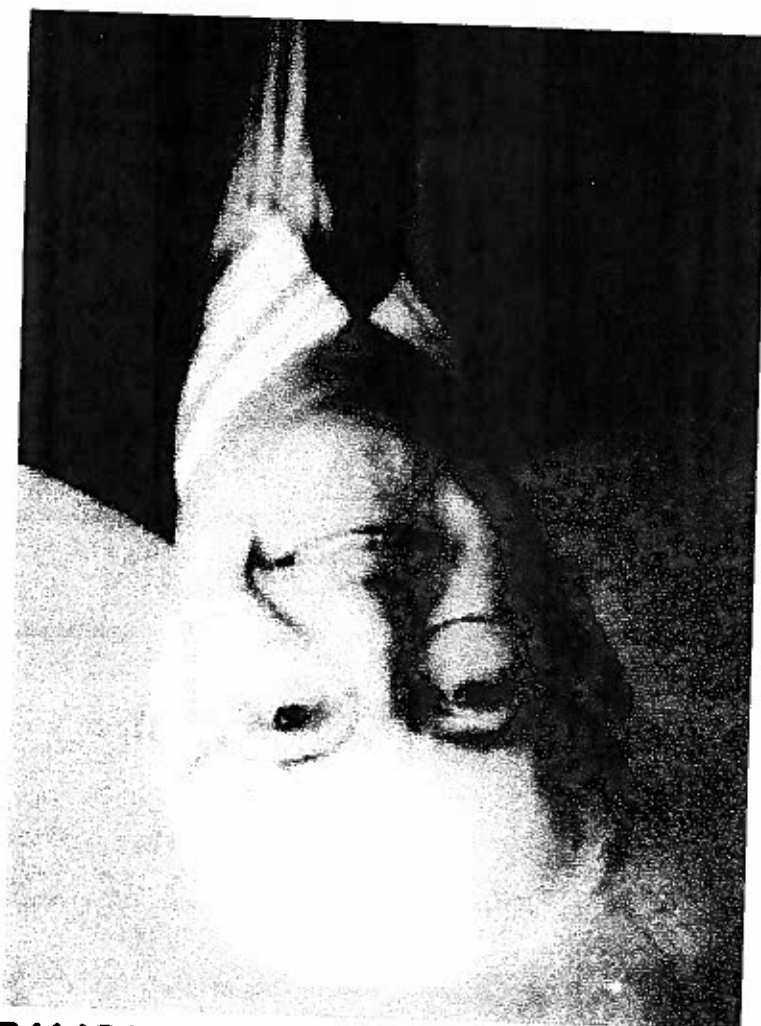

## CONGRATS O.V.A.C. ATHLETES

1. Each game will consist of two 20-minute halves.
2. Zone presses may be used but must end after first trap past half court.
3. Man-to man defense must be played in the normal attack area.
4. Each player must make an appearance in both halves. Attempts should be made to give all 15 players equal playing time.
5. Dunking will be permitted during the pre-game warm-up.
6. All overtime periods shall be three minutes in length.
7. Each player is allowed six (6) personal fouls before he is disqualified.
8. Teams will be permitted one full time-out and two :30 time-outs per game. No one & one until the last two minutes of game. Double bonus will be shot on the 10th foul at all times. One & one will be shot on the 7th foul only in last 2 minutes of game.

