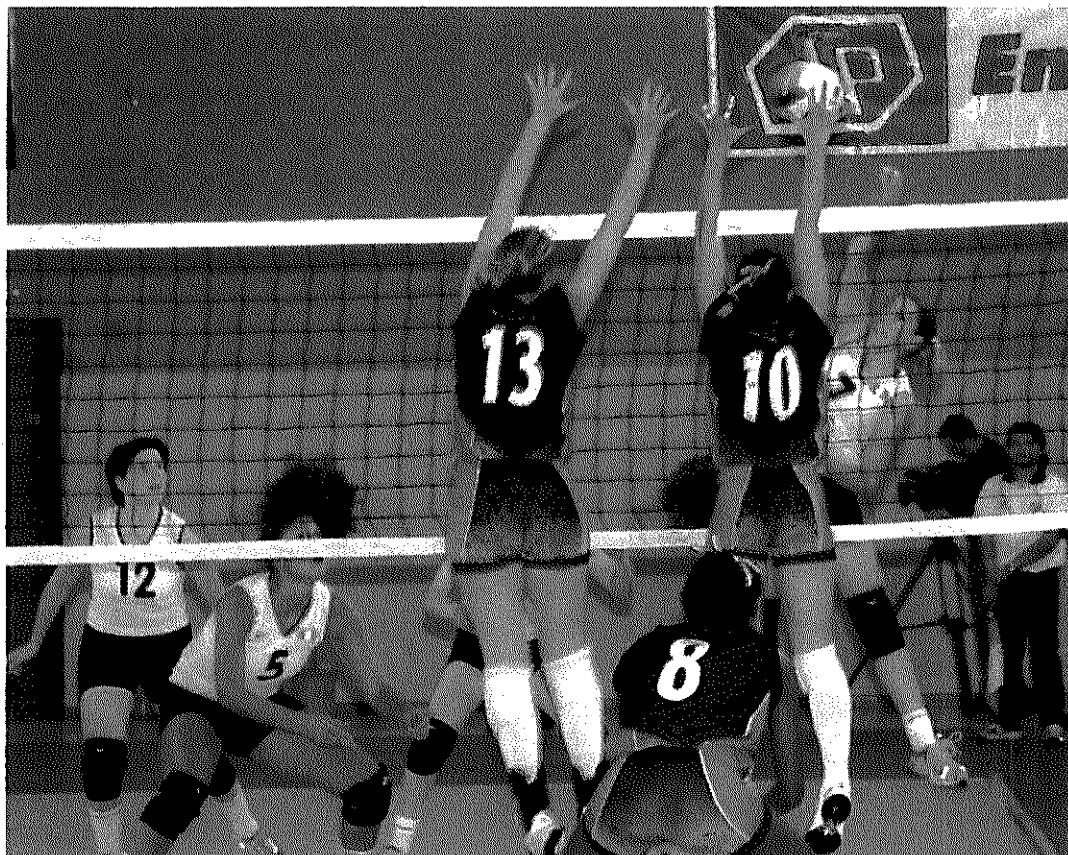

JIM TURNER

Jim Turner is in his third year as the head coach of the Lady Pilots Volleyball Team. During this year the Pilots had their first winning season in over 20 years, finishing with a record of 16-9. Along the way the Pilots captured the schools' first ever OVAC title winning the Class 2A title, and also finishing as Ohio District 12 Sectional Co-Champions. In addition to being named the 2A Coach of the Year, due to the Lady Pilots accomplishments, Jim was also honored to be named the Times Leader Coach of the Year.

Jim is employed by Nationwide Insurance, is an active member of the Duffy Church of Christ, and resides on a farm outside of Clarington, with his wife Julia and daughter Annie. Annie, who is a freshman at Ohio University, also played in the OVAC All-star game last year for the Ohio squad.

SHANNON LEASURE

Shannon Leasure has been the head coach of the Shenandoah Varsity Volleyball Program the past three seasons. During this time, the Zeps have amassed a record of 64-12, and the Pioneer Valley Conference Champions 2011, 2012 and 2013. They have also been the regular season OVAC 3A Champions in 2012 and 2013, and earned the Class 3A Tournament champion honors this past 2013 season.

Apart from coaching volleyball, Shannon teaches 7th & 8th grade Algebra and Pre-Algebra for Shenandoah Middle School and serves as the boys' varsity track and field coach.

CRYSTAL HAMMOCK

Crystal has completed her ninth season as a head coach for the Lady Redskins. This season the Redskins posted a 19-3 record while also finishing first in the Buckeye 8, first in the East Ohio Country Classic, OVAC 5A Regular Season Champs and OVAC 5A Tournament Champs.

Under her leadership, the Lady Redskins have compiled a record of 157-50. They have 4 East Ohio Country Classic Championships, 6 OVAC Regular Season Titles, 1 OVAC Tournament Title, 6 Buckeye 8 Titles, 2 Sectional Titles and 2 District Runner-up Titles.

Crystal currently teaches K-4 Physical Education at Wintersville Elementary in the Indian Creek School District. Outside of volleyball, she enjoys spending time with her husband Joe and her 10 month old daughter, Bryn.

Coach Summers has been named the WV State Coach of the year and twice named OVAC Coach of the year.

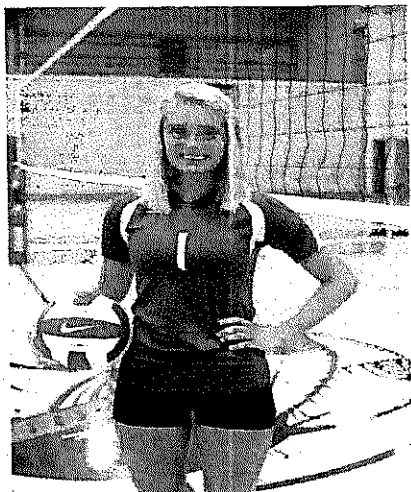

Future Plans: To attend West Liberty University and major in Pre-Med Biology and become a chiropractor.

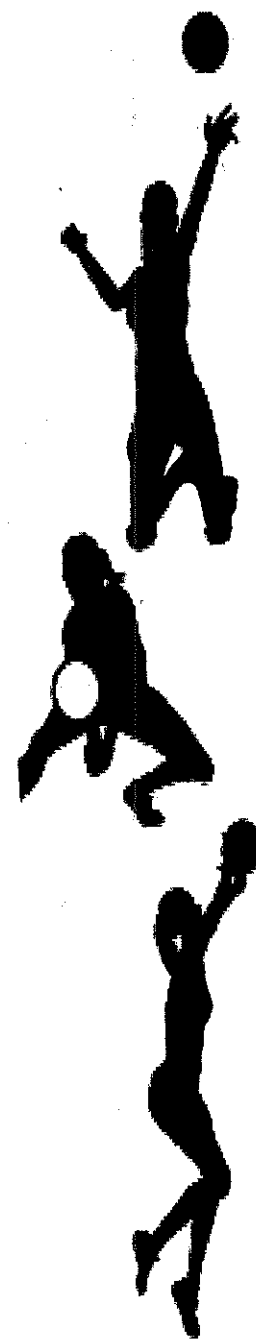
