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FOREWARD

Until Gregg Bonar. These can be found on my website, **theratsnest.org**, in their entirety. And while they were "there," I never really knew what to do with them.

Until Jeff Harrison. You will also find on my website ***The History of Martins Ferry Purple Riders Athletics***. And it became an inspiration. Jeff has spent his life chronicling athletics through his newspaper reporting and research. I would urge you to look through it. It is a masterpiece. And while I don't like copying other's works, when I saw this, it became obvious that something like this had to be done for Bellaire.

And while I'm here, let me add that something like this **SHOULD** be done at **EVERY** high school for **EVERY** sport. While many schools have amazing records for football or basketball or some other sport, few, if any, have them for every sport in their school from the initial year to the current season. All it takes is a commitment and willingness to do some research. If there's anything that comes out of Jeff's work, it would be that other schools would pick up the banner and develop a similar report. "You mean you put Martins Ferry athletics on your Bellaire site?" Darn right. And I'll be happy to post any other school's similar research if you send it to me.

So here it starts. Bellaire High School's athletic history. Let me emphasize that this isn't even close to Jeff's work. I don't scroll through microfilm, surf the web, or dig through old papers. So be ready to find errors. You will. And realize that this is a definite work in progress that will be constantly updated as long as I'm able to do it. After that, hopefully, someone will pick up the torch and carry it on.

FUN FACTS?

Over the years, I've heard a lot of theories and rumors as to various things associated with Bellaire High School: the nickname, the colors, the fight song, etc. As a former yearbook advisor for years, I have to defer to the **BELJUAN** for the answers. And for a couple reasons. The advisors back in 1910 were strict grammarians and historians. One only needs to read those books to understand that. So I can't believe that those early task masters would publish something that wasn't accurate or true. While you may not agree with the following, I can accept that. And if you can show me your answer IN PRINT from a reliable source, I'll be happy to concede and change. Until that time, here's what I've found.

The first **BELJUAN** was published in 1910. It was printed by the junior class and given to the graduating seniors of 1909. So it was the **BEL-laire JUNior ANnual**. It was their hope that future classes would continue with that name, and, over 115 years later, it's still called that.

The first cover was **RED**, making one think that the colors came from that, but it wasn't until 1930 that red or black was used again. From 1930 until 1939, the covers were red or black, then they switched to other colors again. For a long period of time in the 1950's and 1960's, the covers alternated between red, black, and white.

It was stated in the 1910 book that athletes received the letter **B** for their athletic accomplishments, so that tradition had to predate 1909.

The first reference to **RED & BLACK** was used in the 1912 book referencing the 1911 basketball team. It was again used in the 1913 yearbook, but appeared sparingly. Even though the phrase Big Red appeared in 1920, Red and Black was used predominately until the middle 1930's when it started to disappear from use. [RUMOR has it that the phrase began when the Weinies, a sandlot football team, used to play at the ballfield across from the city park. The players would swap socks, wearing one red one and one black one. Someone referred to them as the "boys in red and black." Again, rumor]

However, an article that appeared in the December 18, 1930, **Bellaire Daily Leader** might hold the origin to the colors. [This article was discovered by Ralph Hadley, Class of 1949, and passed down to his grandson, Sean Kennedy, Class of 2003.] At a football banquet ending the 1930 season, Bob McGraw explained how the colors originated. He related that the colors had been used for more than 25 years, which would date back to around 1905. When he was a student, football was just beginning and students felt that the school should have official colors. While he didn't play football, he was appointed to the high school athletic association and was named president. The group was sponsored by the student body and each member paid a dollar a year to join, with the money being used to buy equipment. McGraw and two other boys comprised the committee selected to determine the colors. Each of the boys already owned a red and black sweater with a high roll collar and none of them wanted the expense of buying another sweater. Each member of the committee was tasked with submitting a color combination (so the deck was stacked): pink and green, yellow and purple, and red and black. The student body voted, and red and black was the most popular color.

The first time the phrase "**BIG RED**" appeared was in the 1920 **BELJUAN** in an article on the 1919 football team. And it was Big Red, not Big Reds. The phrase was used several times that year. The use of "**BIG REDS**" was found in 1932 in reference to the 1930 football team. While Big Red and Big Reds both appeared in the late 30's, once you get to the early 40's the phrase Big Reds starts to be used more often.

GORDON BATTELLE, Class of 1906, was credited to be the first alumnus to return to his alma mater to coach in 1912.

The 1939 yearbook stated that **John "Butch" Niemiec** (Class of 1923), who coached the Big Reds football team from 1938-1942, was the first coach to graduate from BHS and return to coach at his alma mater. Obviously that was incorrect. He was joined in 1940 by another illustrious alumnus, **Mike Basrak** (Class of 1931).

FUN FACTS?