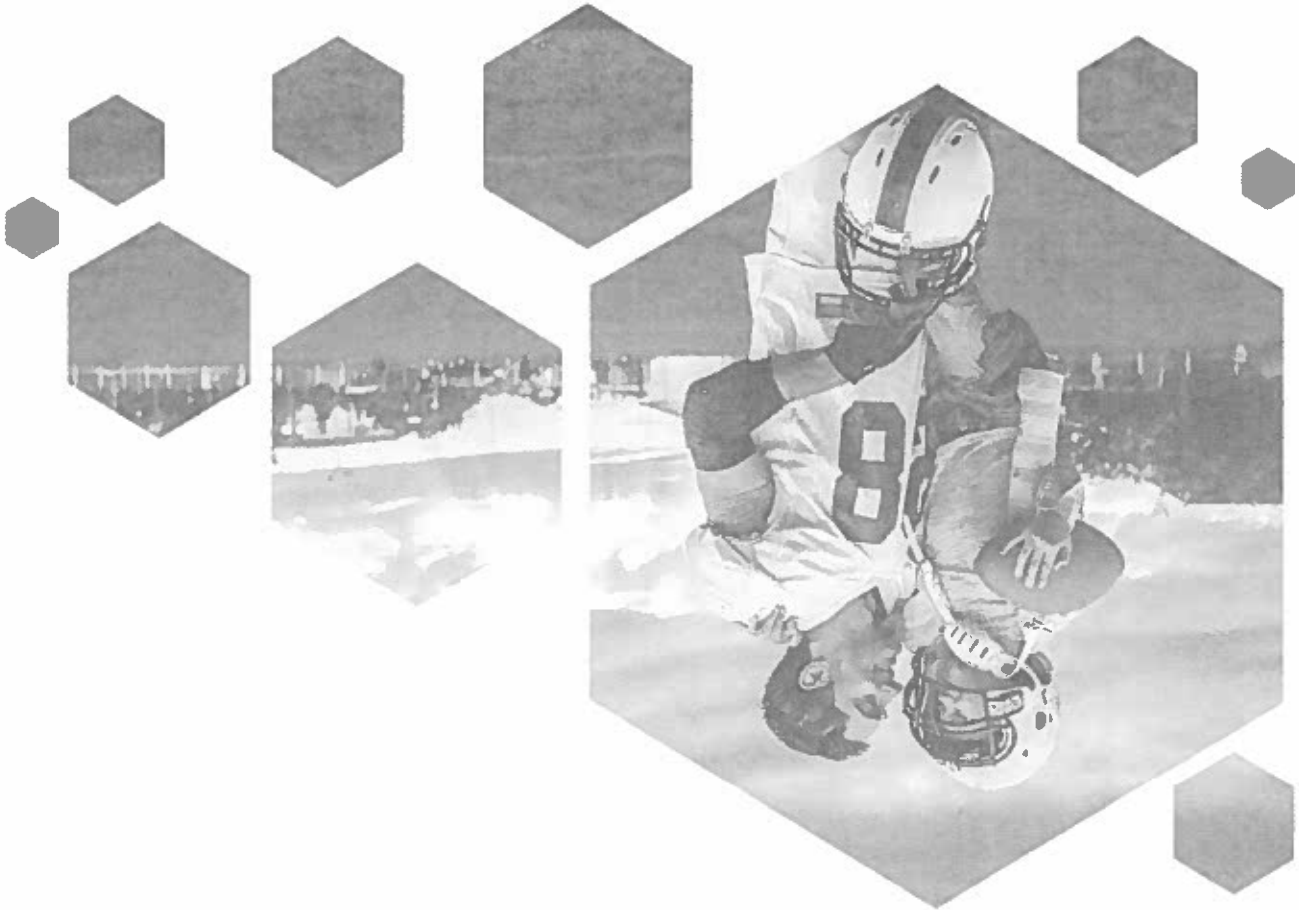

# ROBERT DAWSON OFFICIALS AWARD



Jim Prati's love of basketball developed as a youngster in Yorkville. His passion for officiating, however, kept him around the game for more than four decades.

His prowess as an official has earned him the Robert Dawson Officials Award at today's Samuel A. Mumley OVAC All-Star Game.

Prati worked upwards of 50 varsity games per winter between boys and girls. His resume is much more than just length of service.

Prati was likely to be one of the three officials assigned to big games throughout the Ohio Valley. He was chosen to work in the OVAC boys and/or girls' final every season from 2008 when the tournament format began until 2021 when he opted to step away from officiating.

All told, Prati worked 27 conference title games. He was selected to work seven state championship games and more than 25 regional tournaments between Ohio and West Virginia. He worked at the Ohio district level more than 30 times. He also blew the whistle during the District 5 All-Star Game.