The first appearance of the **INDIAN** was in the 1936 **BELJUAN**. Indians appeared on the inside cover, and a drawing of a peace pipe, tomahawk, shield, and arrow appear at the bottom of each page. A silhouette of a brave and younger boy appear as dividers on each section. But no mention of it as being the mascot. Again, in 1938, Indians appeared on the inside cover and dividers, but still no mention as to a mascot. In 1950, the Indian Chief appeared on the cover of the yearbook. Inside was a picture of principal Steve Polinsky in full head dress. The dividers that year were various students in Indian clothing. While nothing appeared in print, I would assume that the Indian became the official mascot of the school. From that point on, you will find candid photos of students in Indian garb. Most drawings were cartoonish at that time. And most of the Indian chiefs looked to the left. In 1988, while I was running the Bellaire Print Shop, I came across artwork of the current Indian. It struck me as stoic, majestic, like early Indian chiefs would appear. So from that time on, I used that drawing for everything, gradually replacing all other drawings. It is the same artwork that is currently used today.

The words to the **FIGHT SONG** appeared in print in the 1939 **BELJUAN**. I would have to surmise that it was the first time it was used. Only the words appear. No author, no melody. While Cambridge has the same melody for their fight song, they didn't use it until the late nineties. Class songs were selected/written by each senior class up until that time. So while the words are documented, the mystery of who wrote them and where the melody came from remains.

In researching commencement programs, the fight song appeared in the program for 1933. It was titled "Bellaire High School Song," and only included the first verse and chorus. It appeared for many years after that. In the 1936 program and programs which followed, it was shown as being written by Vincent Engledinger, but no reference to the melody.

ALMA MATER is still a mystery. In the 1949 yearbook, the words to the Alma Mater are printed. They are also found inside the 1950 and 1951 books. That makes me believe that the song was first used in 1949 and appeared three consecutive years to ingrain them in the student's mind. However, the Fight Song was printed in the 1939 **BELJUAN**. One would think that the alma mater would have been written before a fight song, so this still is unclear to me.

The phrase **SPIRIT, PRIDE, TRADITION** was first used when the BHS Sports Foundation was created in 1988. The logic behind the phrase was that a student must first create his own spirit in his school, his team, himself. That leads to him expressing pride behind everything he does. As this pride grows, he becomes more aware not only of the traditions of the past but also of traditions he is creating. This phrase, like so many other symbols, has been altered and changed over time. But the original is still the original.

As far as I can tell, the **SPEAR** first appeared on football helmets in 1987. A couple coaches liked the design used by Florida State University and thought it should replace the Indian head. From that point on, it was used in programs, on clothing, etc. Today, both the spear and the Indian chief are used interchangeably as symbols of the Big Reds.

HISTORICAL FACTS

COME ON, IT ALL CAN'T BE ATHLETICS!

- 1843: Town of Bell Air laid out
- 1839: First school building erected on Pultney Street, next door to First M.E. Church (now 27th Street)
- 1860: School Board purchases old shoe factory (35th and Belmont Street) and remodeled it for school purposes
- 1871: New school, called the Central, built east of old building costing \$21,000, minus furniture (elementary and high school students)
- 1875: Bellaire High School was organized with an enrollment of 25 (top floor of Central)
- 1878: First class graduates from Bellaire High School: W.C. Stewart, Lyle Thoburn, Ben Cowen, and Ella Blankensop
- 1904: New high school built at cost of \$45,000, but realized its size was inadequate (old Central Building)
- 1906: First Ward Elementary School built
- 1908: Rose Hill Elementary School built
- 1913: Gravel Hill Elementary School built
- 1917: Indian Run Elementary School built
- 1925: Key Ridge Elementary School built
- 1925: Bellaire High School dedicated
- 1927: West Bellaire Elementary School School built
- 1934: First game played at Nelson Field Saturday, September 22 at 2:30PM Shadyside - 7, Bellaire - 2
- 1953: Nelson Field Dedicated to J.V. Nelson October 3, 1953 v. Ironton
- 1958: Pultney (Neffs) Elementary School School built
- 1965: Industrial Arts Building dedicated at cost of \$104,000
- 1965: Fieldhouse built by Touchdown Club Materials cost about \$16,000 with labor donated
- 1965: New bus garage built at corner of Belmont and 26th Streets
- 1965: Maintenance and Storage Building purchased on Monroe Street
- 1969: Cafeteria/gymnasium dedicated
- 1969: First basketball game in new gymnasium Saturday, December 6 Bellaire - 55, Martins Ferry - 41
- 1998: Administration building on corner of 34th and Guernsey Streets transferred from AEP
- 2001: Home stands at Nelson Field replaced September 1, 2001 Bellaire-6, John Marshall-47
- 2001: Bellaire Elementary School built
- 2001: Bellaire Middle School built
- 2001: High School renovated
- 2017: New fieldhouse completed
- 2018: Neffs baseball field dedicated John Blacker Field April 22, 2018
- 2022: Visitors stands completed at Nelson Field August 20, 2022 BHS-14, Garaway-21
- 2024: The Lights Go On At Nelson Field August 23, 2024 Bellaire - 38, Buckeye Local - 6