Prati was named the District 5 Official of the Year (2003 and 2017); District 12 Official of the Year (2016), Ohio Valley Board Referee of the Year (2000), NFHS/WVSSAC Official of the Year (2014). He was granted an honorary Lifetime Membership to the Ohio Valley Board of Officials. He's also been chosen for the Robert Dawson Officials Award at the OVAC All-Star Game.

Along with his on-court work, Prati served as the president of the Ohio Valley Board three times and spent 25 years on the executive board of the Ohio Valley Board. He also worked in training and mentoring with the board for 15 years.

Currently, Prati remains active in the officiating world by serving as the lead observer for the Ohio Valley Board.

Jim and his wife, Roseanne, have three adult sons – Jason, Justin and Nate.

# EARL HABERFIELD BOYS BASKETBALL COACHING AWARD



Tom Wise and Bishop Donahue basketball became synonymous. That's what happens when you coach at a place for 33 seasons. Because of his dedication and success, Wise is being honored today as the recipient of the Earl Haberfield Boys Coaching Award.

Wise served as an assistant for 16 seasons, working under John Stanko and Tom Tribett, before ascending to the head coaching position in 2000. He held that role for 17 seasons.

During his time leading the Bishops, he racked up 212 wins, won three OVAC titles and finished as state runner-up in 2007. His win total makes him the second-winningest coach in Donahue history.

After the memorable 2007 campaign, Wise was named a finalist for the coveted OVA Coach of the Year Award and served as the head coach of the North squad in the West Virginia North-South Game.

As an assistant, Wise was a part of the Bishops 1985 state championship team and the 1989 state runner-up squad.

Wise, who graduated from Wheeling College and has a master's degree from West Virginia University, has continued coaching as at Sherrard Middle School in Marshall County for the past five seasons.

Tom and his wife, Jill, reside in Moundsville.

# RICHARD SAFFIELD GIRLS BASKETBALL COACH AWARD



Dan Liedtke proved time and time again that gender didn't matter in coaching basketball. Liedtke experienced high levels of success both with the Fort Frye girls and boys' basketball programs during a career, which stretched 39 years.

His success and longevity both led to him being honored today as the recipient of the Richard Saffield Girls Basketball Coach award.

Liedtke spent 16 seasons on the Fort Frye girls' basketball sideline, accumulating 326 wins and leading the Cadets to three state tournament berths. His teams also won seven OVA C titles, 16 sectionals, eight district crowns and 10 Pioneer Valley Conference championships.

Prior to shifting to the girls' bench, Liedtke rang up 433 wins as the Fort Frye boys' coach in 27 years at the helm. He made one appearance in the state tournament, won three district titles, 12 sectionals, six OVA C crowns and 17 PVA C's.

From 2009-2011, Liedtke coached both the girls' and boys' teams concurrently.

All told, Liedtke finished with a 759-259 record. Liedtke's success earned him a myriad of accolades. He was named Division III girls' state coach of the year in 2012 and state boys coach of the year in 1999. He was a finalist for OVA C Coach of the Year four times and was named Eastern District Coach of the Year eight times. He was honored by the District 12 Coaches Association as coach of the year 12 times. He was Ohio's nominee for NFHS Girls Coach of the Year in 2022 and received the coveted Paul Walker Award from the basketball coaches association in Ohio in 2021.

Wheeling Central has one of the area's most storied traditions in both boys and girls basketball. Stan Kaniecki has had a good seat for much of the Maroon Knight success. Kaniecki has been an institution at the score table in the Central Catholic Athletic Center as the scoreboard operator for both boys' and girls' games for more than a decade. That dedication has led to Kaniecki being this year's recipient of the Thomas E. Rataiczak Timer/Scorekeeper Award.

Kaniecki grew up around the game of basketball. He played at Sacred Heart Grade School before playing for four years at Wheeling Central and then at Bethany College. Kaniecki spent 39 years as a math teacher at CCHS and during that span he coached both boys' and girls' basketball for 12 years. He spent four seasons as an official and then matriculated to the table.

He has worked the clock at CCHS games for 12 years and has spent the last 10 seasons at the clock controls for 10 years. According to Kaniecki, the opportunity to work the clock has given him the "chance to still be a part of the game."
